- I have been an active canoeist since 1968 - 56 years
- I competed internationally as a Marathon and Sprint canoeist for Great Britain from 1971 to 1980 winning many major International Marathon Events.
- I relocated to South Africa in 1981 and I am a South African citizen.
- I have been involved in the administration of canoeing in South Africa since 1983 – 41 years
- I was President of Canoeing South Africa from 1994 to 2002.
- Chairperson for Kwazulu Natal Canoe Union from 2013 to 2015
- I was President of the Confederation of African Canoeing and an International Canoe Federation Board Member from 2002 to 2007
- During my period as CAC President I worked specifically to establish the newly formed Confederation and during this period increased the number of African ICF member nations from 12 to 24.
- 2nd Vice President of Confederation of African Canoeing and an International Canoe Federation Board Member from 2011 to 2015
- Member of the ICF Marathon Committee or an adviser to the committee since 1992 – 32 years
