In an effort to coordinate and harmonize the world-wide anti-doping movement, the International Canoe Federation (ICF), in partnership with the Anti-Doping Services branch of the Association of National Anti-Doping Organisations (ANADO-ADS), is pleased to offer access to the ADAMS database to the members of the ICF Registered Testing Pool.

ADAMS is a web-based management system that simplifies the daily activities of all stakeholders and athletes involved in the anti-doping movement. While the benefits to all stakeholders are great, as an athlete, we hope that you will experience the following benefits through your use of ADAMS:

- Ability to enter your whereabouts information from anywhere in the world
- Your whereabouts information is instantly shared with relevant anti-doping organisations such as WADA, the ICF, and the national anti-doping organisation in your country
- Option to designate a representative to enter whereabouts information on your behalf
- Robust security provisions that protect the privacy and integrity of your personal information
