The ECA continues to be successful and now we are receiving income from TV rights at both our Senior Championships in the Olympic Disciplines of Slalom and Flatwater.


The next ECA Congress will be held in Bratislava 2009 and we are hoping to make many changes in our Statutes to bring them into line with the ICF.
