II. GENERAL INFORMATION

1. Pitesti city, Arges County residence capital, with a population of 166,637 inhabitants, is situated in the Central-Southern part of Romania, between Southern Carpathians and the Danube, in the North-West of Muntenia, at the confluence of Arges' River and Doamnei's River, at the point of intersection of the parallel of 44°51'30" North latitude with the meridian of 24°52' East longitude.

Pitesti city comprises about 16% of the existing museums (4 of 25) and over 20% of the total number of museums' visitors recorded in Arges County, many cultural institutions, museums, churches and monuments.



GOLESTI MUSEUM


Located between high hills on Arges River terraces Bascov village, our venue is situated in the western sector of the homonym Region.

Bascov Course is located 140 km away from Bucharest International Airport "Henri Coanda", which means 1h and 20 min by bus on the highway.

2. The surroundings have a calm and moderate climate with an annual average temperature ranging between 9-10 degrees in January average being and 22 to 26 degrees at end of September. Well connected with major neighbouring cities road and rail transport infrastructure – Pitesti – the largest town near Bascov – our venue, is located at the crossroads being a communication hub with international opening.

3. The connection with our main cities and towns, including Bucharest, the capital of Romania is provided by European Roads E81/DNA1. This course is located 140 km away from "Henri Coanda" - Bucharest International Airport, which means 1h 20min by bus on the highway.

No matter if you come by plane, train or car, the venue is really easy to locate as it is close to the capital of Romania and the nearest city, Pitesti which offers a wide range of accommodation facilities as well as cultural opportunities for your spare time schedule.



Transport to Pitesti:

Plane:

- Bucharest International “Henri Coanda” Airport – 125 km
- Sibiu International (Hermanstadt) Airport– 160 km

Car:

- Western Border (Hungary / Szeged) – 480 km
- South Border (Bulgaria / Ruse) – 156 km
- East Border (Moldavia) – 350 km

Train: direct line to Pitesti railway station from Bucharest (110 km)

The HOC will organize upon request transportation to/from the airports and railways stations. During the competition, transportation between hotels and venue will be organized by HOC with dedicated companies for competitors and officials. Local transportation is also available for accredited supporters; taxis are available as well.


1. Dates & Program



2. Catering at the venue

Lunch will be at the Star Hotel's Restaurant – extra charge 15 euro/person/day for those who are not accommodated in the official hotels booked through OC.

3. Participation package

Access period starting from the 25th September – 4th October last day of competition is 3rd of October

For those who are not accommodate by HOC, participation fee is 20 euro/ pers./ day. It has

the following services:

- Accreditation fee
- Right of common and operational costs of the venue/ general information at the venue;
- Participation at the opening ceremony;
- Medical care at the course
- Security service at the course;
- Using the shuttle bus service connecting the regatta course and the official hotels during the access period, according to timetable.
- Fully comprehensive insurance of the event;
- Access pass and parking for one trailer and one accredited vehicle (up to 3,5t);
- Mineral water during competition days

Transfer from “Henry Coanda” Airport

The HOC will organize upon request the transport to/from the airports and railways stations up to the official hotels and back.

During the competition transport between hotels and venue will be organized by R.C.F. with dedicated companies for competitors and officials.

Shuttle bus service connecting from regatta course to the official hotels from two day before start of the competition and to the end of the competition, according to timetable or the masters.

There will be 2 Lines – Shuttle Buses/ minibuses at your disposal according competition schedule.

Car rental

Car rental will be available at “Henry Coanda” Airport in Bucharest or at specialized agencies in Pitesti.

4. Services for all accredited persons

• Shuttle bus service connecting from regatta course to the official hotels will start from September 25th till October 3rd, according to timetable will published in the appropriate time.

IX. OTHER INFORMATION

1. Insurance

All official participants of ICF Marathon World Championships are strongly advised to take out a medical insurance in their own countries.

2. Covid-19 Protocol.

The organisation will follow the ICF guidelines concerning Covid-19 protocol. More information in the "Guidebook for team leaders".

3. Medical care

The following medical services are available for all the official participants for World Championships: Medical Centre will operate at the Regatta Course with ambulance and first aid. The cost above the regular care will be covered by the medical insurance policy or direct payment by the person requesting medical services outside Venue. The organizing committee does not take any responsibility for such occasions.

4. Visa PROCEDURE

All participants are kindly requested to contact the Romanian Embassy or Consulate in their country for visa requirements if necessary.

For VISA INVITATION, please fill in the appropriate FORM and you will get the Official Invitation as soon as possible for Romanian Embassy/ Immigration and Customs Procedure

As member of EU, in Romania there is no request for the participants from the European Union Countries.

- To ensure visa requirements each delegation should contact their Country Foreign Ministry.
- Each country must verify on the Romanian Embassy's Consulate Web if visa is mandatory.
- National Federations can contact the HOC in order to help them to facilitate procedures.

5. Boats storage and rental

Boat racks are provided according to the allocation either in the boat storage tent, in the athlete's area. The trailers will be stored in the established area.

6. (ADEL) ALPHA CERTIFICATE

Anti-doping education

For the ICF World Championships, ICF World Cups and ICF Ranking Races and Continental Championships, every athlete, coach and support personnel must pass the relevant anti-doping online course on the Anti-Doping Education Learning platform (ADEL) corresponding to their role.

IT IS NOT NECESSARY TO DO THE EDUCATION IF YOU HAVE DONE THE COURSE ALREADY AND HAVE THE CERTIFICATE

To access to the courses, please click <https://adel.wada-ama.org/learn>

- **Athletes** must complete the International-Level Athletes Education Program.
 - o This course will give athletes information about the dangers of doping, the importance of anti-doping controls and promotes positive attitudes to avoiding doping.
- **Coaches** must complete the High Performance Coaches' Education Program.
 - o This course provides Anti-Doping education for High Performance Coaches and emphasize on why clean sport matters and how it protects athletes' experiences and opportunities in sport.

- **Medical professionals** must complete the Medical Professional's Education Program.
 - o This course will help medical professionals to learn about their role in protecting clean sport and how to operate in line with the anti-doping rules. It will provide information to effectively support athletes so that they meet their anti-doping roles and responsibilities and it will explain what is expected from you when you suspect doping.
- **Other support personnel** are required to complete the High Performance Coaches' Education Program which will give them the best overview of their responsibilities as support personnel.

When creating the account, please enter the correct identity information, as well as correctly select the sport 'Canoe', as the completion of the course will be recorded.

Athlete who has completed the online Anti-Doping education in the previous years are not required to complete again the course this year.

If the language available on ADEL does not allow the athlete to properly complete the course, and to review the values of a clean sport, it can be allowed to pass the National Anti-Doping education course – if available.

Such alternative would need to be agreed beforehand by the ICF.
