

## INTERNATIONAL TECHNICAL OFFICIAL (ITO) SEMINARS & EXAMS

## Canoe Sprint

The ICF CSP Committee will organize an International Technical Official Seminar and Exams in Poznan (Poland) and Halifax (Canada) on the occasion of World Cup #2 and World Championships (in accordance to 1.15 of the ICF CSP Competition Rule).

The seminar including final exam will be both online and in-person during both competitions. Once accepted, candidates will receive materials in advance to become familiar with the rules. Note that attendance in the seminar is compulsory in order to take the exam.

For the in-person session, the candidates will have to arrive to each competition for the for the team leaders meeting then be fully available throughout the competition. During the competition, the candidates will have opportunities to observe and study the duties at each ITO's function to have practical knowledge followed by Q & A session after each day. The final exam will be after the last day of each competition.

Only National Federation are entitled to nominate candidates for examination at least 30 days before the examination (April 29<sup>th</sup> for Poznan, July 7<sup>th</sup> for Halifax).

The application must be sent to the ICF headquarters (<u>Hoichan.kwon@canoeicf.com</u>) with the proper examination form designed by the ICF and published on the ICF website.

Time and Date of the online session will be announced to selected candidates.
