



ATHLETE NAME AND COUNTRY CODE STICKERS

Each athlete's name sticker must be applied on all boats for ICF Canoe Sprint and Paracanoe competitions. In order for canoes and kayaks to be presented in a standard manner, name stickers must be positioned at the same point on every boat. The country code sticker will be applied on all boats and at the same place for each ICF Canoe Sprint competition and will be checked at the Boat Control. It is the participating National Federations' responsibility to provide the stickers to their athletes.

NEW in 2022: Athletes' name stickers have been modified to match the re-formatted TV graphics.

The last name is now placed after the initial of the first name.

ANTI-DOPING EDUCATION

In accordance with ICF rules, every athlete, coach and support personnel must pass the relevant anti-doping online course on the Anti-Doping Education Learning platform (ADEL) corresponding to their role before the first day of competition.

Athletes who have completed the online Anti-Doping education in the previous years are not required to complete the course again this year.

TRANSPORTATION

Airport arrivals/departures

Our service dates for providing transportation start July 29 and end August 8, 2022. Any transportation service provided within this window will experience a full-service solution with the support of Canoe '22 staff, volunteers, and transport providers. During these dates, transportation will be provided to designated Canoe '22 accommodations, competitions, and special event sites only, with no exceptions.

Shuttle transportation will be provided based on the arrival and departure time provided by your federation to Tournkey. This service is a paid service of \$45 per person, one way. You will be required to have paid your bill in full prior to arrival. Our staff on the ground will be checking to ensure that the people using the transportation system match those registered within the event. Any accommodations required for those travelling in wheelchairs or with other accessibility needs must be clearly communicated at the time of booking. Access to on-demand wheelchair accessible vehicles is extremely limited in Halifax, and as such should be coordinated through the resources available to Canoe '22.

Transportation outside of this service window can be coordinated and booked on your behalf. However, it is important to note that we will not have staff or volunteers on the ground to support your arrival or departure. You will be provided with the service provider's email and/or phone number(s) in the event of any delays or issues. This information will be provided directly to you based on the bookings you have made with Tournkey.

If you do not submit your flight information prior to July 8, 2022, we cannot guarantee that you will have transportation available but we will accommodate on a best-effort basis.

For departures, please note that you will be dropped off at the airport three hours prior to your departure time for both domestic and international flights. We are following the recommendations of Halifax Stanfield International Airport. These timelines are subject to change based on local regulations and service capabilities.



Training and competition transportation

A shuttle service will run between accommodation venues and the competition venue July 29th–August 8th. A detailed schedule will be provided closer to the event date.

Shuttle schedules will be posted at each accommodation and the competition venue. A digital format will be provided that can be shared with team leaders. While Canoe '22 is making every effort to offer an inclusive delivery model for para-athletes, it is possible that paratransit will be a booked service at the event. Should this be the case, Canoe '22 organizers will provide a process to all federations ahead of arrival that will detail how these bookings will occur.

Because of supply and labour shortages being experienced in Canada, Canoe '22 is still securing additional inventory. As we finalize our process and ability to support those with accessibility needs, we will communicate more details.

ACCREDITATION

The Accreditation Centre is located next to the competition area. Accreditation pick-up will take place at Oakwood House, 20 Boathouse Lane.

Team leaders are requested to go to the Accreditation Centre directly upon arrival. Team leaders are required to arrive alone. We request that you use the disinfectants available before filling out any paperwork with our team.

Phase one of the accreditation process will be to check accommodation needs, to confirm payment of all invoices, and to approve the final rooming list.

Phase two will be to collect all accreditation for team members. All participants in the event must be accredited — no access is granted to the course without an accreditation pass.

Please note that you will not be accredited until you have a zero balance with the Organizing Committee. Before leaving the Accreditation Centre, Team Leaders will be asked to leave their email address and mobile number as well as the mobile number of the team's head coaches so they can be reached anytime during the competition in case of an urgent matter.
