Profile Summary: Hayatullah Khan Durrani is a pioneering figure in the fields of caving, mountaineering, rowing, canoeing, kayaking, and environmental conservation in Pakistan. He is the first Pakistani to receive the British Caving Legend Award in the UK and has received appreciation letters from HM Queen Elizabeth II and HM King Charles III. He has been honored with the prestigious Presidential Award 'Pride-of-Performance' for his lifelong dedication to adventure sports and environmental preservation.

Key Achievements:

1. **Canoeing, Kayaking and Rowing Olympic Sports:**

- Founder of Balochistan's first and only Canoeing, Rowing, and Kayaking Olympic Sports International Academy HDWSA in 1996 at Hanna Lake, Quetta.
- Pioneer of rowing, canoeing, kayaking, Olympic sports in Balochistan in 1986.
- Organized numerous national and international canoeing and kayaking events adhering to International Canoe Federation (ICF) rules.
- Instrumental in developing and promoting canoe and kayak Olympic sports within Pakistan.
- Represented Pakistan in ACC Congress Iran 2011 & Uzbekistan 2013.
- Attended Common Meeting with ICF Vice President for Development Of Canoe / Kayak Olympic Sports in Region, April 23, 25 2018 Tehran Iran.
