1. INTRODUCTION

In this publication you will see a change in the title of the competition which has boldly added an "Open ICF Ranking Competition" into the customary championships.

Both events have equal importance due to the fact that ACC has designated the 2023 Asian Canoe Slalom Junior & U23 Championships as a validation event for participation in the 2023 ICF Canoe Slalom World Championships in Lee Valley later this year (refer to Chapter 13,13.2.4 Canoe Slalom Competition Rules 2023).



The addition of an Open ICF Ranking Competition was consequently decided upon based on the new entry rule to the World Cup series (refer to Chapter 15, 15.3.2) which is taking effect from 1 January 2023, and supported by the ICF and the host country to offer the chance for athletes who wish to earn a ranking to join the World Cups. All athletes are welcome to the race to earn points.

Contents in the Bulletin no. 2 feature on events and entry rules of the ranking race and other information missing from Bulletin no.1. Therefore, both publications should be used together as the main source of references for thorough comprehension.

6. DOPING CONTROL

Doping control will be performed throughout the competition in accordance with the ICF Anti-Doping requirements and WADA standards.

7. ATHLETE/TEAM SERVICES

The HOC provides facilities at the venue for participating teams as follows:














The packages include full board of three meals per day.

9. TRANSPORT

9.1 Airport Transfer Service

There are two transfer options to choose from:

- Bus (for 9 up to 36 passengers)
- Van (for 4 passengers)

The fare is USD 80/passenger/round trip*

* Round trip means transport of passengers from the Suvarnabhumi International Airport and the hotel and return on the arrival and departure days.

Please note that the bus or the van can accommodate only passengers and their luggage, but not boats. If the team flies with boats, please notify the









HOC in advance to arrange for boat pick-up service, the charge is THB 2,500 per direction per truck (maximum load of 8 boats). Payment will be made in Thai baht cash to the driver.

10. BOAT RENTAL SERVICE

For teams that cannot bring their own boats, the HOC has limited number of boats to rent since boats will be first prioritized for use in the ACC development program. We will do our best to help solve the problem so please contact the HOC for booking in advance as soon as possible for proper planning. The service is first come first served and once all available boats are allocated will stop. The quality or size of the boat cannot be guaranteed.

11. MEDICAL SERVICES

A first-aid room with medical personnel is situated on the first floor of the dormitory building in the training center compound. An ambulance van will remain on duty during the Championships period.

- Passport holders of Brazil, Korea (ROK) and Peru are entitled for tourist visa exemption scheme.
 Meanwhile, Thailand also holds bilateral agreements on visa exemption for holders of diplomatic, official and ordinary passports for a visit of not exceeding 90 days with Brazil, Korea (ROK) and Peru.
 Passport holders of Vietnam and Hong Kong are entitled for tourist visa exemption scheme.
 Meanwhile Thailand also holds bilateral agreements on visa exemption for holders of diplomatic, and entitled for tourist visa exemption scheme.
- official and ordinary passports for a visit of not exceeding 30 days with Vietnam and Hong Kong.
- *** From 1 October 2022 to 31 March 2023, the period of stay for visa-on-arrival is extended from 15 to 30 days.
- From 1 October 2022 to 31 March 2023, the period of stay for tourist visa exemption scheme is extended 30 to 45 days. In addition, the period of stay for bilateral agreements on visa exemption are extended from 14 and 30 days to 45 days.









12.3 Coronavirus (COVID-19) Travel Rules

Since 1 October 2022 Thailand has lifted the requirement of the RT-PCR test before entry or proof of vaccination and fully re-opened to tourism. As a result,

health insurance is not required.

We recommend travelers from China and India to study your respective country's rules of entry if the RT-PCR test is needed before travelling back. If yes, please inform the HOC upon your arrival to arrange for the test. The hospital's charge for the test will be billed directly to you.

For health reason of all, the HOC strongly recommends athletes and team officials to wear face masks and to keep social distancing while in public places where you will find Thai people are still wearing face masks at large.
