Report of Slalom World Championships Bratislava September 2011



# A. Talent ID camp participants and management

### 1. Organisation

The camp was run from the 1<sup>st</sup> to 12<sup>th</sup> of September. The accommodation was in cabins, meals done at the hotel beside the white-water venue and meals at the hotel near which made "worlds slalom packages" for food and accommodation.

• The group was made of 9 K1M, 1 K1W, 1 C1M and 1 C2M. 12 countries were present, 5 continents

- 11 boats male / 1 female
- Average-age: 19

The group is based now on a core of paddlers who are under TIP for couple of years. Then, it is easier to start working earlier and more efficiently.

## 2. Coaching

Among the five coaches involved in the camp, 3 coaches had already worked on such camp. Coaching was made by Carole Bouzidi (FRA), Janos Peterlin (SLO), Ziga Ovcak (SLO), Jakub Lulley (SVK), Pierrick Gosselin (FRA).

Thanks to a different organisation among coaches, longer time was dedicated to video analysis. "To be continued" as athletes and coaches said.

The choice was made of small groups (4 to 5 boats) maxi/coach.

Those last 2 points brought very good out-comes and should be

The five coaches made a "flexible" program based on:

- Full runs 1
- Half's 1
- Technic 2
- Loops 2

On the whole, the paddling time before the event was about 3h45 on official slots and 2h30 on "open slots".

#### 3. <u>Remarks about the group:</u>

• Huge improvement from the paddlers followed for the last 2 years

- The average level of "new identified paddler" is much higher than 3 years ago
  - The ongoing selection for some athletes is a benefit for the camp
- The athletes are more autonomous regarding their training preparation

#### B. Coordination with Organisation Committee

Accomodation/boarding was booked by the Organisation Committee and fully paid by ICF budget

- Organisation Committee supported fees for accreditation of paddlers and coaches
- The boat rental was organised for a part with Vajda and Galasport Compagnies.
