Rio de Janeiro, simply referred to as Rio, is a Brazilian municipality, capital of the state of the same name, located in the Southeast of the country. It is one of the largest international tourist destinations in Brazil, Latin America and also in the Southern Hemisphere. The capital of Rio de Janeiro is the best-known Brazilian city abroad and is a national reference. It is the second largest metropolis in Brazil (after São Paulo), the seventh largest in the Americas and the eighteenth largest in the world. Its population according to the 2022 IBGE census was 6,211,223 inhabitants. It has the epithet of Marvelous City, and those who are born there are called cariocas.



Deodoro Olympic Park or Rio Radical Park is a permanent sports facility built to host sporting events for the XXXI Summer Olympic Games, which were held in Rio de Janeiro from August 5 to 21, 2016. It was inaugurated on December 23, 2015. Today, it serves as the headquarters of Brazil's main canoe slalom team. The course is considered one of the best in the world for canoe slalom.

Currently, several activities take place in the park for the population living in the region, thus maintaining a legitimate Olympic legacy.
