13. Bib Distribution

A. Canoe Slalom Events

- Training bibs must be returned to the Sport Information office before the competition bibs will be distributed.
- CSL Competition bibs will be available from the Sport Information office between 10:00
 17:00 on the Thursday 20th of June.
- A bib deposit of 100 euro per nation is required on collection of the bibs.
- CSL Competition bibs must be returned to the Sport Information office following the competition for the return of the deposit.
- The bibs are allocated in the following way:

K1M	Green-blue	C1W	Orange-blue
K1W	Red-blue	C1M	Blue

B. Extreme Canoe Slalom Events

 For CSLX final phases bibs will be distributed in the start area on the left bank just before the start.

14. Canoe Slalom events – race information

A. Pre start procedure

• There will be a clock facing upstream into the warm-up area showing the race time and the next athletes to start.

B. Start







- The start is located on the river left below the hut.
- Athletes are asked to start in a stationary position facing down the stream holding the start platform.
- The beam line is located at 20m down the left channel.
- The location is marked by a 'Start' sign.
- At the start, there will be a countdown clock showing the time to start. There will be an acoustic signal (10 seconds before start - 4 shorts, 1 long - start).
- Athletes must start within 3 seconds of their start time.
- At all times, the athletes must follow the Starter's instruction or they may be disqualified for the run.

C. Finish

- The finish beam is located 60m below "Niagara" on the second blue rail.
- The beam line will be appropriately indicated.
- Athletes must exit at bottom via the ramp at Equipment Control to pass through equipment control, kiss and cry and the mixed zone.
- Athletes must not leave the finish zone until dismissed by the Equipment Control Judge once they are no longer needed for the ceremonies, anti-doping or equipment control.
- During the finals, the leading athletes must proceed to the "Kiss and Cry" area located after equipment control where TV will interview them.
- There will be access to the broadcast feed in this area. If they drop out of the lead the new leaders will replace them.
- They then proceed via the mixed zone back to the Athlete area.

15. Extreme Canoe Slalom events – race information

A. Final phases

Pre start procedure

- Athletes need to be at the start area 30 minutes prior to their heats to prepare their boats and receive their bibs and final instructions.
- Athletes may warm up in their own CSLX or slalom boat or a CSLX boat provided by the organiser
- Access to start ramp will be from the left bank (scaffolding)





Start Procedure

- Athletes should be settled in the start position on the ramp 1.5 minutes before their start time.
- They should then listen to the sports presentation where they will be introduced to spectators.
- During this time, they should face the TV camera. At all times they should follow the starters instructions.
- The start position is with paddle in one hand to allow the athlete to push off to start.
- Boats will not be held at the start position

Finish

- Finish line will be indicated on the course design map.
- After the finish please go to the dedicated area indicated on the course design map.
- Wait there for 30 secs to gather with other paddlers from your run (for TV) and then exit to kiss and cry zone – there will be someone to let you know if you were qualified for next phase.
- Please put the boat, spraydeck and bib on the trailer for return to the start.
- Helpers will collect the finals bibs at finish and bring them back to the start as quick as possible for the following heats.

Rules reminder

Gate negotiation

16.21.3 - The whole head and both shoulders of the athlete must cross the gate line in accordance with the correct side of the gate and the course plan.

Safety rules

16.25.1 - Athletes are not permitted to push or hold back other athletes or kayaks with their hands or paddles.

16.25.2 - Kayak to kayak contact is permitted but athletes are not permitted to ram their boats into another athletes body.

16.25.3 - Athletes are not permitted to deliberately reach across another Athletes body with their paddle.

Priority is always given to the boat in front.





16. Technical Video Service – set up schedule

- The Technical Video Service will be available at the TVS room located adjacent to Equipment Control from 14.30 on Thursday 20 June 2019.
- Please ensure your team comes between 14.30 and 16.30 on Thursday 20 June 2019 to check their equipment with the signal.
- Remember: to ensure all the systems are working under full load, Teams need to be set up at least 30 minutes prior to the competition each day – even if you are not competing until the afternoon.
- During demonstration runs **only** full length will be filmed and distributed.
- Team members must stay outside the cameras view during the filming of demonstration runs.
- The TVS coordinator will define the switch positions between each camera after the fulllength demonstration run in consultation with National Federations in the TVS room. Once decided this switch plan must remain the same during the relevant phase of the competition.

17. Athlete's video and photo for TV graphics and sport presentation

For the 2019 season, the ICF is planning to shoot a short video (8s without sound) of each athlete to be used during final phases.

To implement this, a video studio will be installed in the media tent. A detailed schedule will be sent to all team leaders with the list of athletes requested.

The ICF requests the outstanding athletes to attend this short shooting session (maximum 2 minutes) with the national uniform on Thursday following the provided schedule.

18. Venue – key areas and services

See venue map attached in appendix 1

A. Team Areas

- NF tents are located at the car park and will be open between 6:30-20:00
- Boat storage is located at the team parking area
- We will provide the following services for athletes: Water, Wireless internet and Toilet.





B. Sport Information Office

- Sport Information Office is located in the lower level of the grandstand and is open from Wednesday from 10.00-18.30 and then each day from 8.00 until 1 hour after the last activity on the course (e.g. demo run, competition).
- The phone number from the office is +421 948 050 720 (Lucia Zahorska)
- Team boxes are located at the Sport Information Office.

C. Medical Services location and availability

- Medical care will be provided by local medical service.
- An ambulance & medical point will be available during the competition
- First aid for participants is available in the First Aid tent located on the top of the hill at the end of the course opposite the "Niagara" drop and only during the competition time from Tuesday until Sunday.

D. Enquiry / Protest desk

• The Enquiry desk is located at the scoring office near the bottom of the course

E. Equipment control

- Equipment Control is located at the top of the ramp, near the TVS tent.
- Self-checking is open: since Tuesday from 9.00 to 17.30.
- Emergency self-checking: Equipment control will be open each day 1h before the 1st boat starts.
- There will be post competition control and random checking with all boats being checked during the Finals.

F. Medals ceremonies

- Location: see map in appendix 1
- Schedule: see competition schedule, after each session of final
- Each team leader must bring national uniform for all finalists to the equipment control station before the start of the final.

G. Doping control station

- The doping control station is located in the Boat House (building next to Hotel)
- Athletes will be notified for Doping Control at the finish area.





H. Car parking

- Car parking for Teams is located near the boat racks.
- Access to this parking is only with parking card distributed through the Accreditation Office.
- The HOC will confirm by Thursday 20 June at 12.00 the allocation additional pass.

I. Warm-up area during competition

• The warm-up will be possible on the right channel. Pay attention to potential rafting.

19. Venue – Accreditation and security

A. Accreditation to the Venue

- The Accreditation Office is located at in the blue container next to main entrance.
- Accreditation will be required from the Thursday 20 June when access control commences.
- The accreditation office will open at 08.00 on Thursday 20 June

B. Security

- The venue is a gated area and will be closed from 20.00 to 7.00 every day.
- There will be surveillance during the night.
- The Organising Committee recommends not leaving anything valuable in the tents, the cars or at the competition venue.
- The Organising Committee will not accept liability in case of theft or disappearance of equipment from the site.
