BOAT CONSTRUCTION

The ICF Paracanoe kayak construction rules are identical to the Canoe Sprint kayak construction with the only exception being the width requirement. Since the kayak construction rules prevent concavity and permit one rudder to be placed under the hull of the boat, any projecting elements such as skegs and keels are not permitted.

The ICF Paracanoe Va'a construction rules permit concavity. Consequently, Section 8.10.5 of the ICF Paracanoe Competition Rules specifically exclude rudders, skegs and projecting keels.

SPRAY SKIRTS (SPRAY DECKS)

Section 8.8 of the Paracanoe Rules state that spray skirts may not be used in classification or competition unless approved by the Chief Official and due to severe water conditions.
