

INTRODUCTION

Paddle Australia (PA) is the National Federation for Canoe and Paddle Sports. PA is affiliated with the International Canoe Federation (ICF), Paralympics Australia and the Australian Olympic Committee (AOC). We are excited to host the 2023 ICF Canoe Ocean Racing World Championships and Masters Championships in Perth, Western Australia from 30 November – 3 December. Activities and downwind runs will be facilitated from the 27 November.

The 2023 ICF Canoe Ocean Racing World Championships will cater to Junior, Under 23, Open and Para competitors. The 2023 ICF Canoe Ocean Racing Masters Championships will cater to all age categories as specified in the 2023 ICF Canoe Ocean Racing Rules (from 35 years+). The 2023 ICF Canoe Ocean Racing World Championships will be an open event, meaning participation is uncapped in all categories. The 2023 ICF Canoe Ocean Racing Masters Championships remains open in accordance with the 2023 ICF Canoe Ocean Racing Rules as a Level 4 event.







ENTRIES

Registrations are open for the highly anticipated 2023 ICF Canoe Ocean Racing World Championships and Masters Championships.

All participants seeking to enter the 2023 ICF Canoe Ocean Racing World Championships and Masters Championships must be a member of their National Federation and provide proof of membership at the point of registration. Federations are welcome to provide one letter verifying membership of all competitors. Registrations will be made online via the event website.

Please note – every competitor in the Junior, U23 and Open age categories must also be entered by their National Federation into the ICF SDP (Sports Data Platform) system. Please ensure your National Federation has completed this on your behalf.

The official start list will be published in tandem to the official Race Guide

All athletes must have completed all entry requirements to compete in the competition.

COURSE

SINGLES (SS1)

The course is approximately 21km from Bathers Beach Fremantle. The start is a deep water start and paddlers will paddle out 2km before turning north towards Scarborough Beach.

There will be one buoy off Scarborough Beach with paddlers needing to keep the buoy on their right-hand side before heading into the beach for a short run finish. Paddlers will need to finish on beach at the finish line to complete the race.

COURSE

DOUBLES (SS2)

The doubles course is 15.5km starting off the southern end of Port beach. The start is a deep water start with the start line approximately 500 metres offshore. There will be one buoy off Scarborough Beach with paddlers needing to keep the buoy on their right-hand side before heading into the beach for a short run finish. Paddlers will need to finish on beach at the finish line to complete the race. Only one paddler in each SS-2 crew will need to run onto the beach and finish at the finish line. This paddler must be the paddler that wears the timing band.









TIMING, TRACKING AND EQUIPMENT

The safety of all competitors is our priority. Please ensure you understand and adhere to the information below.

Scrutineering will be in place before each race. All athletes must have their equipment scrutineered before participating in the race/s.

TIMING

- All competitors will be given a timing device for the events they are entered. Your timing device will be given to you on the day of the race at the registration station at the start location.
- Your timing device will be registered to your name.
- Your timing device must be worn on your ankle for the duration of the race.
- Timing devices must not be switched between athletes.
- Athletes are asked to return their timing chip at the end of their race at the designated drop off point following the race on the beach at Scarborough.
- For athletes racing in multiple races, you will receive a different timing chip for each of your races.





TRACKING

- All competitors will be given a GPS tracker for the events they are entered. Your GPS tracker will be given to you on the day of the race at the registration station at the start location.
- Your GPS Tracker will be registered to your name.
- GPS trackers must not be switched between athletes.
- The GPS tracker must be placed in your PFD pocket for the duration of your race.
- Your tracking device will only be activated during the race times.
- Athletes are asked to return their timing chip at the end of their race at the designated drop off point following the race on the beach at Scarborough.
- For athletes racing in multiple races, you will receive a different GPS tracker for each of your races.

Athletes who lose their GPS Tracker or who do not return their GPS tracker will be charged a \$30 AUD fee.







TIMING, TRACKING AND EQUIPMENT

EQUIPMENT

· Event number sticker:

- Athletes are asked to clearly display their event number sticker on the front left-hand side of their boat.
- All athletes will be provided event number stickers when they collect their registration pack from event administration.
- Athletes must have their event sticker in the correct location on their boat to ensure that their craft meets ICF standards in accordance with the ICF Canoe Ocean Racing Rules.

· Country stickers:

- All athletes are asked to clearly display their countries sticker on their boat.
- It is the athlete's responsibility to source country stickers. Country stickers should be clearly displayed on the front cockpit of the craft about should be at least 10cm high.
- Athletes must have their country sticker in the correct location on their boat to ensure that their craft meets ICF standards in accordance with the ICF Canoe Ocean Racing Rules.
- Need to purchase a country sticker for your boat? Here are some local options in Perth:

Safety Equipment

- All athletes must wear a PFD which conforms to the minimum requirements of ISO 12402-5 (level 50). PFD's must be:
 - bright in colour;
 - be able to float a weight of 7.03kgs;
 - carry appropriate labelling, be in sound condition;
 - have pockets and
 - be worn as the manufacturer intended.
- All athletes must wear a leash. The leash needs to be in sound working order and attached to a secure strong point on the craft.
- All athletes must carry a pea less whistle.
- All athletes must carry an orange smoke aerial flare in accordance with local maritime laws.

<u> ANTI-DOPING</u>

All athletes competing in an ICF level event (World Cup's, Ranking events, Master Championships, World Championships etc.) must complete the International- Level Athletes Education Program prior to competing in the event in question. Athletes who have completed the online Anti-Doping education in the previous years are not required to complete the course again this year.
