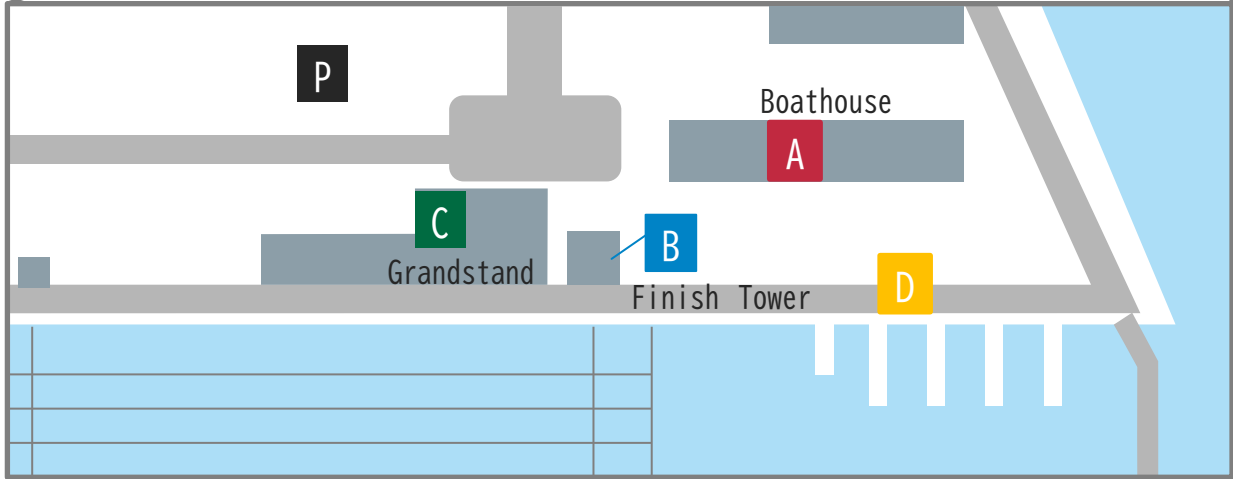
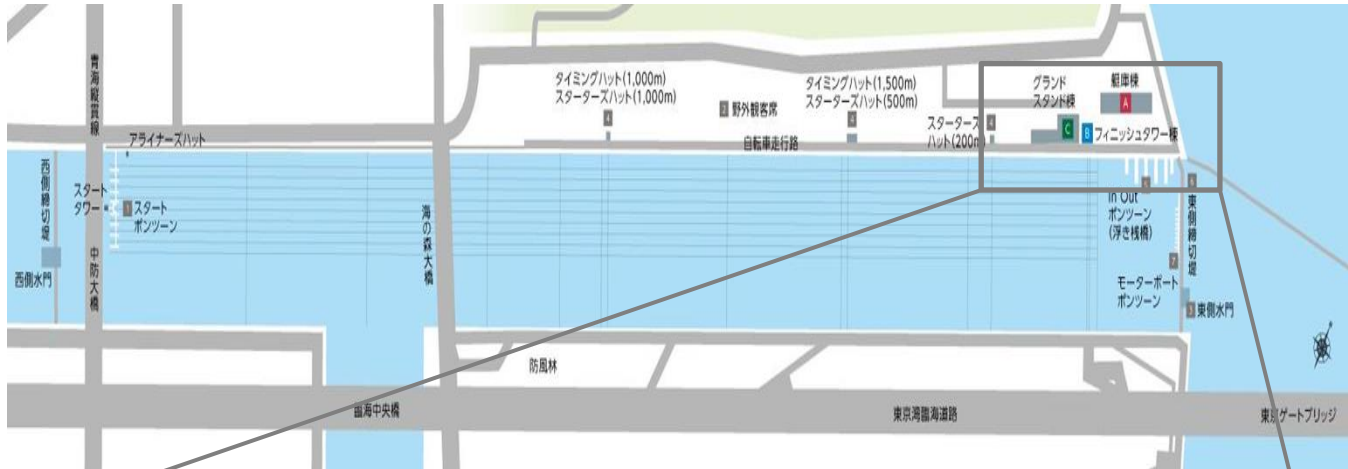

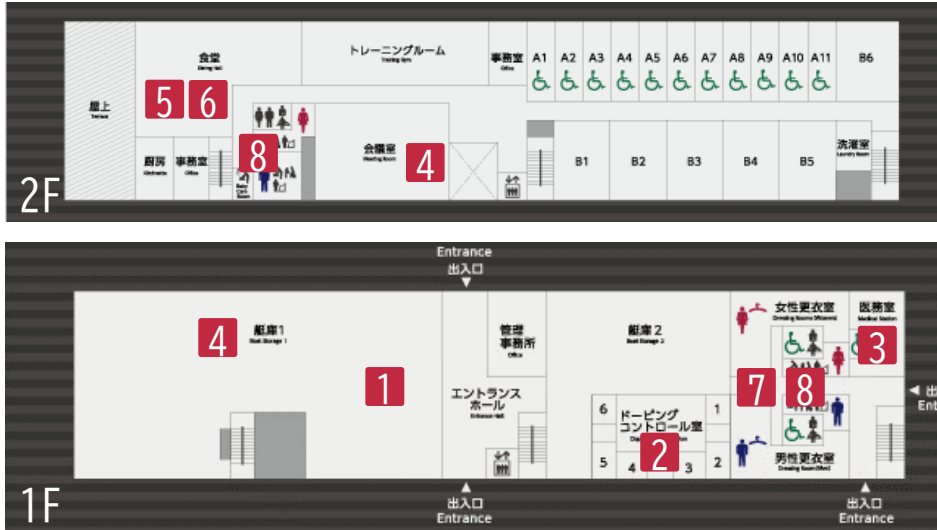
Venue Map 1/3





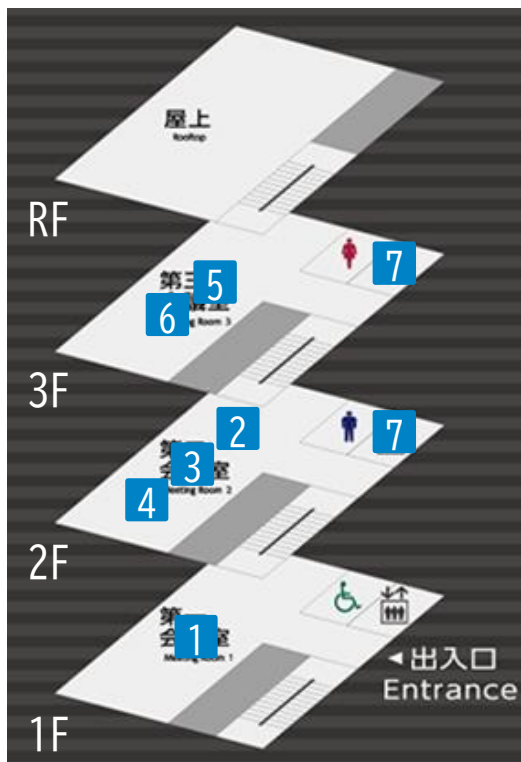

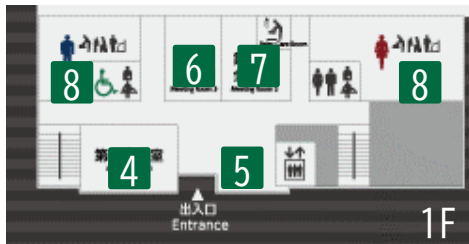

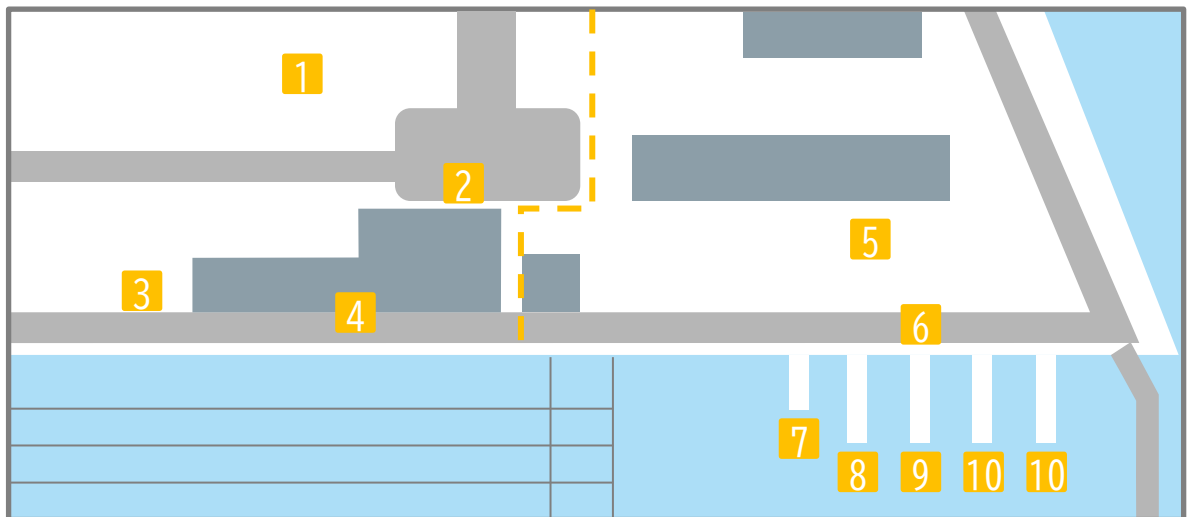
Venue Map 3/3

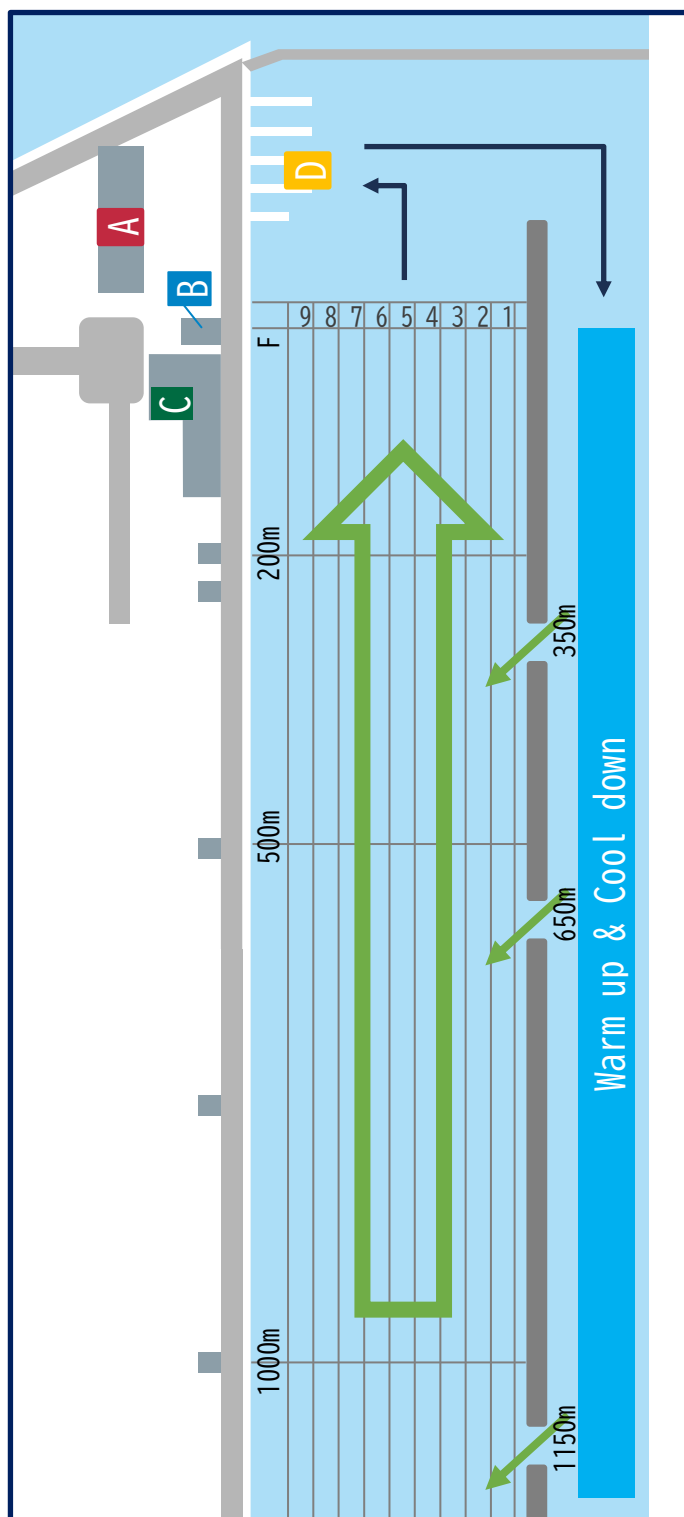

Channel

- The competition course and the training channel is separated by wave absorbers.
- There are three slits to enter the course at 350m, 650m, and 1150m.



Accreditation



- Accreditation Office is located at the venue (Map **C 4**).
- All participant must come to the Accreditation Office in person to receive his/her Accreditation Card. Please bring own passport to identify.
- Accreditation Card is necessary to enter the restricted area. Please note that you will not be accredited until payment of the accreditation fee and other expenses is confirmed.
- We will need team leaders' mobile phone number so they can be reached in a case of an urgent matter.
- Team leaders will be asked to control the national flag and the national anthem at the Sport Information in the morning on 17th April.

Boat Storage

- Outdoor racks in front of the boathouse will be allocated for each team.
- Please tie your boats securely to the racks on your responsibility to prevent them from falling from the racks. We recommend you to bring belts.

Boat Control

- Pre-competition boat control will be conducted as a self boat control. Teams can find a scale in the boathouse.
- Boats for post-race control will be called from the disembarkation pontoon. Called boats must come directly to the boat control.

Boat Number Plates

- The boat numbers (lane number plates) can be collected just before the race at the sport information on the 1st floor of the finish tower (Map **B 1**).
- Numbers may be used by each team to bring their own.
- All boat numbers collected at the sport information must be returned directly after the race at the same place.
- If a number plate collected at the sport information is lost or damaged, or not returned on the same day, a fee of 2,000 JPY or 15 USD will be charged for each number plate.



Boat Stickers

The stickers with athlete's name and your National Olympic Committee (NOC) code must be applied on all boats following the guideline of ICF. The stickers will be checked at the Boat Control. It is the participating National Federations' responsibility to provide the stickers to their athletes. Please use the templates provided by the ICF with the correct sizes and font.

Body Numbers

- Athletes must wear the body number on their back.
- Body numbers can be collected at the Sport Information from 17th Wednesday.
- If there is a body number missing or broken, you can go to the Sport Information on the 1st floor of the finish tower (Map **B 1**).

- Only forms submitted up until the deadline will be accepted.
- After the deadline you need to contact the Chief Official directly.

Parking at the venue

- Vehicle pass is required to park a vehicle at the venue.
- It costs 7,000 JPY or 50 USD per vehicle for whole competition period from 14th to 21st.
- If you need one, please ask at the Accreditation Office and receive a parking ticket in exchange for payment.

Bicycling / walking along the course

- Bicycling or walking along the course is allowed only during the training period.
- On competition days, access to the path along the course is prohibited to operate the competition vehicles safely.



Drinking water



- Tap water is safe and drinkable in Japan.

First aid



- First aid is available during the competition days from 18th to 21st at the medical station on the 1st floor of the Boathouse (Map  ).
- Out of the above period, please consult at the Sport Information.

- Medal ceremonies will be held following the finals.
- The athletes receiving medals must wear their national team uniform.
- The top three athletes/crews should come to the area at the finish tower 15 minutes before their ceremony.

- The coordinated transportation schedule and other necessary information will be informed to each team at the Sport Information.

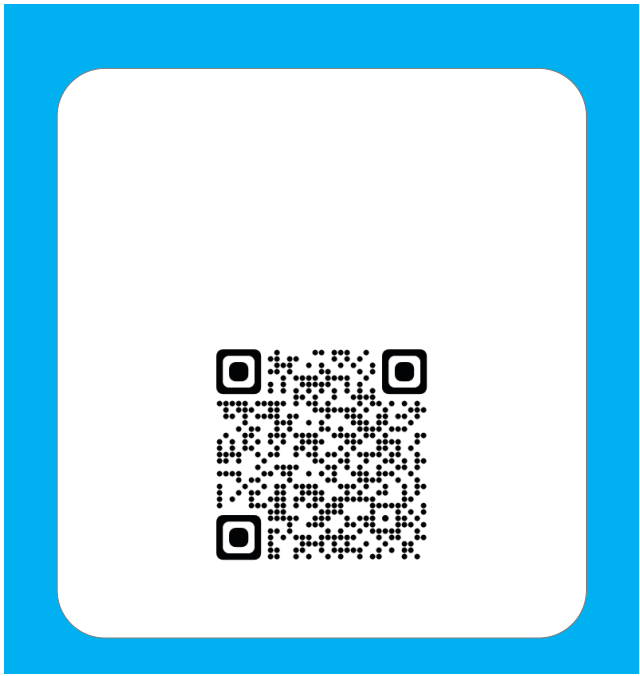

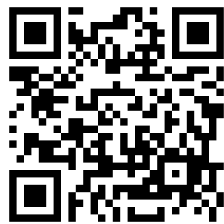
