#### 16. Race information



#### A. Pre start procedure

• There will be a clock facing the lake.

#### **B. Start procedure**

- Athletes may move to the start position once the previous Athlete has broken the beam but must be at the start position 15 seconds before their start.
- The start position is located below the pontoon on river right (yellow pontoon).
- Athletes must start facing downstream.
- In the team events, the 2<sup>nd</sup> athlete holds the handle on the left side of the pontoon and the 3<sup>rd</sup> athletes must start in a stationary position on the left bank below the building.
- The beam line is located at the top of the first drop.
- At the start, there will be a countdown clock (right bank) showing the time to start. There will be an acoustic signal (10 seconds before start - 4 shorts, 1 long - start).
- Athletes must start **within 3 seconds of** their start time.



• At all times, the athletes must follow the Starter's instruction, or they may be disqualified for the run.





### C. Finish

- The finish beam is marked by the two yellow flags on the bank.
- Athletes must exit via the ramp at the equipment control and pass through equipment control, kiss and cry and the mixed zone.
- Athletes must not leave the finish zone until dismissed by the Equipment Control Judge once they are no longer needed for the ceremonies, anti-doping or equipment control.
- During the finals, the leading athletes must proceed to the "Kiss and Cry" area located after equipment control where TV will interview them.
- There will be access to the broadcast feed in this area. If they drop out of the lead the new leaders will replace them.
- They then proceed via the mixed zone.

## D. Start procedure - team events



10.1.4 - In the team runs, all boats must be stationary. The boat in the start gate must activate the timing of the run. The boat can be either A, B, or C

#### E. Enquiry

11.1.2 - In team events, one (1) enquiry per team will be allowed.

11.1.3 - A National Federation may enquire on another National Federation one (1) time during the entire competition.

#### The entire competition consists of team events and individual events.





## 17. Technical Video Service – set up schedule

- The Technical Video Service will be available at the TVS tent from 14.30 on Tuesday 24<sup>th</sup> September.
- Please ensure your team comes between 14.30 and 16.30 on Tuesday 24<sup>th</sup> September to check their equipment with the signal.
- Remember: to ensure all the systems are working under full load, Teams need to be set up at least 30 minutes prior to the competition each day – even if you are not competing until the afternoon.
- During demonstration runs **only** full length will be filmed and distributed.
- Team members must stay outside the cameras view during the filming of demonstration runs.
- The TVS coordinator will define the switch positions between each camera after the fulllength demonstration run in consultation with National Federations in the TVS room.
   Once decided this switch plan must remain the same during the relevant phase of the competition.

# **18.** Athlete's video and photo for TV graphics and sport presentation

- The ICF is planning to shoot a short video (8s without sound) of each athlete to be used during final phases.
- After heats the missing athletes accessing to semi final will be requested to go the green screen studio at the athlete's lounge on Thursday 26<sup>th</sup> September and Friday 27<sup>th</sup> September.
- Each team leader will inform via WhatsApp.
- The ICF requests the outstanding athletes to attend this short shooting session (maximum 2 minutes) with the national uniform following the provided schedule in the athlete's lounge.

#### A. Enquiry / Protest desk

• The Enquiry desk is located at the exit of the finish area.

#### **B. Equipment control**

- Equipment Control is located in the building next to the exit ramp.
- Self-checking is open: Monday 23 and Tuesday 24 from 8.30 to 20.15.
- Emergency self-checking: Equipment control will be open each day 1h before the 1<sup>st</sup> boat starts.
- There will be post competition control and random checking with all boats being checked during the Finals.

#### **C. Medals ceremonies**

- If your athlete is in a final, please bring their National Federation uniform to medal tent aside the return channel.

#### **D. Doping control station**
