During the first 5 days of the camp, the young enthusiastic women paddlers have spent all day talking, learning and training in Slalom canoeing.

B. Venues and contents

Located at the foot of the mountains of Tehran, at the amazing Azadi Nautic Sports complex, the flat-water slalom venue is offering to Maria Ferekidou, twice Slalom Olympian Greek paddler, to Benoit Peschier, French 2004 Olympic Champion, and to Oktay Alkan, Turkish National coach, a great spot to share their technical slalom knowledge with 24 ladies eager to continuously improve their skills.

The group went also paddling to Alborz, about 30 minutes drive from Tehran. Within less than half day, they had already hung slalom gates and since then they have been training hard, playing and taming the dam-controlled flow of the Karaj river.

C. Educational program

It had been based on the following items for all participants

- Setting of a Slalom venue (building and hanging gates)
- Instructing in Canoe Slalom with a turn-over paddler/observer/instructor
- Basics of Slalom judgement

D. Development plan to the IRI NF

The following steps of national plan were proposed to Mr Amini, IRI NF President, Mr Moradi, IRI NF General Secretary.

A brief presentation of them was also given to Mr Donyamali, ACC continental representative at the ICF board.



Back to October 2014, the Turkey camp made the bridge between Europe and Asia thanks to the participation of 16 ladies from 4 European countries and 3 ladies from Iran, on the Asian continent. In Tehran, thanks to the participation of 4 different countries, Africa is now meeting Asia.

April 2015 is a milestone for E&E program, as it brings European, Asian and African paddlers over the borders to share and enjoy Slalom paddling.
