

Report of Continental DVLPMPT CSL camp (ICF/COPAC/CBca) American Olympic Qualification Foz de Igassu (Brazil) 11th – 17th March 2012



A. DVLPMPT camp management

1. Organisation/coaching/financial

The development camp was organised in the following of the TIP camp with the same logistic

A meeting was organised among the paddlers with an international coach, Mr Ettore Ivaldi, and an international Brazilian paddler, Joao Machado. Athletes were asked to prepare questions and debated with Ettore and Joao.

2. Remarks about the group

The main work done with the athletes during that period was on the development of skills and the approach one could have of technical session.

Even though, athletes are not used to this kind of session, the work was fruitful and as weird as it seemed, they caught up with technical points they did not use to.

As it had been agreed the previous season, the athletes who were under TIP World should attend the DVLPMPT camp as athletes model. Unfortunately, due to a misunderstanding, not all of them could stay after the race.

On the other hand, some athletes invited for DVLPMPT camp did not stay because of misunderstanding of the target of the camp and late preparation.

It is a missed opportunity for all of them not to come as on the one hand the future of Slalom in the area is under the involvement of the athlete model and on the other hand, practicing in such good condition for lower level athletes should be a must to refuse or miss.

To be noticed:

- Official invitation letter could be sent when a NF needs to justify the « after race camp » to the national sport authorities.
- The process of the camp is as to be taught to the Slalom leaders of the Nfs as the process of Slalom training and racing to the paddlers
- Training sessions
- They are based on the work of technical skills. Paddlers spent about twice more time on the water than the preparation period of the competition.
