1. CURRENT SUMMARY OF NUMERICAL ENTRIES FOR THE SHAOXING WORLD CHAMPIONSHIPS

Below is the summary of the numerical entries by the deadline for these entries (2^{nd} September 2019) for the World Championships in Shaoxing.

As you will see all classes meet the criteria for being valid championships events. **However, we wish to** remind you that according to the ICF rules "a valid World Championship is held only if at least six (6) National Federations in each event <u>start</u> in the competition". This means that it is not enough that we have the required numbers now on paper. We need to have the numbers on water at the start. It is therefore crucial that the entered boats show up at the competition.
