- I started paddling at the age of 10 in my local river, the Noguera Pallaresa in the Pyrenees. Since then, Canoeing has been the driving force of my entire live.
- I competed in Slalom, Freestyle, WW, Polo and Ocean Racing.
- I started organizing competitions when I was competing in slalom in the early 90's.
- In 2000 I introduced Freestyle into the RFEP, in 2004 into ECA and in 2005 into the ICF. In 2007 I was elected as Chairman of the first Freestyle committee and an ICF board member at the Hong Kong Congress.
  As an organiser, I was head organiser of 2 x Freestyle World Championships, 2 x Freestyle European Championships, The YOG World qualifier event 2018 in Barcelona, and the 2018 Mediterranean Games Sprint competition.
  Within the ICF I've been Freestyle chair since 2007. I've also undertaken a variety of other tasks and developing also different tasks as follows: Member of the ICF Olympic program commission, Chair of the Sources of Income group and Jury member at the 2021 Olympic Games (slalom),

### Development

- Creation of the HUB project, that fix a venue for development per region, with the aim to be more effective in long term development policies and help environmental education in paralel with the growth of athletes, judges, officials in the region of each HUB.
- Help NFs and Continental Associations with their development linking projects with the different
  - activity blocks (whitewater and calm waters) along with the possibility of creating global HUBs of all disciplines together.
- The objective will be to increase participation in ICF events by 20% in the next 6 years. In return also set real activity for each country, in order to create a more sustainable base of participation.
- Set real activity levels in the countries that are included in the 20% increase in participation, this needs to be non-negotiable.
- Integration of the recreational activities in the HUBs to increase the base quicker and to be able to create canoe culture.
- To place gender, race and disability equaly at the heart of all development projects. Where possible, to place emphasis on developing countries, to enhance lifestyle opportunities.
