  - (2) Take the inspection of buoyancy aid before race.
  - (3) In the event of an accident during the game, the organizer will provide first aid, but in principle, the responsibility lies with the athlete concerned.
  - (4) Self-rescue is required during official training.
  - (5) There is no consideration given to the time of the competitors when starting.
