1. IMPORTANT: FEDERATIONS URGED TO ENSURE ATHLETES COMPLETE ANTI-DOPING COURSE

Unfortunately, at the recent World Cup we experienced that a number of athletes had not completed the anti-doping course in time, so once again we request National Federations, team leaders, coaches and athletes to pay attention to the fact that the International Canoe Federation congress has endorsed a proposal to extend compulsory anti-doping education courses to all senior, U23 and junior international athletes across all canoeing disciplines. This is a strong stand in the fight against doping.

It is important federations and teams understand that these education courses are compulsory for all international athletes and need to be completed before they compete in an international competition.

Athletes who have not completed the course will not be allowed to start.

2. CURRENT SUMMARY OF NUMERICAL ENTRIES FOR THE SHAOXING WORLD CHAMPIONSHIPS

Below is the current (16th August) summary of the numerical entries so far for the World Championships marathon in Shaoxing.

At the moment the weakest classes are C1 women juniors and the C2 men juniors. We need for a valid World Championships at least 6 nations. Marathon rules 1.7.1.b

We wish to remind you that we need 6 countries in a class to constitute a championships race, Marathon rules 1.7.1.b. This is determined at the deadline for numerical entries which is 2nd September. We ask for your cooperation (and use your network) to ensure that we have World Championships in all classes. Many efforts are made on the part of the ICF to try to solve the problems, but we are depending on National Federations to enter boats in those classes.

Important information:

- The competition will be combined World and Asian Continental Championships
- Participation-for-free-strategy: With the goal of encouraging more National Federations to participate in the competition the organizing committee is giving away one free place (paddler) from each national federation including meals, accommodation, local transportation and local boat rental and accreditation costs during competition, see event bulletin. Prize Money total €30.000 for seniors, under 23 and juniors.
- Masters World Championships single classes will be held. Rules for these competitions are in the Masters bulletin which has been published on the ICF website and on facebook.

4. EXAMINATIONS FOR ITO CANDIDATES

This is a reminder that examination for candidates to become International Technical Official in Canoe Marathon will be possible in connection with the World Championships in Shaoxing, China 17-20 October. There is place for max. 10 candidates.

The programme for candidates includes a seminar followed by verbal examination. The date of the examination is Tuesday October 15th. Passed candidates will then serve as trainees during the competition and **must** attend the full event.

Only National Federations are entitled to nominate candidates for examination at least 30 days before the examination, see Canoe Marathon Competition Rules for further requirements.
