## COMPETITION RULES

### 1. Canoe Slalom Format

The competition is run in accordance with the ICF's Canoe Slalom Rules 2023 version 2, in competition level 4, can be adapted upon the host's discretion.





## 2. Short Slalom Format (ICF Level 4 Competition)

The course must consist of a minimum of ten (10) gates and a maximum of twelve (12) gates, of which two (2) or four (4) must be upstream gates. The course should be navigable for MK1 in a time close to 45 seconds.

# COMPETITION FORMATS AND PROGRESSION SYSTEM

## 1. Individual Events:

### 1.1 Short Slalom (SSL)

Both SSL-race 1(FOP2) and SSL-race 2 (FOP1) will consist of one final run.

### 1.2 Canoe Slalom (CSL)

Both CSL-race 1(FOP2) and CSL-race 2 (FOP1) will consist of one heat run and one final run.

#### 1.2.1 Progression System

Progression from the heat runs to finals is ten boats. The first top ten athletes will run the finals for the ICF Ranking Competitions. Athletes not progressing to the Final will be offered a "B" Final. This second block (i.e. minus those names from the first block) will then be generated according to respective age groups to run the finals for their titles in the 13<sup>th</sup> Asian Canoe Slalom Championships.

**2. Team Events:** There is one run.

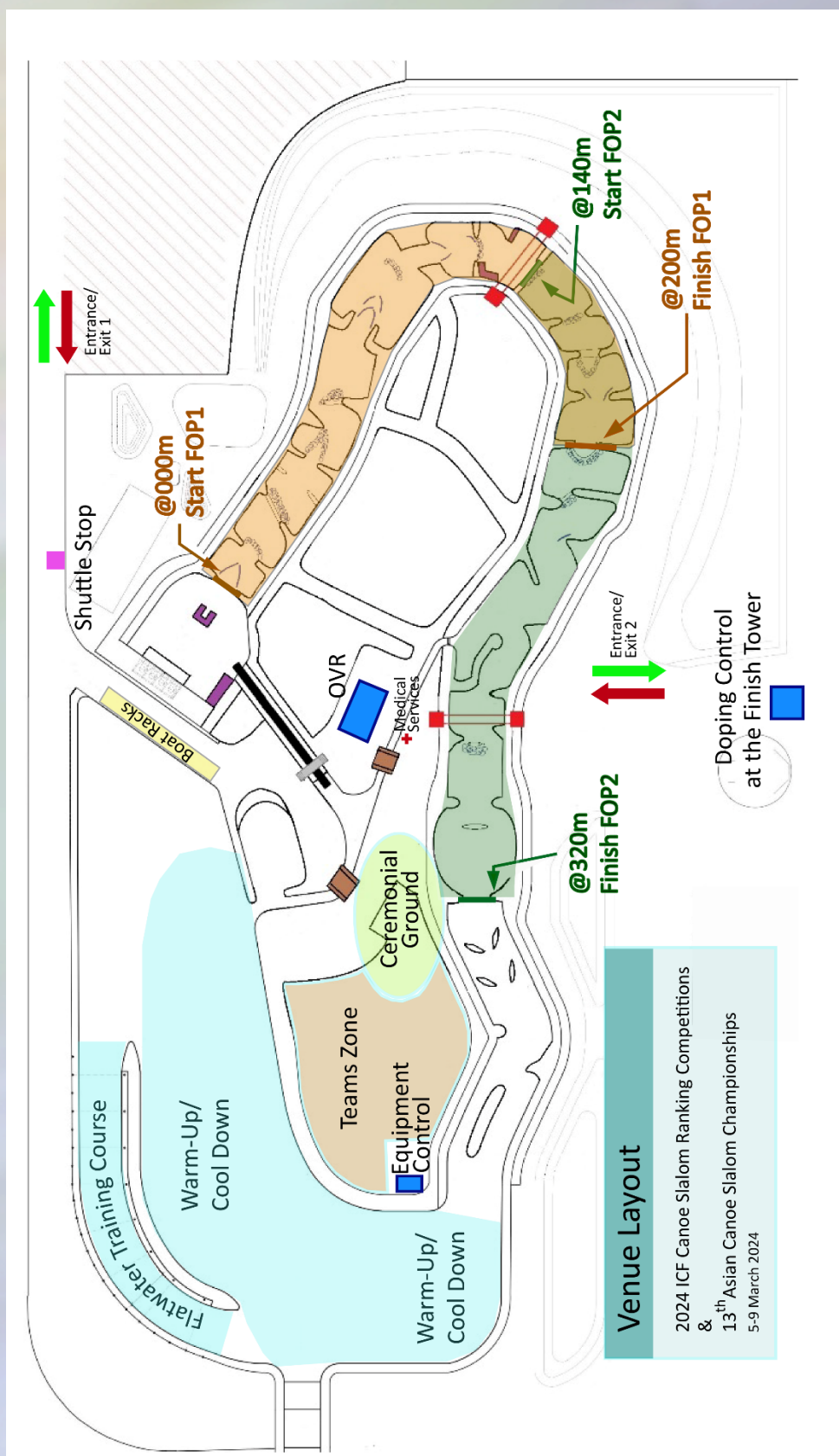

## EQUIPMENT CONTROL

The area, well equipped with calibrated scale, measure tape and water tank with 6.12 kg calibrated stainless-steel cage, is opened for self-check from 2 – 4 March for the whole of each day. Random control shall be conducted during the competitions.

Teams need to prepare boat stickers for all members of your team i.e. country code sticker and athlete's name sticker.

## MEDICAL SERVICES

A first-aid room with medical personnel is situated on the first floor of the dormitory building in the training center compound. An ambulance van will remain on duty during the Championships period.

The HOC recommend the teams to always wear proper shoes while walking around the venue to save from very warm walkway, slippery areas, and sharp rocks.
