




Words of welcome – Mayor of Nova Gorica

Competition Rules

 The 2025 ICF Junior and U23 Wildwater Canoeing World Championships in Solkan will be organised in accordance with the ICF Wildwater Canoeing Racing and Competition Rules - 2025 ICF Wildwater Canoeing Rules

An Anti-Doping-Education Certificate (Alpha Certificate) is required no later than Tuesday, 15th of June. Must be sent to HOC – <u>kkse@siol.net</u>

Participation

 The number of participants in each World Championships event is defined according by the ICF rules. <u>Wildwater Canoeing Rules</u>

Participation Fee

The participation fee (accreditation) is 100 EUR per person (competitors, team leaders, and team members). It includes:

- Free training for three days prior to the competition
- Event organization
- Technical video signal
- Team area
- Event t-shirt
- Wireless internet access
- Logistic support for teams
- Other services in accordance with ICF and hosting rules (if applicable)







Championships Venue

The Kayak Centre Solkan previously hosted the ICF Wildwater Canoeing World Championships in 2013, as well as the ECA Junior and U23 Canoe Slalom/Wildwater European Championships in 2008, 2012, and 2016. We can confidently say that all these events were a great success. However, organizing the championships presents an additional challenge for our organizing committee and many others involved in bringing this sporting event to life. Once again, we are preparing to host two professional and exciting championships, complemented by an engaging additional program in a relaxing setting and pleasant natural surroundings. For the upcoming event, the organizer is placing special emphasis on integrating the program with GO!2025 – European Capital of Culture, as well as the ICF development program. The novelty and innovation of this event will be that, for the first time, two championships (kayaking and rafting) will be held together.









As this is one of the most important competitions under the auspices of the International Canoe Federation, we expect the participation of the best young wildwater competitors from around the world.

The local canoeing club built a new kayak center in 2005 with the help of the city and the government. A modern sports center has been developed on the site of a former sawmill and paper mill, with additional support from European funds.

The kayak center features a partially artificial channel within the natural riverbed, which is suitable for training at different water levels. The 300-meter-long track and the modern facility adjacent to it allow for the organization of any competition or training session, catering to both beginners and top-level paddlers.

The course on the Soča River is made of stone and spans 450 meters in length, with a 2.7-meter drop. The water flow is controlled by hydropower plants with ample water coverage. The power plant is located 750 meters upstream. The course has arranged water access, trails for paddlers, and stands for spectators.

In just a few years since its establishment, the kayak center has become well-known for hosting popular and engaging events both during the day and in the evening, when floodlights illuminate the course, making the venue even more attractive to the audience.







Nova Gorica & Solkan

Goriška is a region divided between Slovenia and Italy. It stretches from the sea to the high peaks of the Alps. Its proximity to the Adriatic Sea and the Alpine peaks gives it a mild climate throughout the year, making it one of the most pleasant places to live. Slovenian Goriška is a region with 119,000 inhabitants, located in the westernmost part of Slovenia. After the Second World War, Nova Gorica (with 36,000 residents) became an important center for universities, science, culture, commerce, and sports. Nova Gorica, also known as the "City of Roses," boasts a variety of hotels of all categories, as well as small guesthouses and apartments, which are renowned for their excellent cuisine and superb wine.

The main artery of Goriška is the Soča River, which originates in the heart of the Julian Alps. Over its almost 138 km length to the sea, the Soča River is a paradise for paddlers and other water sports enthusiasts.



Solkan is a place known for its carpentry and canoeing. Kayakers became active here, especially before and shortly after the Second World War, when they formally organized themselves into a club that still exists today. Canoe racing feels at home here. Names such as Prijon, Bone, Špacal, Jug, Pellegrini, Poberaj, Abramič, Štrukelj, and others have carried the good name of Solkan kayakers around the world, earning many world champion titles and other successes. Through their knowledge and enthusiasm, they have played a key role in developing the canoeing sport as we know it today.

How to get here:

Location

Solkan is located in the lower part of the Soča river, near the town of Gorica/Gorizia. Highways, railways and international airports are situated nearby, within a 30/120 km radius. The Canoe center Solkan, which serves as the main venue place in Solkan, is located 2 km from the City centre of Nova Gorica.

Transport

Teams are responsible for their own transport of participants and equipment. The organiser offers logistical support to all the teams upon request. Upon request, the organiser can also arrange the transportation of equipment and accreditated participants.

Location of Airports, Rail Network and Roads to the Venue/Town

Nova Gorica has a railway station connected to Ljubljana, Triest and Venice as well. The nearest airports are:

Ronchi – Trieste Airport: 30km Ljubljana Airport: 100 km Venice Treviso Airport: 110 km

Venice Marco Polo Airport: 120 km

Arriving by Car

Most drivers enter Slovenia via the motorway. To drive on Slovenian motorways, you must have a vignette, or you risk heavy fines.

Athletes' Area at the Venue

A section of the public viewing place will be made available exclusively for the competitors. A separate area will be provided for all teams. Teams can also apply for limited space to set up their own area (e.g., tents). The area will be assigned by the organiser.



Boat Hire: Available Quantity and Rental Fees (if required)

There are limited boats available for hire; however they will not be top competition models. For further information contact the HOC by listing the number of boat sought per federation – kkse@siol.net

Transport of Athletes and Officials during the Competition

The transportation of competitors from the place of accommodation to the competition venue is the responsibility of the respective teams. The Organizing Committee will organize the transport for race officials based on individual needs.





Access to Transportation for Leisure

Solkan is a suburb of Nova Gorica. The city transport bus stop is approximately 350 metres away from the venue place itself. The proximity of the city to the Solkan venue guarantees a number of visitors who will arrive by bicycle or on foot.

Medical Support

Location of Local Hospitals

The Clinical Hospital, with 24-hour medical services, is 6 kilometres away. An ambulance crew and doctor will be on standby at the venue daily during the competition days. Upon request, sports massages and therapies are available at the event venue for the duration of training sessions and competitions. Sport massage and therapy services are at your own cost and are not covered by the organizer.

First Aid

A van with aid supplies will be stationed in the competition area.

Water Safety

Rescue services in the competition area will be organized during the competition days.

Medical Insurance

The Organising Committee kindly asks all participants to ensure medical they have insurance coverage. The Organising Committee will not cover any expenses related to hospital or dental treatment.

Security at the Venue

All competitors and officials will have accreditation passes granting access to their designated areas. General security will be provided.

The organizer will not accept any responsability for missing equipment or other goods.







Internet Access

Available in most areas of the Kayak Centre Solkan.

Access Pass and Parking

Parking places will be organised. As the venue has limited space, a detailed mobility plan will be prepared (one month before the event start date).

Since two championships (kayaking and rafting) will take place simultaneously, the space for teams, veichles, and equipment at the event venue will be limited. The organizer will do everything in their power to ensure that both championships are conducted in accordance with the standards set by ICF for Junior World Championships.

Nova Gorica and Gorizia share the same commitment: being the European Capital of Borderless Culture.


















