





Team Leaders are kindly requested to come directly to the Accreditation Centre upon arrival.

If Team arrive later that **20.00PM** should go directly to dedicated hotel, team should come to accreditation next day morning.

Team leaders are required to arrive alone. After paying their dues, team leaders may collect their accreditation cards. A federation will receive accreditations only when all documents are delivered and invoices are paid.

## LATE ENTRY / WITHDRAWAL / CREW CHANGE

In extraordinary circumstances, an application can be submitted to the Chief Official for the acceptance of late events entries and/or withdrawals. It is at the Chief Official's discretion to accept or decline a late entry/withdrawal. Requests for late entry, withdrawal, or crew changes can be made through the following online form: [FORM](#)

Late event entries/withdrawals will incur a fee of 50 euros per boat. Late event entries for already registered athletes will incur a fee of 50 EUR per boat. Late entry fee payments are accepted exclusively by credit card at the competition office. Only requests submitted before the deadline will be considered. After the deadline, please contact the Chief Official directly.

### **DEADLINE TO SUBMIT REQUESTS: 21st May, 11:00.**

1. Any athlete listed in the final entry for their country is eligible to substitute in any other event.
2. Any changes to entries must be communicated through the online form to the Chief Official at least one hour prior to the first race of the morning or afternoon session.
3. Withdrawal of an entry is final and prohibits the same athlete or crew from participating in any other events of the competition.
4. For crew boats, the competitors' names must be listed in the order they will race in the boat. The name at the top must correspond to the competitor positioned at the front of the boat.

# BOAT NUMBERS, BIB, BOAT ID AND EQUIPMENT CONTROL

## BOAT NUMBERS

Boat numbers are free of charge and can be collected before the race at the designated place next to ID control. All rented numbers need to be returned after the race.

## BIB

BIB numbers are not required for the 2025 ICF Canoe Sprint and Paracanoe World Cup and will not be distributed. The ICF number of every athlete will be their BIB number.

## BOAT CONTROL

### DO-IT-YOURSELF BOAT CONTROL

The scales will be available for athletes in a dedicated tent located next to the hangars and information desk in the athlete area, starting from:

### POST-RACE BOAT CONTROL

Is located next to the athletes area. Boat controllers will check boats after all heats, semi-finals, and finals.

At least three (3) boats will be selected from the participants in the races for boat control after the finish. Athletes will be called by boat numbers. Selected boats numbers will be also visible on the screen.

## ID AND EQUIPMENT CONTROL

Athletes can embark **ONLY** from the designated place before the competition where their boats, equipment, clothes (uniforms and uniformity), accreditation cards will be checked.

# ATHLETE NAME AND COUNTRY CODE STICKERS, UNIFORMS and UNIFORMITY

## ATHLETE NAME AND COUNTRY CODE STICKERS

Each athlete's name sticker must be applied on all boats for ICF Canoe Sprint competitions.

In order for canoes and kayaks to be presented in a standard manner, name stickers must be positioned at the same point on every boat.

The country code sticker will be applied on all boats and at the same place for each ICF Canoe Sprint competition and will be checked at the ID and Equipment Control.

It is the participating National Federations' responsibility to provide the stickers to their athletes.

## UNIFORMS and UNIFORMITY

If two (2) boats from the same country compete in the same race, they must wear the same uniforms submitted with Nominal entries. In a crew boat there **MUST BE** uniformity among all athletes including: sleeve length, hats, headbands.

The front athlete in K2 or K4 may compete without a spray deck. Teams shall upload a picture of their uniform before the entry deadline in SDP to the relevant section.

A detailed guideline on the procedure will be sent to the team leaders by ICF.

# AWARDING CEREMONY, DOPING CONTROL

## AWARDING CEREMONY

During the medal ceremonies at the 2025 ICF Canoe Sprint and Paracanoe World Cup, national **anthems will not be performed**.

Instead, the anthem of the International Canoe Federation will be played to accompany the ceremonies.

Athletes should wear their official team uniforms or competition uniforms and footwear must be worn (barefoot is not allowed).

Athletes may not wear hats or headgear and no sunglasses are allowed throughout the Ceremony.



All athletes and the Team Leader of the winning team (wearing their national uniform) are requested to be present at the medal ceremony area no later than 10 minutes before the officially scheduled victory ceremony.

## DOPING CONTROL

Athletes will be randomly selected for doping control conforming to the relevant regulations.

For the ICF World Championships, ICF World Cups and ICF Ranking Races and Continental Championships, every athlete, coach and support personnel must pass the relevant anti-doping online course on the AntiDoping Education Learning platform (ADEL) corresponding to their role **before** the first day of the competition in accordance with 2023 ICF Anti-Doping Rules.

Athletes entered in any ICF competition or continental championships must complete the ICF's anti-doping education programme or equivalent before competing or risk being denied entry to the competition.

Athletes may access the water for warm-up at the competition venue via two pontoons located near the boat racks.

The warm-up area is situated behind the 1000m start line of the regatta course.

It is forbidden to train during competition days parallel to the regatta course.

Parking passes will be available at the accreditation office. All cars must be parked only in the designated parking area.

Teams will receive three parking passes for: one trailer and two accredited vehicles (up to 3,5t). Additional parking passes will be purchased for 30 Euro/car/competition.


## WATER

# 5 000M RACES

The 5000 m events will run with portages. The races will start at the southern end of the course. It will consist of 6 laps (1 long and 5 shorter ones). The turning points are the same in each lap. The distance from the start - southern end of the course - to the first turning point will make the first lap a long lap. The long lap is followed by five shorter laps. There will be 5 portages. There is no portage in the last shorter lap. All athletes need to do all portages.

Disembarkation, portage and embarkation will all be on a low pontoon. It is allowed to use both side of the pontoon. All competitors must disembark in the area defined by flags diagonally divided in red and yellow, carry their craft along the portage and embark in the area defined by flags diagonally divided in red and yellow. Rules are based on canoe sprint rules. Only boats with specifications set out in the Canoe Sprint Competition Rules can be used. Handles are allowed, but pumps are not permitted.
