Oklahoma City – The Modern Frontier

Located in America's heartland, Oklahoma City's western heritage and lively atmosphere combine with an innovative spirit you won't find anywhere else.

Known for its friendliness, the OKC metro area has undergone major transformation in recent decades with more than \$1.8 billion invested in quality-of-life improvements including sports and recreation venues, updated schools, changes to create a vibrant, walkable downtown and improving neighborhoods.

RIVERSPORT

RIVERSPORT and the Boathouse District are located adjacent to downtown Oklahoma City at the intersection of highways I35 and I40, the crossroads of the nation. The \$100M+ development includes a series of iconic boathouses and four- story Canoe Sprint finish line tower, a whitewater center, a six-story adventure course, a zip line, surfing and an indoor alpine ski simulator. RIVERSPORT is a US Olympic and Paralympic Training Site and hosts national and international canoe slalom races on the whitewater course, and national and international rowing and canoe sprint regattas on the adjacent Oklahoma River – the only permanently lighted race venue in the world.

RIVERSPORT is also located within walking distance of downtown's Bricktown entertainment district which means great hotels, restaurants and entertainment are just steps away.

The State of Oklahoma

With numerous industries and a growing base of companies, Oklahoma is positioned for a strong future in aviation/ aerospace, biotechnology, energy, healthcare, a developing film industry and travel/ tourism.

In September, 2021, the state celebrated the opening of the First Americans Museum. Located on the Oklahoma River east of the Boathouse District, the world-class museum features Native American history, culture, food, and art.

TRANSPORTATION TO OKLAHOMA CITY

COMPETITION VENUE

RIVERSPORT Rapids was built in 2016 and hosted US Canoe Slalom and several US Canoe Slalom Championships. The course is 305 meters (1,000 feet) long and drops 510 centimeters (16'9") from start to finish. This recirculated water pumped course is estimated to be level WW III-IV at 10 m³/s (350 ft3/s) flows during a competition.



PRE-COMPETITION TRAINING PERIOD

The HOC offers a pre-competition training period from 18 April to 1 May, for the 2022 PAN AMERICAN CANOE SLALOM CHAMPIONSHIPS, and the Canadian and USA Team Trials participants at the cost of \$25/hour/person. Registration coming soon.

OFFICIAL TRAINING PERIOD

The official training for the competition starts on 2 May and ends on 5 May after the morning session. The water cost of the official training and competition period is covered by the HOC.

Pre-Competition and Official Training Period will be organized in groups according to schedule. The official training schedule will be published under: https://www.riversportokc.org/events. Expect two (non-exclusive) training slots for each federation per day, except on 5 May, when one (non-exclusive) training slot will be available for each NF.

COMPETITIONS

The Pan American Championships and Canadian Team Trials will begin on Friday, 6 May and conclude on Saturday, 7 May. The USA Team Trials will begin on Friday, 6 May and conclude on Sunday, 8 May. The competition schedule for the entire event will be published after the close of the Nominal Entry period.

The following events will be offered during the competition: MC1, MK1, WC1, WK1, MX1, and WX1.

COMPETITION RULES

2022 PAN AMERICAN CANOE SLALOM CHAMPIONSHIPS will be run in accordance with ICF Canoe Slalom Competition Rules and COPAC Canoe Slalom Competition Rules (race format and advancements).

ACCREDITATION & REGISTRATION FEE

Accreditation passes (credentials) will be required to access the venue and will be available at Registration for registered athletes and coaches. Registration and race information will be headquartered in the RIVERSPORT Whitewater Center.

Registration fee

The registration fee is \$125 USD per Athlete (Aa), Team Leader (AC), Technical Staff (Ao), Medical Staff (Am), and includes a commemorative T-shirt and celebration meal after the completion of the PAN AMERICAN CANOE SLALOM CHAMPIONSHIPS.

NIE Waivers for foreign athletes and staff

The previous US waiver process ended on 8 November 2021, when a requirement of full vaccination against COVID-19 came into effect for all foreign nationals entering the US.

At this time all foreign nationals entering the US are required to present the following:

- Passport
- Visa or ESTA
- Negative COVID test taken within 1 day of travel
- Proof of full vaccination against COVID-19
 - Or, proof of exception from the requirement

The US Olympic and Paralympic Committee is working on a potential travel waiver for certain categories that do not meet these requirements.

ICF ONLINE ENTRIES & ACCREDITATION SYSTEM – SDP

Principles

Entries and accreditation requests must be made by the National Federation using the ICF's online entries system (SDP): https://icf.msl.es/icf/main.jsp

Nominal entries

Numerical entries close: 5 February, 2022

Nominal entries close: 5 April, 2022

Each athlete competing must be entered by name.

Team personnel must also be submitted for accreditation at this time. These entries will be used to produce accreditation cards for all teams.

Reminder

Entries or accreditation requests sent directly to the committee or the competition organizer will NOT be accepted.

HEALTH AND SANITARY MEASURES

RIVERSPORT and the ACA will be following health and sanitary measures designed to reduce risk of exposure to COVID 19 valid at the time of the pre-competition training and competition. More details about the details of the COVID-19 mitigations will be published in Bulletin #2.

EXTRA SERVICES

Medical Services

During the event period (May 6-8, 2022) we will provide a first aid service. Please note that this medical service will cover only emergency cases and that all participants are responsible for arranging, at their cost, their own international medical insurance policy. During the training period the NFs are responsible for their participants.

Medical facilities will be included in Bulletin #2.

Spectators

Admission to racing will be free; parking will be \$10.
