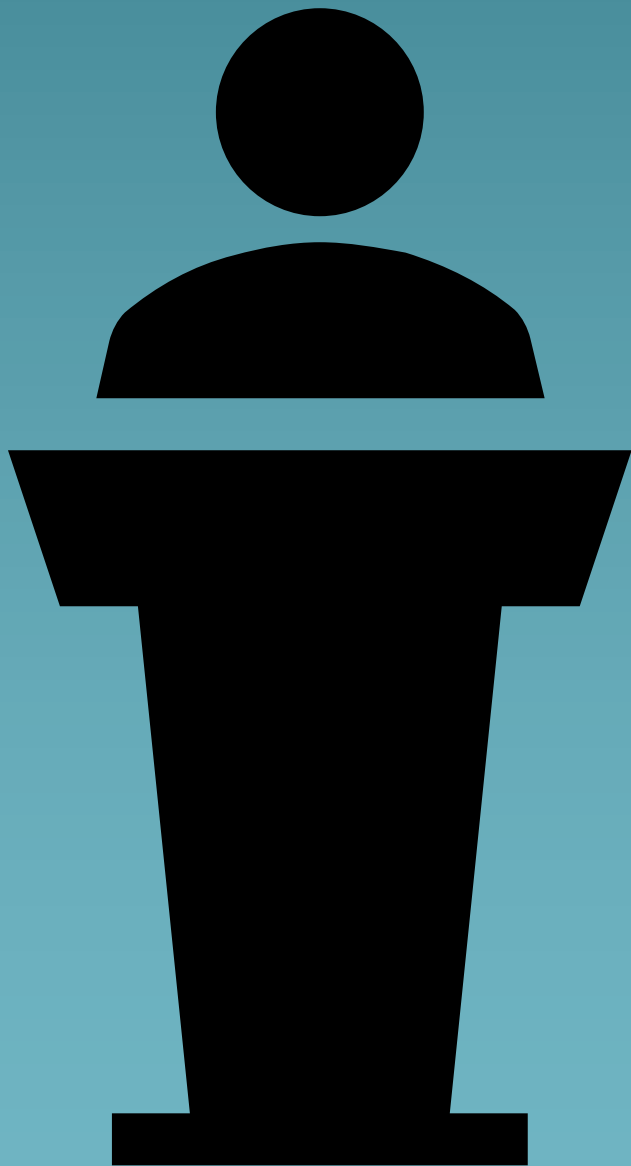

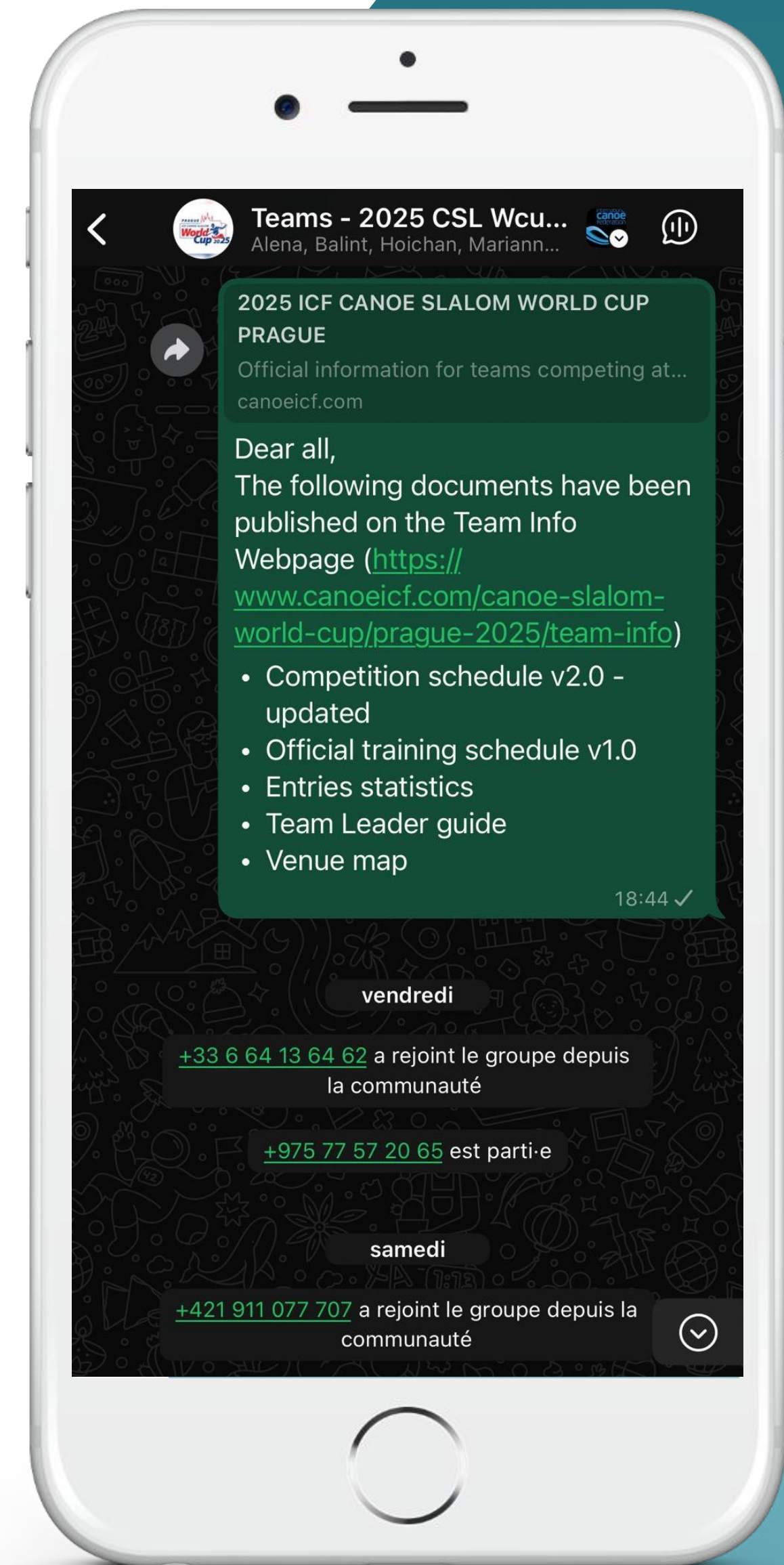

NF areas

- The NF area is in the garden, with the entrance on the right side of the road near the start.
- Extra tents may be installed in the NF area close to the NF tents.
- NF parking is located on the grass area above the Boathouse. Parking is only permitted with a valid parking card, which will be distributed through the Sport Info Office.
- **Free lunches** will be provided for all accredited athletes and team staff on competition days, with accreditation required. **Lunch times** are Friday from 11:00 to 14:00, and Saturday and Sunday from 11:30 to 14:00. Additionally, **snacks** will be available throughout the day in the Athletes' Lounge in the NF area.



Green box studio

- We still miss some athletes. We are opening a slot tomorrow (Thursday 26th) from 10:00 to 13:00, so please ask your athletes to go if they haven't yet.
- **Reminder:**
 - **ALL athletes must shoot a new headshot** (not only for new ones)
 - Athletes must wear their **dry competition gear**.

Equipment control

- **Location**: Equipment Control is located **at the end of the course**. Athletes have to exit via the steps and go through the equipment control area.
- **Self-checking**: Thursday 26th June from 9am to 4pm
- **Timing on competition days**: open 1h before the 1st boat starts.
- **Hiko bouyancy vest**: Athletes with worn labels on the Hiko bouyancy vest can take them to the Hiko Shop at the venue to discuss resolution. As long as the bouyancy vest is in good condition and on the list, athletes won't be penalised for a worn label.
- **Reminder:**
 - **Canoe & Kayak events and Kayak Cross Individual**: post competition control and random checking
 - **Kayak Cross**: pre-competition checking in the pre-start area
 - **Final phases**: the athlete must go **straight to Kiss & Cry**. The boat can be left in the ITO hands in the Equipment Control tent. After the control, boat and equipment will be **stored in a specific boat rack at the back of the area**. Athlete will be able to reach their equipment from the back.

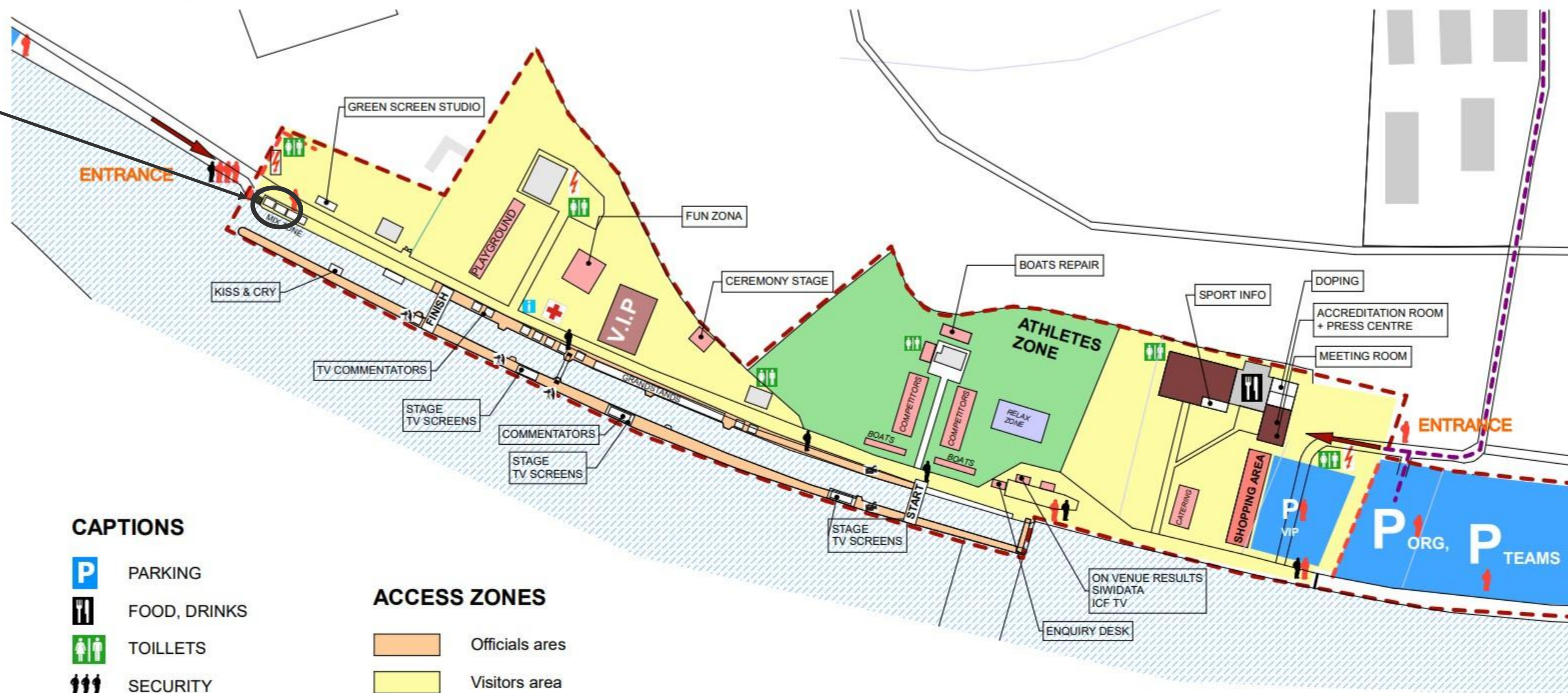

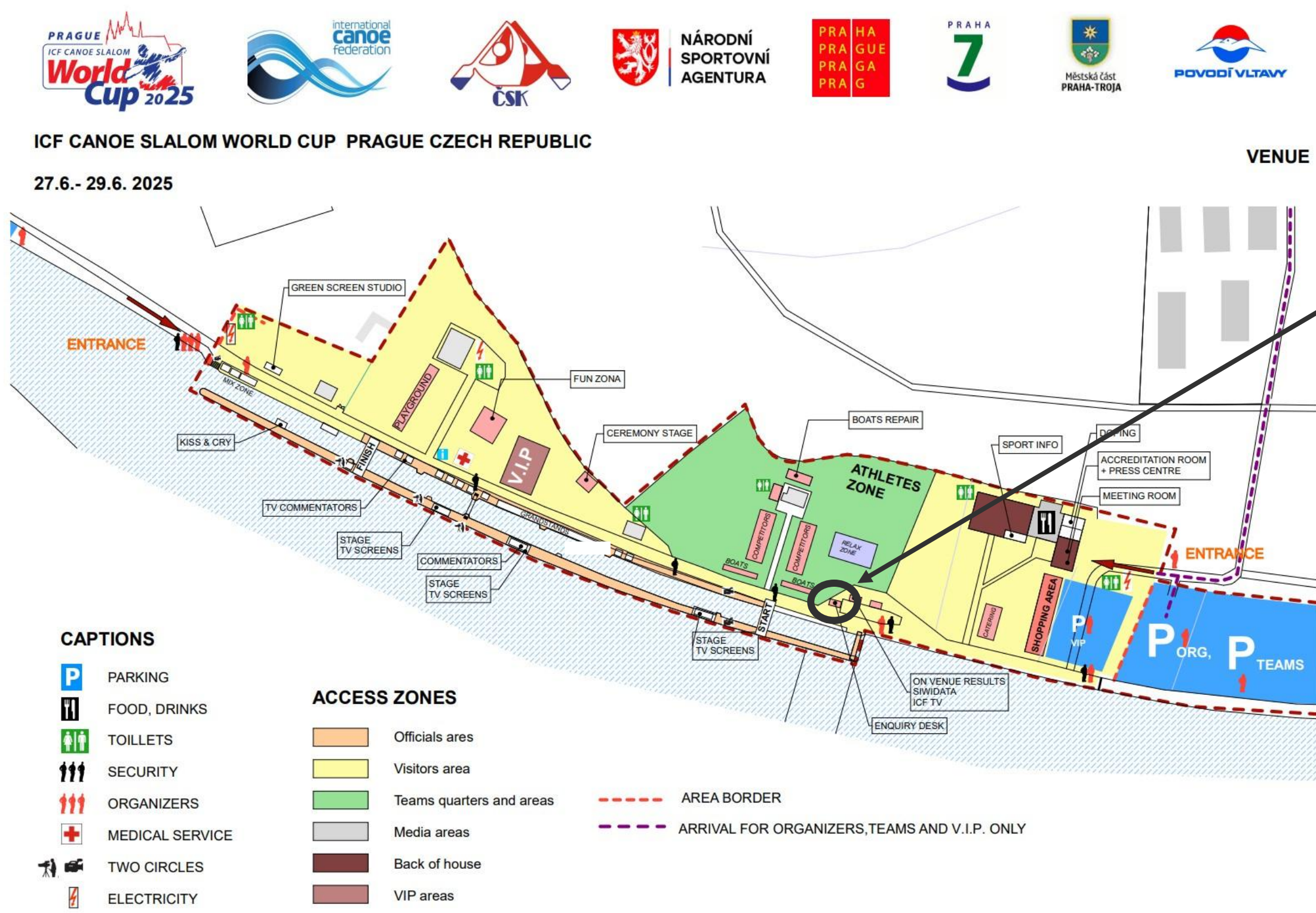
Anti-doping & Doping Control

- Athletes will be notified for doping control in the finish area.
- **Reminder:** passport or ID is required
- Anti-doping reminder: ADEL certificate for athletes and coaches

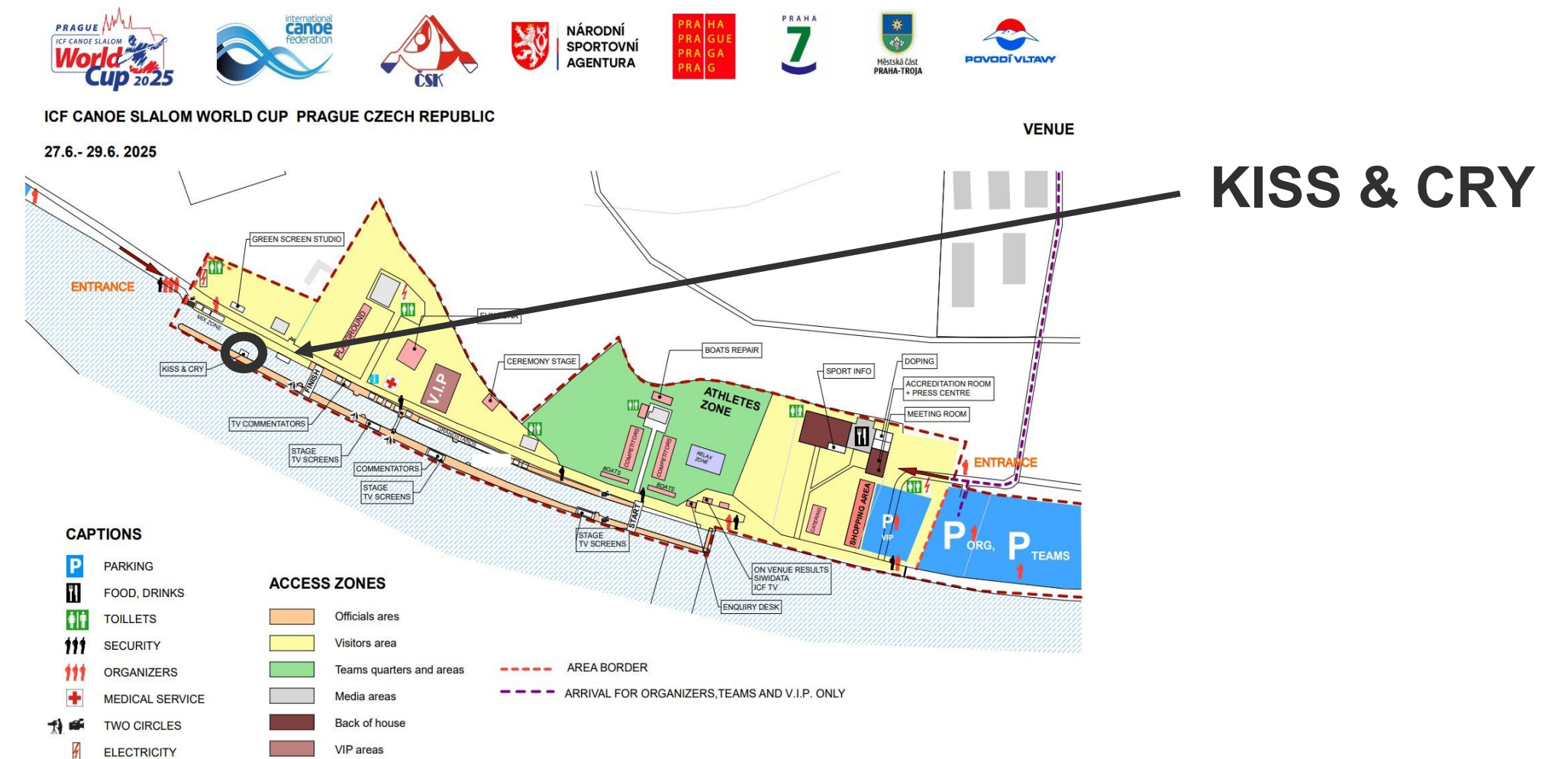
- Location: in front of the OVR

Kiss & Cry

- Location: on the water – at the bottom of the course
- For **Canoe and Kayak Finals**:
 - Provisional **top 3** at the Kiss and Cry
 - With bib and competition gear
- For **Kayak Cross Individual**:
 - Provisional top 3 at the Kiss and Cry only **for the last 10 athletes - it will be on the river right, near the mixed zone**
 - With bib and competition gear (warm clothes accepted)



- **Location**: the grass area at the middle of the course
- **Schedule**: see competition schedule
 - For **canoe, kayak and kayak cross events**: after each session of final
 - For **Kayak Cross Individual**: after the run of the event
- Uniform drop out: **near the Team Leader tent** (only for Canoe & Kayak events), boxes will be available.
- **Kayak Cross & Kayak Cross Individual: in competition gear**

Official training schedule

- Canoe slalom training sessions start **on Monday until Thursday**.
- Kayak Cross training sessions take place on **Tuesday** and on **Thursday**.
- Exact timings and updates are available on the **online official training schedule**.



Competition schedule

- The course is closed following **the end of official training (Thursday 26.06.2025 at 16:30) until the end of the competition.**
- The **competition schedule version 3** will be available on the dedicated **ICF event Team Info webpage** on **Thursday 26th of June by 10am** and spread on the WhatsApp Group.
- Note: Canoe and Kayak Heats and short slalom, **start interval is 60 seconds for all boats.**

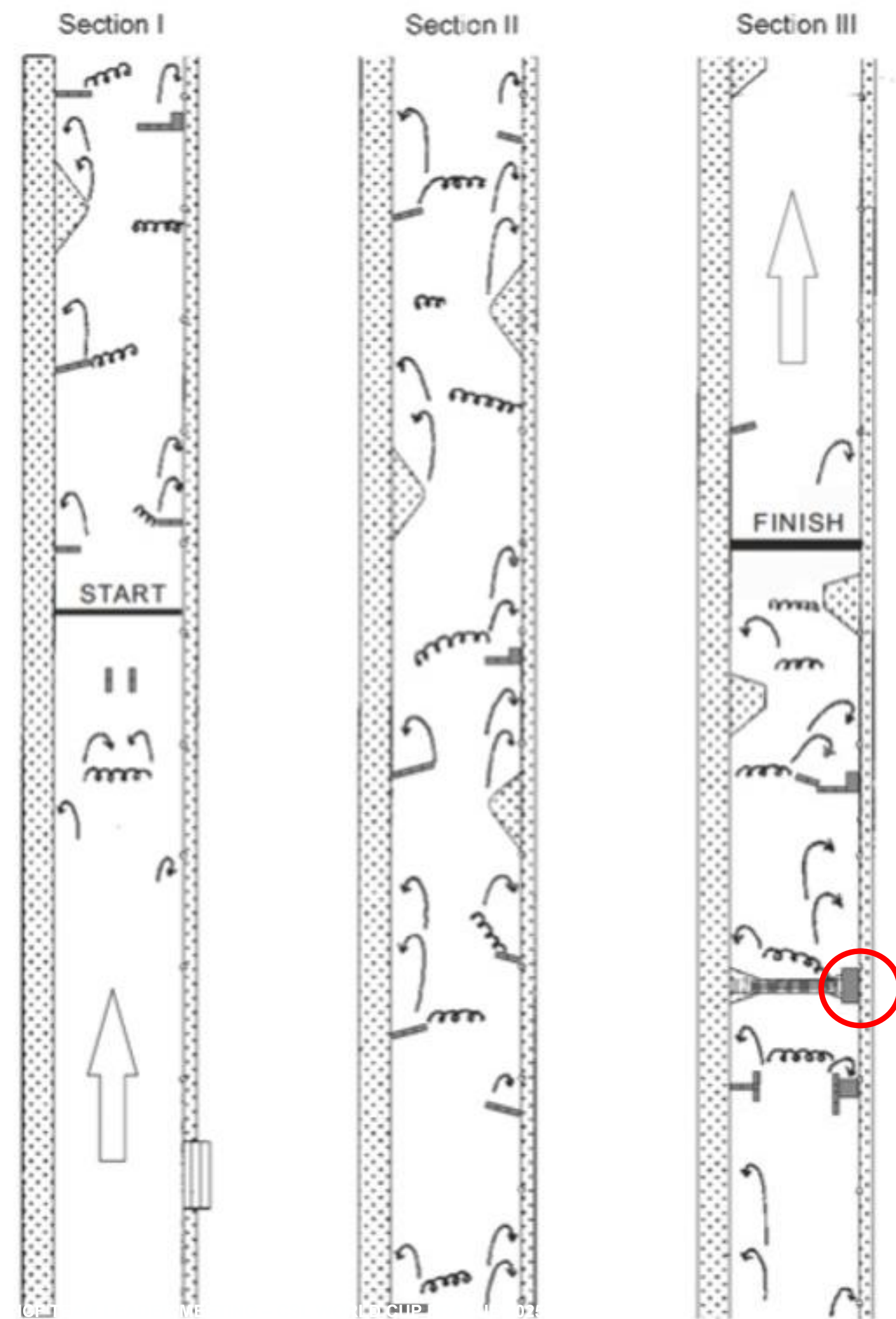

Feedback to be reported to the ICF Technical Manager (Manon BOCQUET):

- **Slalom GP:** on Thursday from 18:25 to 18:30 at the lower bridge (river right)
- **World Cup:** on Friday from 18:10 to 18:15 at the lower bridge (river right)



Bib distribution

CSL competition bibs:

- **Competition bib:** will be same for Friday (Prague Slalom GP) and Saturday (World Cup) and will be available from the **Sport Info Office from 12:00 on Thursday 26th June.**
- **All training bibs need to be given back at the same time after last training,** in exchange of competition bib.
- CSL Competition bibs must be returned to the **Sport Information Office** following the competition.
- Deposit of 50€

Kayak Cross bibs:

- For **Kayak Cross Individual**, bibs will be available from the **Sport Info Office from 12:00 on Thursday 26th June.**
- For **Elimination phases**, the **numbered** and **colored bibs** will be distributed **individually at the start area.**



CANOE & KAYAK EVENTS

Pre-start procedure

There will be a clock, facing into the warm-up area showing race time and the next athletes to start – river right, near the stairs

For Short slalom this clock will only show the race time

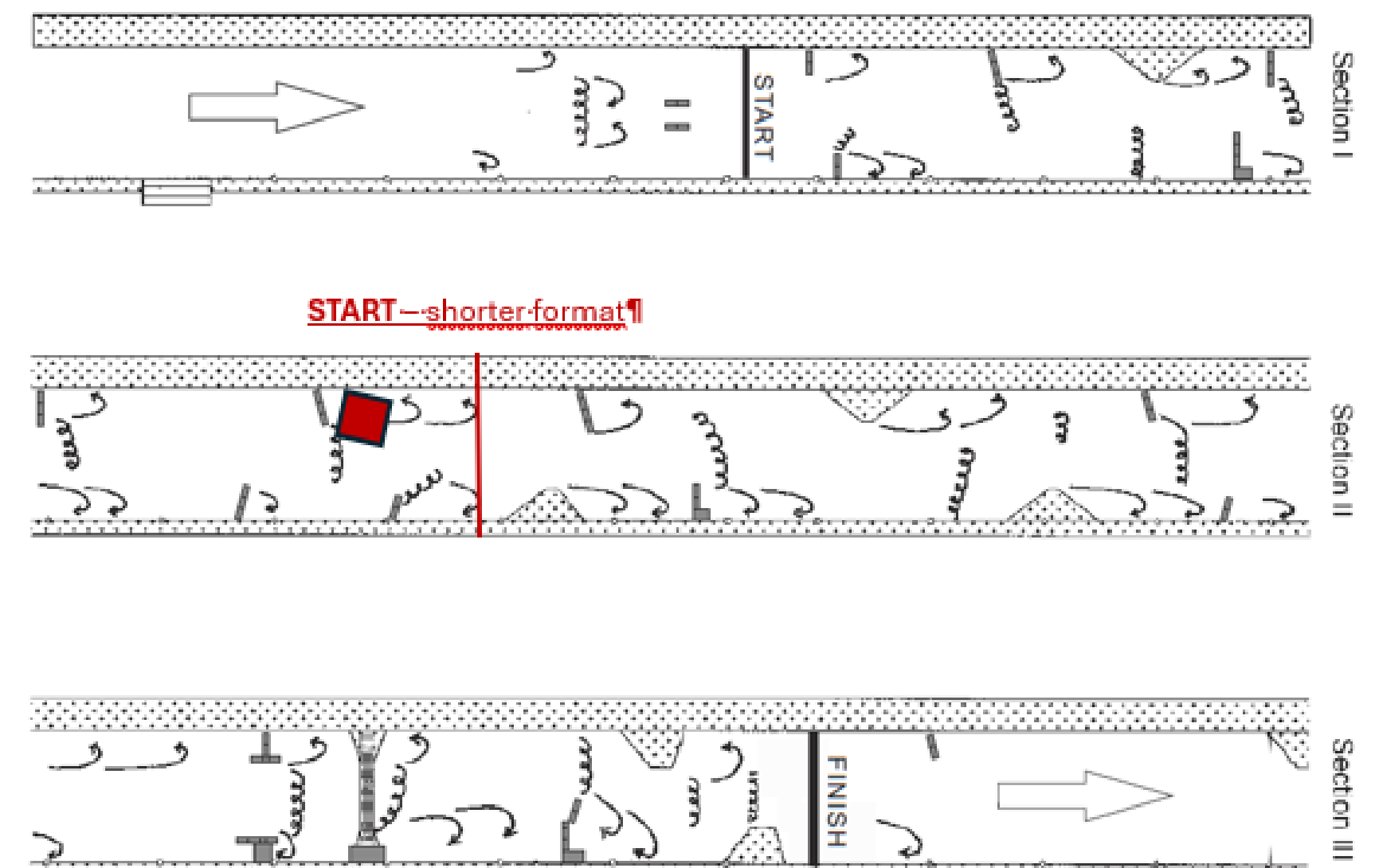


CANOE & KAYAK EVENTS

PRAGUE SLALOM GP

Start procedure

- The start will be located in the big eddy, as shown on the course map. The start position will be downstream, between two rapid blocks placed high in the eddy. Athletes will need to enter from below, entry through the backdrop will not be possible.
- The beam line will be set far enough downstream to avoid being broken as athlete enter.



CANOE & KAYAK EVENTS WORLD CUP

Start procedure

- The start is below the Kayak Cross start ramp between the Rapid blocks.
- The beam line is 5 m below the starting position.



KAYAK CROSS EVENTS

Pre-start procedure

- Access to start ramp will be **from the right bank.**
- Athletes go through pre-start equipment control and pick up their colored bib.



KAYAK CROSS EVENTS

Start procedure

➤ Kayak Cross Individual

- Athletes must start from **lane 2** on the platform for the Individual (second lane from river right). Athletes should get in their boat in lane 2.
- The start interval is **60 seconds**; The start time for Kayak Cross Individual will be triggered automatically **by the start gate**.

➤ Elimination phases

- Athletes should be settled in the start position on the ramp **90 seconds before their start time**.
- They should then listen to the sports presentation where they will be introduced to spectators.

KAYAK CROSS EVENTS

Finish procedure

- The finish beam is located **20 m above the last concrete point**.
- The finish beam is marked by **two yellow finish buoys**.
- All Athletes must exit **via the steps at the end of the course and pass through equipment control and mixed zone**.
- During the finals, the **three first athletes must proceed to the Kiss and Cry area located on the water, river left after the finish line**.
