The whitewater stadium

The 2017 ICF Canoe World Championships will take place on the brand artificial stadium of Pau-Pyrénées built around the river «Gave de Pau» for the following events :

Canoe Slalom - Canoe Slalom & Extreme Slalom
Canoeing Wildwater - Sprint

Technical attributes

Length : 280 meters

Width : 15 meters

Drop : 5 meters with an average of 2%

Water flow during the World Championships : 12m³

50-meter float lift system

200-meter initiation basin, warm-up and cool-down areas linked to «Gave de Pau»

If you want to use the course before the World Championships for training camps, you can book your trainings slots directly at the whitewater stadium front desk. During these periods, you will paddle on our own responsibility and costs.

SPORT INFORMATION

Do you need visas ?

France is a state-member of the European Union. The French Embassy in your country will provide you with all detailed information about visas. You will find details in the website of French Foreign Affairs Ministry (www.diplomatie.gouv.fr/en/)

Please inform in advance but not later than 1st May 2017 the Organising Committee together with the visa form whether your team needs entry visas to France. You will find in appendix the form to fulfil.

Special regulations in France

EVIN LAW (N91-32 January 10th 1991)

This law forbids advertising for alcoholic beverages (any level of alcohol including beer) and tobacco inside sports arena (Canoe Slalom stadium is a sport arena). No advertising on tracksuits, boats, paddles, ... is allowed.

Protection of athletes health law (N99-223 March 23rd 1999)

Specific doping regulations on French territory.

Safety rules - Canoe Slalom

Each competitor must wear a safety helmet with a strap fastened under the chin and a buoyancy jacket (article 19.2 ICF Canoe Slalom rules).

A buoyancy jacket must comply with the current industry standard that is ISO 12408-5 (Level 50) or any national standard that meets the same requirements and be ICF registered by 1st January in order to be authorized for use in Olympic Games and/or ICF level 1,2 & 3 competition that year (article 19.2.1 ICF Canoe Slalom rules).

The safety helmet must comply with EN 1385 and be ICF registered by 1st January in order to be authorized for use in Olympic Games and/or ICF level 1,2 & 3 competition that year (article 19.2.2 ICF Canoe Slalom rules).

SPORT INFORMATION

Safety rules - Wildwater Canoeing

Concerning safety helmet and buoyancy jacket, requirements are the same for both discipline. Please refer to article 18.2.1 and 18.2.2 into ICF Wildwater Canoeing rules.

All paddlers must wear shoes on their feet. Shoes must have a thicker sole to protect feet. Shoes must fit in a way that they will not come off in capsize or be release from boat (article 18.2 ICF Wildwater Canoeing rules).

All boats must be filled with air bages in both the front and the back of boat.

Safety rules - Extreme Slalom

Extreme Slalom is an event of Canoe Slalom, as Team events are.


Concerning safety helmet and buoyancy jackets, requirements are the same for Extreme Slalom and Canoe Slalom.

Please refer to article 54.1 to 54.8 into ICF Canoe Slalom rules for complete Extreme Slalom safety rules.

Competitors who break any of the safety rules will be disqualified for that phase (DSQ-R) (article 54.8 ICF Canoe Slalom rules).

Entries - Canoe Slalom

According to ICF Canoe Slalom rules, each national federation can enter up to 3 boats per event.

Numerical entries will be made at least 45 days prior the competition according to ICF Canoe Slalom rules.

Nominal entries must be received 14 days prior the first day of competition according to ICF Canoe Slalom rules. They must be processed via SDP software with the ICF entry system online (www.canoeicf.com).

All nominal entries proposed after the deadline will have to be deal as a late entry and be accepted by the Chairman of ICF Canoe Slalom Committee (Jean-Michel PRONO) according to ICF Canoe Slalom rules (article).

Entries - Extreme Slalom

According to ICF Canoe Slalom rules, each national federation can enter up to 2 boats per event.

Entries - Wildwater Canoeing

According to ICF Wildwater Canoeing rules, each national federation can enter up to 4 boats per event.

Nominal entries must be received 14 days prior the first day of competition according to ICF Wildwater Canoeing rules.

How to register ?

You need to enter your team through the nominal entries via the ICF software SDP in order to validate them. With the nominal entries, all athletes will be automatically pre-accredited, so you do not need to re-enter them. Be careful, you need to enter all your staff members through pre-accreditations !
