2020 In-competition testing statistics

The ICF is responsible for Anti-Doping testing during ICF Competitions which includes Junior and Senior World Championships and World Cups in all disciplines.

The ICF performed **32 in-competition tests** as testing authority.

Out-of-competition testing statistics

137 samples (blood, urine, or passport samples) have been collected from outof-competition testing in 2020.

The ICF Out-of-Competition Testing Program is coordinated by the Canadian Centre for Ethics in Sport Anti-Doping Service (CCES) since 2012.
