COPENHAGEN

Copenhagen, the largest city in Scandinavia, has a history of being one of the world's great design capitals. A city steeped in history, so evident and beautifully preserved in its medieval streets and 17th century canals, sumptuous palaces, copper-roofed town houses and atmospheric cobbled-stoned squares. At the same time it is a city that never stands still.

Though smaller than many other Northern European cities, the Danish capital has proven itself more than able to organise successful large-scale events in innovative and appealing settings.

The city's mix of water activities, tradition and modernity will set the perfect background for the celebration of the 100 year anniversary of the Danish Canoeing Federation.

Denmark and its capital are proud of their environmental record as not only one of the safest, but also as one of the cleanest and most comfortable cities in the world. The crystal-clear waters and the clean air of this capital by the sea provide a comfortable environment for all its visitors.



THE VENUE

Lake Bagsvaerd has been used for international canoeing events for many decades. Our national team trains at this venue every day. We are working on the best conditions for the athletes and coaches for the world championships. We are involving our national athletes in the planning of the team quarters. We are creating different areas with Danish "hygge" [a quality of coziness = feeling warm, comfortable, and safe - has to be experienced]. The coaches can expect a relaxing lounge where they can prepare and watch replays of the races.

The bleachers are only a few meters from the waterfront giving the fans a unique opportunity to get very close to the action on the water.

In other words, we are working very hard to ensure that everyone is feeling comfortable and well taken care of at the world championships.

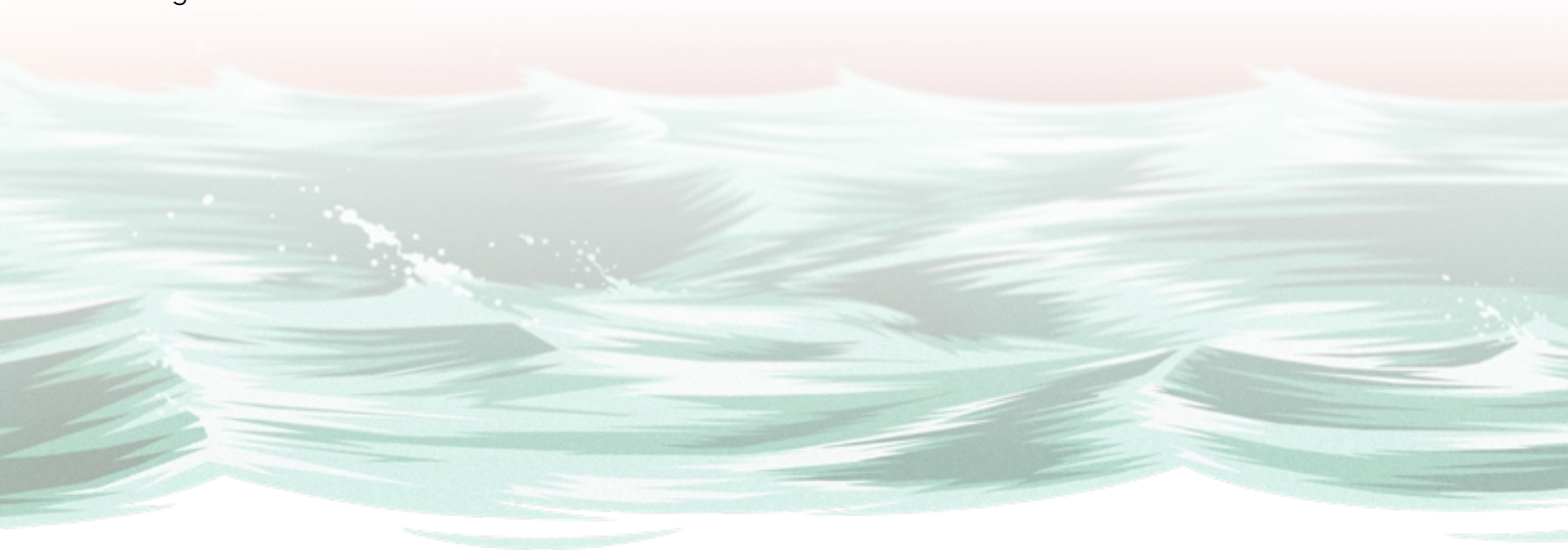

ACCOMMODATION PACKAGE

The accommodation package fee includes:

- Accommodation
- Participation fee (See content on page 16)
- Three meals per day
- Shuttle bus service connecting the regatta course and the official hotels during the access period according to timetable

Excluding: Airport transfer to and from the accredited hotels.

Please keep in mind that because of limited availability of hotel rooms in various categories reservations will be accepted on a "first-come, first-served" basis which means your team will be redirected to a different hotel within the category as long as availability allows it. Thereafter, we will redirect to another category.

The organizing committee does not take responsibility for any extra services of the hotel, such as the minibar, parking, telephone, etc. These costs are to be paid directly to the hotel. Check-in time is 3:00PM. The rooms are to be vacated by 10:00AM on the day of departure (Upon request the hotels will provide storage rooms for an additional fee).

In Denmark all of our accommodation options have a very high standard. Note that shuttle service will be available from the official event hotels only.

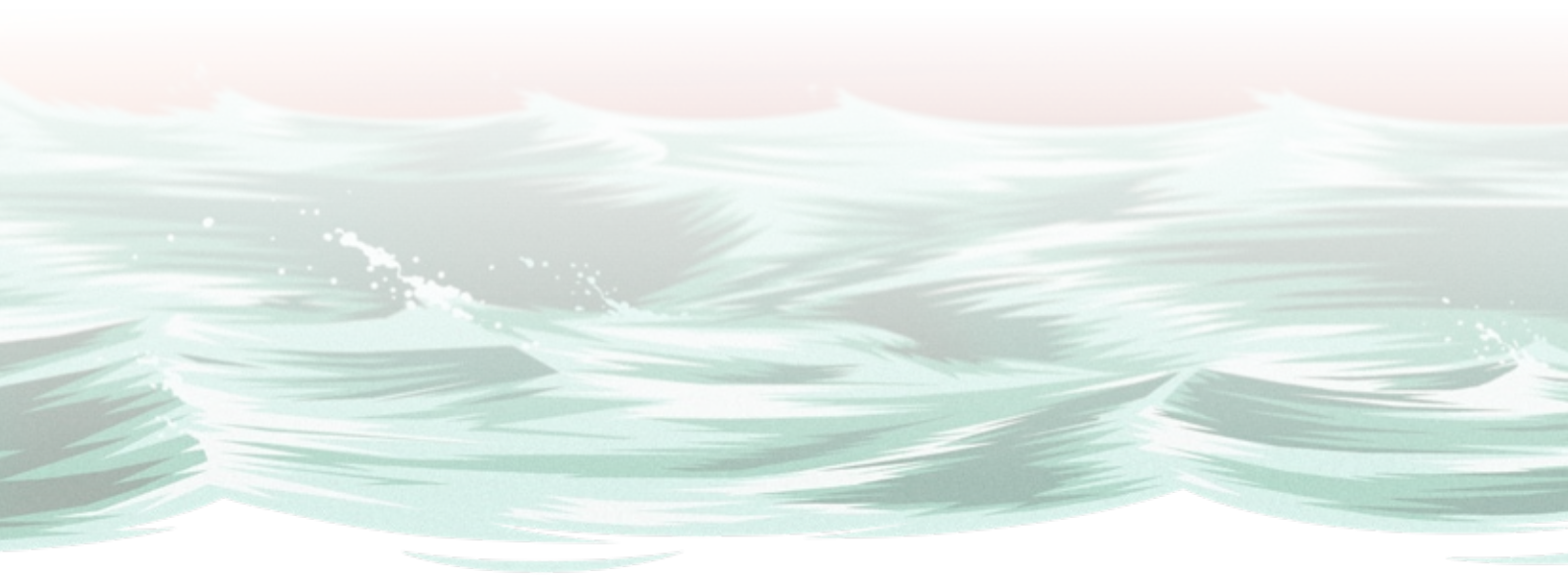
Shuttle bus stops are right next to the hotels.

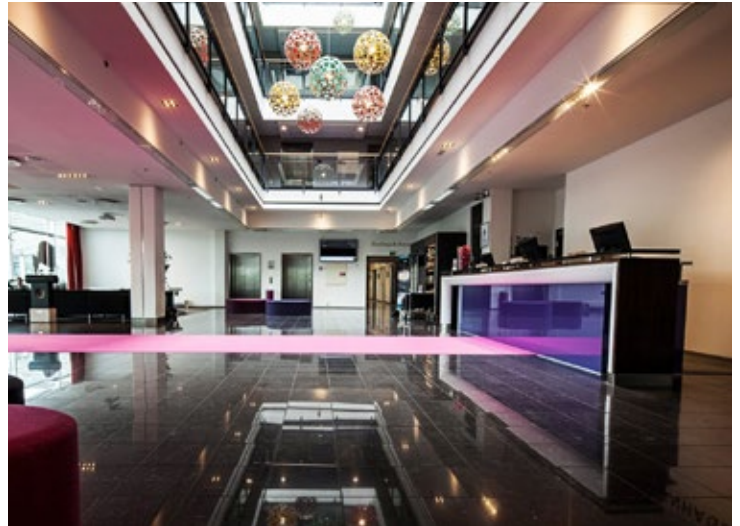

PARTICIPATION FEE

Participation fee of € 25 per day is payable for the days during the access period.

In the case where accommodation is booked independently and NOT through the organising committee you are still required to pay the participation fee of € 25 per person, per day, which includes the following:

Non-competition days:

- Issue of accreditation card/pass
- Accreditation services
- Info desk
- Usage of the course during opening hours
- Security on the course
- Qualified lifeguard on the course during opening hours
- Medical care at the course during opening hours
- Drinking water
- Reusable water bottle
- Toilets
- Showers
- Electricity power
- Washing facilities for boats and equipment
- Outdoor boats storage facilities
- Boat measurements and control facilities
- Boats and equipment repair services
- Cars and trailers parking
- Transport to and from the HOC hotels

Competition days:

- Doping control
- Live streaming of the races
- Timing and results system
- Boat numbers distribution
- Results and information announcements
- Merchandising facilities
- Athletes recovery areas

Additional Rates:

- Airport pick-up service from Copenhagen Airport to the venue upon arrival and from venue/hotel upon departure: € 20 per person return
- Parking for additional vehicles are available for € 50 per car (limited availability)

Lunch at the athletes and coaches dinner hall can only be bought as part of the accommodation package.



PARA SPORT IN DENMARK

This is the first time that the Danish Canoeing Federation is hosting a para championship. However, Denmark has strong traditions for parasport. Parasport Denmark has hosted several major international championships in the past years. Parasport Denmark is supporting the Danish Canoeing Federation in hosting this championship.

In general, Denmark is focusing on accessibility for all in public buildings, hotels, and in the city. Regulations require all new buildings to have high accessibility standards.

Scandic and Comwell have specific special needs para-rooms whereas all our hotels have accessible rooms. Please make sure that you describe your needs on the hotel form for us to give you the best possible stay in Denmark.

We are working on an on-demand basis for transportation for the para-athletes who use wheelchairs. We will inform you regarding this option in bulletin 2 and on the website.

Comwell:

Comwell Portside will be opening its doors in the spring of 2021. This large, green, brand new hotel will be both close to the venue and the center of Copenhagen. With 20 wheelchair accessible rooms it will be a perfect option for the para-athletes.

Scandic:

With the help of smart solutions, Scandic designs hotels where all of the guests can be happy. Scandic prioritize accessibility in both their newly built and renovated hotels, constantly improving the standard of what they can offer. As well as technical solutions and practical matters, they believe in care and consideration.



VISA & INSURANCE

Denmark is a member state of the European Union (EU). As such, all accredited participants who are citizens of the European Community are granted free access to Denmark. Participants who require a visa to enter Denmark will upon request, receive an invitation letter from the Danish Canoe Federation, once their participation is confirmed.

INSURANCE AND MEDICAL SERVICE

All participants are firmly advised to obtain appropriate medical insurance from their respective federations.

First aid and emergency medical service will be available at Bagsvaerd Regatta Course, from September 11-19 to everyone requiring medical assistance.

The hospital is situated 8 minutes from the regatta course and will be on standby to cover the needs during the event.



TERMS OF PAYMENT

The accommodation and participation fees are to be paid as follow:

Hotel reservation deadline is Friday July 9, 2021 however, we encourage you to book early to secure your preferred hotel category. After the organizing committee confirms your booking, 60% of the total amount will be invoiced with 8 days payment terms. The remaining 40% will have to be paid by August 26, 2021.

The participation fee (for those who book their accommodation privately) has to be paid upon invoice from the organising committee.

CANCELLATION TERMS

Should you cancel your booking, a charge will be made equivalent to any loss suffered by the organising committee, as itemized below. The amount of any cancellation fee will be calculated as a percentage of the accommodation fee according to the following period of notice given:

No forfeit if cancelled before July 9, 2021

50% forfeit if cancelled in the period of July 9 - July 31, 2021

100% forfeit if cancelled after July 31, 2021
