2. Tasks undertaken for this period:

Meetings have been held with the members of the Board, the presidents of the committees, COPAC professional staff and continental representatives of America. In those meetings, a diagnosis was made of how COPAC was doing on various issues. I summarize below the most relevant ones.

- Finances (Income and Debts)
- Administration of COPAC (Board, Registry and professionals)
- Event calendars
- Pan American Games in Cali 2021 and Santiago 2023
- Social networks
- Members of the Sprint and Slalom commissions

Administration of COPAC:

Due to the volume of work in administrative matters and social network matters, we will continue with the professional structure of having support in COPAC for administration and social networks. The board decided to close the registration of COPAC in Brazil. Several meetings have been held with Brazilian lawyers to understand the process to be carried out to close it. At the board level, the vice presidents will be supporting the commissions of Sprint with Sebastián Gómez and Slalom with Merryl See Tai. At the treasury level, Othón Díaz will continue to work hand in hand with our administrative assistant on financial matters. In addition to Christian's role as secretary of COPAC, he will be participating with me in matters related to the Santiago 2023 games.



Cali 2021 Pan American Games:

The Cali Games celebrated in November 2021 were our first event as a new COPAC board. Although we managed to get our young people to have their first event after almost two years without events due to the pandemic. A total of 15 countries participated in these games.



Pan American Slalom Championship:

The Pan American Championship was held in Oklahoma City, USA from May 6 to 8, 2022. Aa total of 7 countries with 86 athletes participated (Argentina, Brazil, Canada, Chile, Mexico, USA, Venezuela), unfortunately Peru did not obtain the visa to participate in the event. We greatly appreciate the Federation of the United States for supporting this event.



Pan American Sprint and Paracanoe Championship:

The Pan American Championship was held from August 10 to 12 in the city of Halifax, Canada, once the World Sprint Championship ended. A total of 14 countries participated in this event and about 5 had visa problems to participate in the event. We greatly appreciated the support of the Atlantic Division and Canoe Kayak Canada Organization on this event.


Santiago 2023 Pan American Games:

Report Technical visit Canoe Sprint:

Our Technical Delegate Allan McDonalds visit on May 17, 2022 the plan B Facilities for Canoe Sprint. Because the country is facing an extreme drought, the city of Curauma does not have the capacity to host the event. It was evaluating San Pedro Lagoon as a Plan B Venue.

- It is approximately 515 kilometers from Santiago
- The City and the venue it is recommended by CO, Chilean Federation and COPAC (has hotels, airport, and good transportation).

Laguna San Pedro in the city of Concepción - has the necessary infrastructure to host the event. The conditions of the lake are correct, considering all the necessary requirements. We had a very productive meeting with the organizing committee of the Games. The finish tower location will need to be on the water. On top of an island. We have periodically meeting with the Santiago 2023 to follow up activities to be perform in la Laguna San Pedro.





Report Technical visit Canoe Slalom:

Proposal Río Aconcagua Pista Canotaje Slalom – LOS ANDES

Canoe Slalom ITD Visit to Santiago 2023 July 31st to August 3rd, 2022

Plan A, Option 1: EL Sauce is a stretch of the same River Aconcagua, but 1,5 km river up from Coquimbito. It is 4 km from the town main square, in a more suitable area (more area and easy to work on the ground with heavy machinery in the riverbed and on the banks and area designated for the overlays. The water flow during the visit was informed to be 7 m³/s (by the hydroelectric power station operator river up from the stretch). It is recommended the Plan A, Option 1, due to the convenience of the area, and a better legacy for canoeing in Chile, for being a public area.





3. Issues and Main Points of Report

- The main issue during this period was the visa requirement to participated in events. This is a Topic that we need to continue evaluate for future events.
