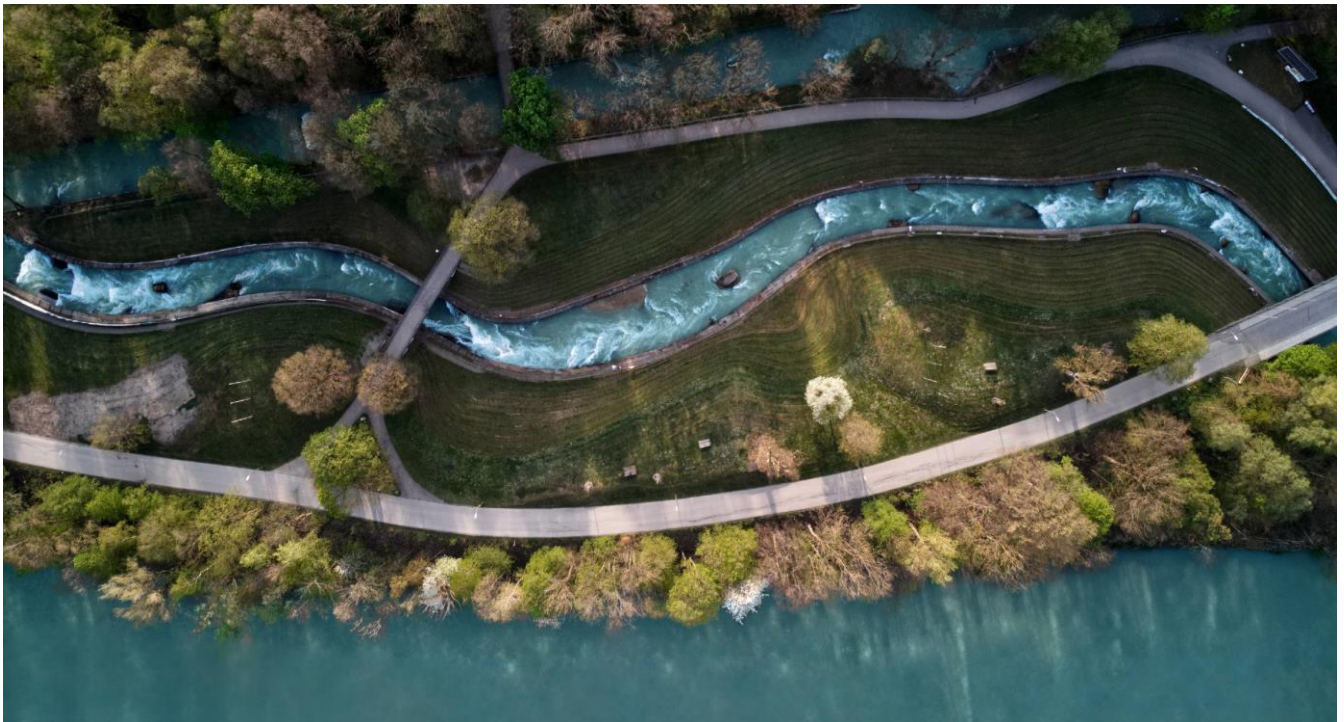

Dear paddlers, dear canoeing friends,

It is our pleasure to invite you and your national federations to the ICF Canoe Slalom World Championships to be held in Augsburg from 26th to 31st of July 2022.

50 years after the Olympic Games of 1972, canoe slalom's elite athletes will return to the legendary Eiskanal, the world's first artificial canoe slalom stadium. This is where our sport celebrated its Olympic debut with 50'000 spectators.

The Olympic spirit has been present at the Eiskanal ever since. The venue is a role model for sustainable Olympic facilities, being in service for both competitive and recreational sports non-stop, and perpetually hosting national and international sporting events.

The Augsburg Olympic Park, built in 1972, is currently undergoing a general redevelopment in line with heritage preservation, thus providing state-of-the-art conditions regarding infrastructure and organisational requirements for the 2022 ICF Canoe Slalom World Championships. Furthermore, the Olympic course is part of Augsburg's water management system which has been listed by UNESCO as World Heritage Site in 2019.

The ICF Canoe Slalom World Championships are set to be the city's flagship event in 2022. Augsburg's international guests as well as its people can look forward to sporting and social highlights. The excellent performances of athletes will be accompanied by manifold cultural events throughout the city.

The city of Augsburg feels honoured being nominated to host its fourth ICF Canoe Slalom World Championships in 2022, proudly remembering the events in 1957, 1985 and 2003.

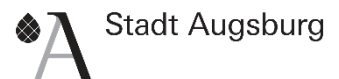

How to get to Augsburg



Location of the Olympic Park at the Eiskanal in the relation to major cities:

By car

Augsburg is connected to the German road system by Motorway: Autobahn A8, Highways: Bundesstraße 2, Bundesstraße 17, Bundesstraße 300. The road system in Germany is free of charge.

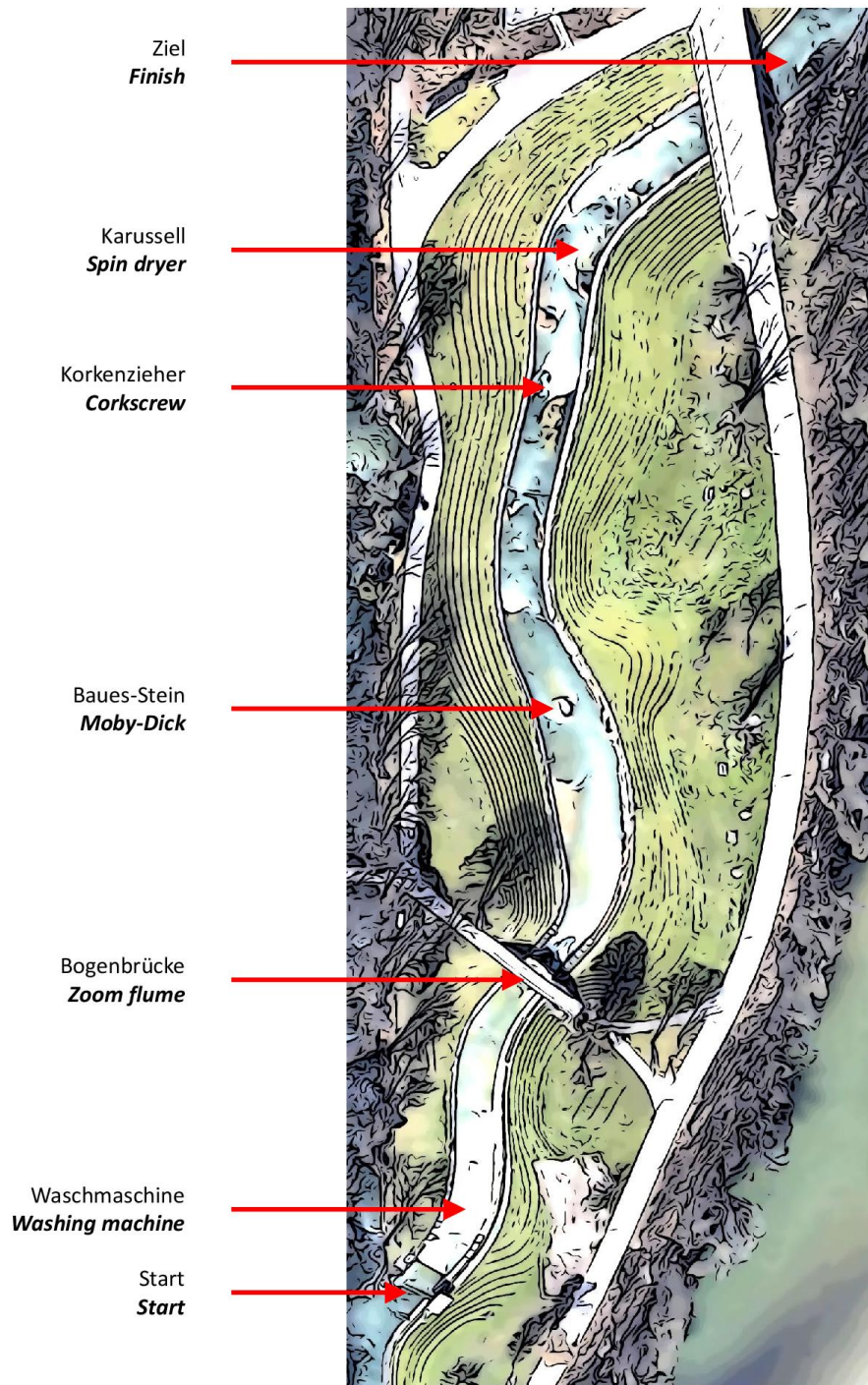

By train

Augsburg is part of the German high speed train system (ICE) with direct connection to all major German cities. The distance from Augsburg Central Station to the Olympic Park is 5 km. The railway station Augsburg Hochzoll is approx. 1 km away from the Olympic Park (just on the opposite side of the river Lech) and can be reached within a 10 to 15 minute walk.

The Venue

The 2022 ICF Canoe Slalom World Championships will take place on the legendary whitewater course "Eiskanal" at the Olympic Park in Augsburg. The Eiskanal was built for the Olympic Games in 1972. Since these days it has been serving as a model and a source of ideas for numerous canoe slalom courses all around the world.



Technical attributes:

The competition course in Augsburg is 280 m long. The elevation drop amounts to a total of 4 m, and the water speed is 3 to 6 m/sec. At 10 to 12 m wide and 40 to 120 cm deep, the Augsburg Eiskanal boasts a difficulty rating of Class III whitewater. 35 concrete obstacles create the whitewater's own eddies, waves and rapids. Equal conditions are guaranteed for all participants thanks to the weirs, which control the volume of water allowed in from the natural flow.

- You must submit through SDP the number of athletes you will enter into each event.
- Please also give indicative numbers for the overall number of athletes and team personnel who will attend the event with your delegation.

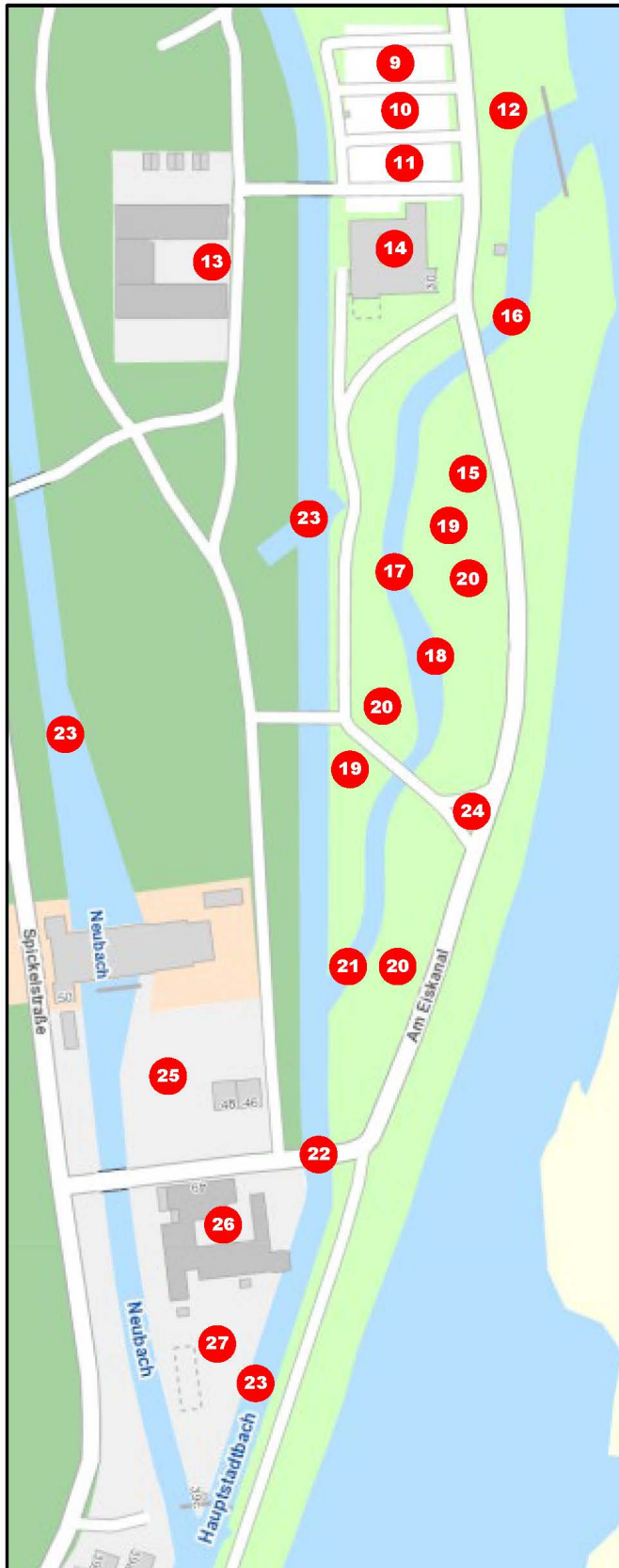
NOMINAL ENTRIES

- Nominal entries close: 17/07/2022
- Each athlete competing must be entered by name.
- Team personnel must also be submitted for accreditation at this time. These entries will be used to produce the accreditation cards for all teams.

REMINDER

Entries or accreditation requests sent directly to the committee or the event organiser will NOT be accepted.

All nominal entries proposed after the deadline will have to be dealt as a late entry and be accepted by the Chairman of the ICF Canoe Slalom Committee according to the ICF competition rules.

Visa

EU nationals

EU nationals do not require a visa to enter the Federal Republic of Germany.

Non-EU nationals

Generally speaking, all other foreigners require a visa for stays in Germany. A visa is not required for visits of up to 90 days in a 180-day-period for nationals of those countries for which the European Community has abolished the visa requirement.

Bodies responsible for issuing visas

Under German law, responsibility for issuing visas lies with the missions of the Federal Republic of Germany, i.e. its embassies and consulates general. Ratione loci competence (local responsibility) for issuing the visa lies with the mission responsible for the area in which the applicant has his/her ordinary residence or domicile. Ratione materiae competence (subject matter responsibility) lies with the mission of the Schengen state in whose territory the sole or main destination is situated.

Visa fees

Since 14 May 2008, the fee for all types of visas has been EUR 60. Exemptions may be possible.

Time required to process a visa application

As a rule, missions require between two and ten working days to decide on an application for a short stay visa. Applications for visas entitling the holder to a longer stay or to take up gainful employment may take several months to process. During the peak travel season there may be a waiting period for making an application to a German mission. Persons requiring a visa to enter Germany should therefore submit their applications in good time.

Application procedure

As a rule, applicants must submit visa applications, together with all necessary documents, in person at the German mission responsible for their place of residence. In order to avoid time consuming requests for additional information or documentation, applicants should consult the website of the respective mission well in advance of their departure date to find out about the visa procedure and about the documentation which has to be submitted.
