5. Pre-race requirements (checklist)

a. Anti-doping education program

All athletes, coaches, and support personnel must have completed the relevant anti-doping online course on the WADA Anti-Doping Education Learning platform (ADEL) corresponding to their role. The certificates showing completion should be sent by each National Federation to sue.natoli@canoeicf.sport. Previous certificates are still valid for this season. There is no need to repeat the program unless the person's role changes (e.g. athlete becoming coach).

Accreditations will not be issued until the certificates are marked off.

b. Entry list checking

Once the team leader arrives on the competition site, they must go to the accreditation office to check:

- the entry list per nation and notify any modifications
- the national anthem
- the national flag

c. Official training sessions requests

If any NF has a specific request concerning the official training sessions for a competition, these ones must be sent by email to the technical managers: <u>Thomas Rosset</u> and <u>Manon Bocquet</u> before the nominal entries' deadline (10 days minimum prior to the event). No requests will be considered after that deadline.

The ICF team will try to answer at their best to those requests when building the official training schedule. Do not consider that a request sent is officially stated.

d. Guidelines for advertising on equipment

i. Generic guidelines

For canoe slalom boats, ICF Nation and athlete's name stickers are mandatory. Further information can be found in the <u>ICF guidelines for advertising trademark</u> identification on equipment document.

For Kayak Cross boats, only the Nation Sticker will be required. It has to be placed freely in a suitable place in front of the cockpit. The actual location may vary depending on the model of the boat. The Nation sticker is the same dimensions as for the Canoe Slalom boats.

There is a sponsor sticker to place below the NOC code on the boat. These will be distributed with the accreditations.



e. Technical Video Service

A TVS feed will be available for all events and demonstration runs.

ICF TVS manager: Hans Peter WEISS

Remember; at all times, whether you choose the cloud or download solution a bottle neck is created if many teams decide to "download all files" at the same time. Please be selective with the files you need to download during the competition and if you want all files download the rest outside competition time. Then it works for everyone!!





a) Cloud solution

The TVS cloud solution is available to access the TVS files. Each NF must register on the 2025 Canoe Slalom TVS management form to indicate which person from the team will get access to the Dropbox folder for downloading the videos (one person per nation). Teams who do not register through that form could not receive the link and they will not be able to access the TVS feed.

- To connect to the Dropbox folder, simply click on the link receive by email.
- NF TVS manager can visualize directly the videos on the Dropbox website. All the files of a run (full run and gate line cameras) are available between 60 and 90 sec after the athlete cross the finish line.
- To download the files locally on your computer, or to visualize the files <u>online</u> no Dropbox subscription is needed. The payment is necessary only if you want <u>to store</u> more than 2Gb of files on a Dropbox account.

 <u>Remark:</u> to avoid any pay-wall, use the link on a computer (not a smartphone) having no Dropbox application installed

As mentioned at the beginning of the season, no dedicated internet connection will be provided by the HOC. If the NF wants to secure a fast internet access locally, they have to manage their own internet access solution (4g/5G Sim card, Starlink...).

b) Download solution

In case of issues using the TVS cloud solution, a backup option is available at the enquiry desk. Teams, under the supervision of the ICF TVS manager, will be able to plug their own device via a RJ45 wire and download the files needed. Keep in mind that this backup solution is limited.

c. !! NF areas

- Opening hours of the NF area: from 06:30 to 18:00 from 19.09.2025 to 04.09.2025.
- It is forbidden to add additional tents in the NF area.
- NF parking is located on the left of the road, the entrance is just before the Paddle Australia office.

Power distribution

• Please make sure that your electrical equipment is reliable and will not create any shortcuts or overload on the main network during the competition.

Wireless routers

Wireless routers may be used if they are NOT within the following frequency:

- 5785 GHz, band width +/- 20 MHz
- 5825 GHz, band width +/- 20 MHz
- At no time should any wireless router system be connected to the computer which is connected to the TVS LAN cable
- All devices, including any wireless routers, must be named with National Federation code and device number e.g. AUS1, AUS2, AUS3 – unnamed devices will be removed from the system.
- Any team found to be using a device affecting the competition will have power removed to their compete system.

d. Green box studio

The Team Leader of any Athlete required for the green screen studio to shoot an Athlete video clip will be advised directly including with the exact date, time and location.

e. !! Equipment control

- Equipment Control is located on the left bank at the bottom of the course.
- Self-checking is open from: Saturday 27th September from 9:00 to 17:30
- Equipment control will be open each competition day 1h before the 1st boat starts.
- In Canoe and Kayak event and in Kayak Cross Individual: post competition control and random checking will occur.





- Specificity for Kayak Cross Individual: for the last 10 athletes, if the athlete is in the top 3, he/she must exit at the "beach", right after the finish line (river left) to go straight to the Kiss & Cry.
- In Kayak Cross, during elimination phases: pre-competition checking will occur in the Kayak Cross pre start area.

f. **!!** Doping control

- Location: in the room accessed from the breezway to the car park
- Athletes will be notified for Doping Control in the finish area.
- Passports or ID are required for Athletes selected for doping control.

g. **!!** Enquiry desk & TVS – Emergency download solution

- Location: in the tent adjacent to the OVR.
- In case of issues to download TVS feed on the Cloud solution, you can go to the enquiry desk where there is emergency dedicated switches.

h. !! Medal ceremonies

- Location: on the stage in the middle of the island
- Schedule: see competition schedule, after each session of final.
- Athletes involved in the Finals for Canoe Slalom events should bring their national uniform to the medal ceremony preparation area. There will be boxes there to place the uniform in. There is only a short time between the end of the competition and the medal ceremonies.
- For Kayak Cross on Saturday, the medal ceremonies will be done in competition gear.

a. !! Official training schedule

- Canoe slalom & Kayak Cross sessions start on Saturday 20 and go until Sunday 28 September.
- A Kayak Cross training session will be organized each day except Saturday 20 September
- Athletes competing only in Kayak Cross (14 athletes) will be able to access Kayak Cross Training sessions every day (instead of every other day). They will be identified with a specific orange training bib.
- Kayak Cross gates will be set at the bottom on the course at the following times:
 - Sunday during slalom trainings Only KC athletes with orange bibs (14 athletes)
 - Tuesday: 13:30 14:15 (45 min) athletes progressing in Round 1
 - Wednesday: 13:10 13:55 (45 min) athletes progressing in Round 1
 - Thursday: 12:55 13:55 (60 min) athletes progressing in Round 1

 Exact timings, allocations and updates are available on the online <u>official training</u> schedule.

b. !! Competition schedule

- The course is closed following the end of official training Monday 29 September 11:45
 until the end of the competition (except for Kayak Cross training slots on Friday 3rd
 October and Saturday 4th of October).
- The competition schedule version 3 will be posted on the dedicated ICF event Team Info webpage on Sunday 28/09/2025 by 10:00 and spread on the WhatsApp Group.
- Canoe & Kayak events format: Heats Semi (30) Finals (12) for all the events
 - Some breaks have been added within Kayak Cross individual, Heat sessions and Team events
 - During the Canoe and Kayak Finals, start intervals have been reduced (from 3 min to 2 min 30 sec) and the number of breaks has increased (2 breaks of 3'30" sec min per final, after the 4th and the 8th athletes on the final start list)
 - During Kayak Cross breaks have been enlarged and have been added within the Final phase

e. Course approval

i. Generic rules

The ICF wants to remind you that the course designers are:

- Selected from a pool of people skilled enough and proposed by the NF,
- o Are ITOs, which means independent from any NF during the competition.

Any pressure or kind of harassment towards the course designers, as for any ITOs, may lead to sanctions.

ii. **!!** 2025 ICF Slalom World Championships course approval information

National federations feedback about the course designs can be reported to the ICF Technical manager, to be integrated into the Course Approval process.

Feedback will be accepted from only one representant per federation at the following times:

- Heats & Teams course: on Sunday 28/09/2025 from 15:30 15:35 on river left, at the bottom bridge.
- Semi/Final course: on Wednesday 01/10/2025 from 17:02 17:07 on river left, at the bottom bridge.

f. !! Bib distribution

The full list of the bibs per event is available at Appendix 3.

- Training bibs will be available at the Athlete Lounge in the Nation tent area from 09:00 on Friday 19/09/2025 and must be returned (all at once) after last training session on Sunday 28/09/2025.
- A bib deposit of \$100AUD cash only (or equivalent amount in foreign currency) is required on collection of the training bibs and will carry through for the whole competition to be returned on the final day once all the relevant bibs are returned.
- Canoe Kayak (Individual and Teams Events) & Kayak Cross Individual Competition bibs will be available from Sport Information from 13:00 on Sunday 28/09/2025.
- The accreditation fee and ITO fee must be fully paid to receive competition bibs.
- The Kayak Cross Individual bibs (numbered & coloured) will be collected right after each athlete's run in the finish zone area.






- For Kayak Cross Repechage phases the numbered bibs will be distributed form Sport Information on Friday 3 October from 12:00. Coloured bibs will be distributed at the start area and collected at the finish pool (numbered & coloured).
- Kayak Cross coloured bibs will be distributed individually at the start area, then collected at the Kayak Cross finish
- For Kayak Cross Elimination phases the numbered & coloured bibs will be distributed individually at the start area before each run on Saturday 4 October.

Bib return

- CSL Competition bibs don't need to be returned, the HOC is happy to give them to the athletes.
- Athletes doing Kayak Cross only, will also be able to keep a bib. The bib will be available from Sport Information at the end of the Kayak Cross competition on Saturday 4 October- sorry we need to keep using the bibs for the whole of the Kayak Cross competition.
- All training, Teams events and Kayak Cross bibs must be returned; then the deposit will be returned to the team.

g. !! Warm up area

Athletes are allowed to warm up in the area showed on the picture:







8. Canoe & Kayak events


a. !! Pre-start procedure

There will be a display above the entrance to the conveyor belt showing race time.

b. Start

i. Generic rules

- At all times, the athletes must follow the Starter's instruction, or they may be disqualified for the run.
- On the left bank, there will be a countdown clock showing the time to start.
- There will be an acoustic signal (10 seconds before start, and then from 5 seconds before start 4 shorts, 1 long start).
- Athletes may start 5 seconds either side of their official start time which is signified by the long beep on the start clock.



ii. !! Specific rules

- For Canoe & Kayak Individual events, the athlete must start between the start blocks
- For the Team events, to break the beam, the first athlete must start between the start blocks, the second and third athletes should be behind and to the left of the blocks
- The beam line is at the top of the first drop (red line) and is marked by a flag on each bank.
- Athletes should paddle directly to the beam line. They should not turn upstream into the current. Turning upstream means that athletes turn 90 degrees or more relative to the starting blocks.
- Athletes may move to the start position once the previous athlete has broken the beam but must be at the start position 15 seconds before their start.







c. Finish

i. Generic rules

- During the finals, the leading, second and third athletes/teams must proceed to the "Kiss and Cry" area located near the bottom bridge where the leader will be interviewed. If they drop out of the first three positions they will be escorted back to the mixed zone.
- Generally, athletes must not leave the finish zone until dismissed by the Equipment Control Official once they are no longer needed for the ceremonies, anti-doping or equipment control.
- They then proceed via the mixed zone (if in operation) back to the Athlete area.
- Athletes should wear their competition bib in the mixed zone for identification purposes.

ii. **!!** Specific rules

- For Canoe & Kayak events, the finish beam is located under the bottom bridge and is marked by Finish signage on the bridge.
- All athletes must exit via the platform on river left, near the pumps, to pass through equipment control, kiss and cry and mixed zone.
- Each medallist will be able to invite 2 family members at the end of the final to join them on the island for the medal ceremony. The team leader of the medallists must reach the ICF technical managers at the Kiss and Cry to get the passes for the family members.

9. Kayak Cross events

a. Pre-start procedure

i. Generic rules

- Athletes need to be at the pre-start area prior to their start to prepare their boats (and equipment control during the Elimination phase), and receive any final instructions (colored bibs distribution, choosing their start lane).
- Volunteers will be there to help your athlete if needed on the ramp.

ii. !! Specific rules

- In the Repechage and Elimination phase Athletes need to go through equipment control in the pre-start area.
- Access to start ramp is from the left bank.

b. Start procedure

i. Generic rules

- An automatic start machine will be used for all phases.
- At all times, the athletes should follow the starters instructions.
- The start time for Kayak Cross Individual will be triggered by the activation of the start machine.





- At the start, a Pre-Start Official will inform your Athlete if they have progressed
- The start position is with both hands on the paddle and along the side of the kayak. The paddle must be parallel to the plane of the platform and the front blade must be behind the front flap. The front hand has to be placed over middle of the boat on one side and touching the boat or the spraydeck.



- The start orders will be:
 - 1) "In position" => the athletes must place their paddle in the start position
 - 2) "Ready" => the athletes wait in steady position; no movement is allowed following the "Ready" command
 - 3) The platform will tilt to indicate the start. The starter will not say "Go".

ii. !! Specific rules

> Kayak Cross Individual

- Athletes must start from lane 3 on the platform (third lane from the river right).
- The start interval is 60 seconds; athletes should get in their boat directly on the platform.

Repechage & Elimination phases

- Athletes must be settled in the start position on the ramp 90 seconds before their start time.
- They should then listen to the sports presentation where they will be introduced to spectators.

c. Finish

i. Generic rules

- The finish time for Kayak Cross Individual will be triggered by photocell.
- During the Repechage & Elimination phase a photo finish system will be deployed.

ii. !! Specific rules

• The finish line is on the top of the drop at "Jacks" on the second corner of the course.





- During Kayak Cross Individual, athletes must exit at Equipment Control on river left at the bottom of the course.
- During Kayak Cross Repechage & Elimination phase, athletes should return to the start pool by the conveyor and exit at the steps on the side of the start pool, around the back of the ramp to the pre-start area.
- For Finals, the athletes must exit at the beach after "Jacks" on river left to reach the Kiss and Cry and the podium.
- Each medallist will be able to invite 2 family members at the end of the final to join them on the island for the medal ceremony. The team leader of the medallists must reach the ICF technical managers at the Kiss and Cry to get the passes for the family members.

d. Rules reminder

Kayak Roll

To be correctly performed in Kayak Cross competition, a kayak roll must meet the following criteria:

- The roll must be 360 degrees
- At one point when under the roll barrier the boat must be 180 degrees turned

10. HOC topics

a. Bridges

You are reminded that bridges are for access only. The only people who may remain on the bridges are Officials. You may pass over the bridge but not remain on any part.

b. Security

Overnight security will be provided at the stadium from 6pm Friday 19 September until 6am Sunday 5 October.

There is no capacity to store personal belongings in secure areas. Athletes and Teams are encouraged not to bring extra items to the venue. Please remind members of your team not to leave valuable items unsecured.

c. Opening ceremony

• Time: 16:30 – 17:45

At the Stadium directly following the Kayak Cross Individual Medal Ceremonies Athletes, in national team uniform, should prepare and gather along the road from the pumps back through the breezeway by 16:00.

The Olympic Qualification Working Group established by the ICF Board of Directors has finalised the next steps of creating the Canoe Slalom Olympic Qualification System (OQS) for the Olympic Games LA28.

The ICF Sport team and the Canoe Slalom committee will host an online briefing followed by a live information session at the 2025 ICF Slalom World Championships in Penrith.

The online briefing has taken place on September 22nd at 13:00 CET (21:00 Sydney time zone), where the preliminary OQS document has been presented, including all details of the allocation process, the number of quota places, and the timeline.
