# BRANDENBURG AN DER HAVEL: WHERE HISTORY MEETS THE WATER

Brandenburg an der Havel is a city that seamlessly weaves centuries of history with a passionate dedication to water sports, making it a truly unique destination in Germany's state of Brandenburg. Nestled amidst a sprawling network of interconnected lakes and rivers, the city offers a rich blend of cultural heritage and active, nature-based tourism.

## A TREASURE TROVE OF HISTORY AND ARCHITECTURE

For the visitor, Brandenburg an der Havel is a living history book. As the original namesake of the Mark Brandenburg and the federal state itself, the city boasts stunning medieval architecture. Its three historic city centers—Old Town, New Town, and the Cathedral District (Dominsel)—present a fascinating journey through time. Must-see attractions include:

- The magnificent St. Peter and Paul Cathedral (Dom St. Peter und Paul), one of the most significant Romanesque churches in the region.
- The impressive St. Catherine's Church (St. Katharinenkirche), a masterpiece of brick Gothic architecture.
- The well-preserved historic city walls and gates, such as the Plauer Torturm.
- The city's historic core, surrounded by water, creates an atmosphere of peaceful, accessible beauty, often referred to as the „Venice of the Mark.“

## A GLOBAL CAPITAL FOR WATER SPORTS

Brandenburg an der Havel's true modern identity is defined by its strong connection to competitive water sports. The Beetzsee Lake is not just scenic; it is home to one of Europe's finest natural regatta courses. This world-class venue is consistently chosen for major international events, affirming the city's sporting prestige:

**Canoe and Kayak Sprint:** The Beetzsee regularly hosts prestigious competitions, including the highly anticipated ICF World Cups (such as the one scheduled for 2026). The natural setting provides optimal, fair racing conditions praised by athletes globally.

**Paracanoe:** The city is a dedicated proponent of inclusive sports, frequently hosting Paracanoe events that showcase incredible athletic dedication.

**Rowing:** Beyond canoeing, the course is a frequent location for national and international rowing championships, making it a hub for water endurance sports.

The city's infrastructure, combined with its welcoming atmosphere, makes it a top destination for athletes seeking high-quality training camps and competition venues. For tourists, the sporting events provide a dynamic backdrop to their cultural explorations.

Brandenburg an der Havel successfully combines its role as a quiet, historic sanctuary with that of an energetic, world-class sporting arena, ensuring an attractive experience for every kind of visitor.





# THE BEETZSEE REGATTA COURSE: WHERE CENTURIES MEET THE FINISH LINE

The natural regatta course on the Beetzsee lake in Brandenburg an der Havel stands as a unique testament to the successful marriage of deep European history and modern athletic excellence. It is more than just a body of water; it is a globally recognized venue where the pursuit of Olympic gold takes place against a backdrop dating back to the Middle Ages.

## HISTORIC SETTING, MODERN PERFORMANCE

The course's distinct identity stems from its immediate surroundings. Just a short distance from the Beetzsee lies the city of Brandenburg an der Havel, the original namesake of the region. Athletes and visitors compete and train in the shadow of the venerable Dominsel (Cathedral Island), home to the magnificent 12th-century cathedral, and the preserved brick Gothic architecture of the old city districts. This provides an almost paradoxical atmosphere: competitors are striving for milliseconds with cutting-edge technology, yet they are fully immersed in a scene that has changed little in its historical grandeur.

## STATE-OF-THE-ART NATURAL VENUE

In contrast to its historic neighbours, the Beetzsee course itself represents the pinnacle of modern athletic requirements. It is celebrated across the international canoeing and rowing communities for being one of the best natural regatta courses in the world.

- Fairness and Stability: The lake's protected position ensures optimal, non-turbulent water conditions, guaranteeing exceptional fairness for all competitors across its 2000-meter length.

- Modern Infrastructure: Despite its „natural“ label, the venue boasts contemporary infrastructure, including modern finish line towers, integrated timing systems, and dedicated boat storage facilities necessary to host top-tier events like the ICF World Cups and European Championships.
- Sustainable Sport: The natural environment reinforces a commitment to sustainable, outdoor sport—a modern trend that perfectly aligns with the historic value placed on the surrounding landscape.

In essence, the Beetzsee Regatta Course provides a powerful synthesis: the enduring legacy of Brandenburg's past grounds the dynamic, high-speed reality of today's competitive sports, making every race a journey through time and a glimpse into the future of paddlesports.



# TRAVEL INFORMATION: REACHING BRANDENBURG AN DER HAVEL

Brandenburg an der Havel is easily accessible for international guests, benefiting from its proximity to Germany's capital, Berlin, and excellent connectivity via air and rail. Here is a guide on the best ways to reach the city:

## → 1. BY AIR: INTERNATIONAL AIRPORTS

The most convenient entry point for international travellers is Berlin Brandenburg Airport (BER).

- **Airport Code:** BER (Willy Brandt Airport)
- **Distance to Brandenburg an der Havel:** Approximately 100 km (62 miles).
- **Connectivity:** BER is a major hub serving numerous airlines and international destinations worldwide.

## FROM BER AIRPORT TO BRANDENBURG AN DER HAVEL (BY RAIL)

The quickest and most efficient way to travel from the airport is by regional or intercity train:

- **Regional Express (RE) Trains:** The RE 1 line is the key connection. This train runs frequently (usually every hour) directly from the BER Airport terminal station (via Berlin Hauptbahnhof) to Brandenburg Hauptbahnhof (Main Station).
- **Journey Time:** The total travel time from BER to Brandenburg Hauptbahnhof is typically between 1 hour 20 minutes and 1 hour 45 minutes, depending on the specific connection.
- **Tickets:** Tickets can be purchased directly at the airport train station machines. Look for connections that cover the Berlin ABC zone and beyond (VBB fare zone).

## → 2. BY RAIL: VIA INTERCITY (IC/ICE)

For guests arriving from other major German or European cities, the Intercity (IC) network provides direct access:

- **Main Line Connection:** Brandenburg Hauptbahnhof is a stop on major East-West rail lines, making it easily reachable from cities like Hannover, Cologne, or Amsterdam.
- **Berlin Central Station (Hauptbahnhof):** Even if a direct connection is not available, travelers can always transfer at the centrally located Berlin Hauptbahnhof and take the frequently running RE 1 train directly to Brandenburg an der Havel.

## → 3. BY ROAD (CAR & SHUTTLE)

While train travel is recommended, driving is also an option:

- **Autobahn:** The city is located close to the A2 Autobahn (Berlin-Ruhr Area), with the designated exit being Brandenburg/Lehnin.
- **Rental Cars:** Car rental services are available at BER Airport and major train stations in Berlin.
- **Parking:** Visitors should check with their accommodation regarding local parking availability and fees.

## LOCAL TRANSPORT WITHIN BRANDENBURG AN DER HAVEL

Once you arrive at Brandenburg Hauptbahnhof:

- **Trams and Buses:** The main station offers excellent connections via local trams and buses (operated by the VBB/BVB) to all parts of the city, including the historic centre and the Beetzsee Regatta Course.
- **Accessibility:** The city centre is compact and easily explored on foot or by bicycle, especially for visiting the main historical sites.

# 2026 ICF PARACANOE WORLD CUP INTELLECTUAL IMPAIRMENT RACES, DEADLINE & PARTICIPATION FEE

The 2026 Canoe Sprint World Cup is committed to showcasing visible and dignified inclusion by integrating inclusive canoe competitions into the existing World Cup format. This initiative aims to send a strong message of equality, offering athletes with intellectual impairments an international platform within the regular World Cup schedule.

By incorporating ICF II classification races as fixed component of the competition and Special Olympics categories as demonstration events, the World Cup ensures equal recognition and opportunity for all participants. These competitions not only highlight inclusive sport formats but also fosters shared sporting experiences with races and medal ceremonies taking place within the official World Cup program. This approach creates to a stage.

Details regarding registration will be provided in the 2nd bulletin. In both competition categories, the following races will be held:

## ANTI-DOPING CONTROL

Doping control will be conducted in accordance with ICF standards.

## DEADLINES, ENTRIES & REGISTRATION

All team entries (numerical and nominal) must be submitted online through SDP system from ICF. The deadline for numerical entries is 30.03.2026 and for nominal entries is 04.05.2026

## PARTICIPATION FEE

Each participant is charged a participation fee of EUR 30 per day, which includes the following services:

- Accreditation
- Medical Care at the Course
- Security Service at the Course
- Organization Fee
- Drinking Water during training and competition days
- Transport between hotel and course included
- Access to the competition venues for the purpose of training and other activities.
- Boat storage
- Free Wi-Fi at the competition venues
- Per team parking for one trailer, one accredited vehicle, or one container for boats, paddles, and team equipment
- The entry fee is calculated from the day the sports team arrives until the team departs. Days of travelling are one day.



## ACCOMMODATION: BOOKINGS, CAMPING & CATERING

The teams will be accommodated in hotels in Brandenburg an der Havel and Potsdam. There is a camping site directly available at the regatta venue. When submitting your entries, you can select your preferred type of accommodation.

Breakfast is available in all types of accommodations. If teams stay overnight at the camping site, breakfast will be served on the regatta course. Lunch will be available for all teams on the regatta course. Please note that dinner options depend on the individual hotel selected.

A shuttle bus service between the regatta course and the official hotels will be available between 10.05.2026 and 17.05.2026.

The Organizing Committee is not responsible for any additional service provided by the hotel, such as minibar, telephone, parking, etc. These costs must be paid directly to the hotel. If your team causes any damage to the rooms or elsewhere at the hotel, payment must be made on-site, or the Organizing Committee will issue an invoice for the cost of the damage.

Check-in time is 14:00. The rooms are to be vacated before 11:00 a.m. on the day of departure. (Upon request, the hotels will provide storage space at an extra charge).

## PAYMENT TERMS

50% due at the time of booking.

The remaining balance is due by 31 March 2026.

## TERMS OF PAYMENT

50% of the total fees mentioned above must be paid to the Organizing Committee by 31 March 2026, with the remaining 50% due by 30 April 2026.

All bank transfer fees must be covered by the sender. Please ensure that the full payment for your entire team's stay is made. You are kindly requested to print the bank remittance and bring it with you when checking in. Your reservation will be confirmed once we receive the advance payment.

## PARKING

Teams will receive one parking pass for one trailer and one accredited vehicle (up to 3.5t).

The pass is valid for vehicles up to the size of a 9-seater minibus, parked near the Athletes Area. Additional parking passes are available for 50 EUR / car / competition.

Water will be available from dispensers. Please ensure that competitors bring their own water bottles.

## VISA INFORMATION
