


OUR EXPERTISE AND LONG-TERM STRATEGY ON WHITE WATER, FLAT WATER AND SEA

The 2027 ICF World Championships fit perfectly with our federation's strategy to further develop our sport for the years to come: Perform, Celebrate, Consolidate the Paris 2024 legacy.

- The Olympic and Paralympic Games to motivate and strengthen the **PERFORMANCE** of our athletes, managers, and of the disciplines themselves. Not to mention that our facility at Vaires-sur-Marne will be assessed at the highest level.
- A unique CELEBRATION, a true festival to welcome the world of canoe and kayak, federate all practitioners, and to
 attract new ones. This work has already begun and La Tribu a supporters club organized since 2000 and currently
 boasting more than 10,000 members.
- The Games as a driver to **CONSOLIDATE** the development of our federation: its members, structures, territories, practice sites, disciplines, paddlers, and all paddle sports.

It is with this mindset that our strategy has been set up until 2028 to root the canoe culture locally, and to let the world benefit from the marvelous assets of the Vaires-sur-Marne site, before, during and after the Games of 24. The 2027 Championships fit perfectly with our long-term strategy to host more national and ICF events in our sport, as you can see on the timeline below:



This bid is part of a broader perspective of hosting international competitions in the next few years also in the rest of the national territory, not only on white water, but also on flat water and sea.

The competition will take place at the Olympic and Paralympic nautical stadium in Paris / Vaires-Sur-Marne.


It is both an Olympic venue to the highest standards and the perfect venue for everyone wanting to discover our sport.


- An international training center to support the highest performing athletes

- A new hotel will be built in 2025, 2 minutes away from the competition site.
- A dynamic wave with direct access will be used for practice at 10 min.
- Some eco-lodges will be set up in the next few years in the vicinity.







AN HISTORICAL FIRST

We wish to see slalom and freestyle together in 2027, and we see many reasons why it will be a great success. Here are the main ones:

- First, in terms of sustainability and cost-optimization, we would invest more on the event and have synergy gains, reducing organizing costs by 35%.
- We would like to combine a "traditional" and Olympic discipline with a fresher discipline.
- The Championships will be close to urban cultures and have more media coverage.
- We believe kayak cross can be a link between the two disciplines. There is a desire to anchor freestyle on this site.
- We have the ambition to one day host a common white water/calm water competition. Also, there is a strong will to promote a Whitewater Festival on this site, which will have hosted the Olympic and Paralympic Games in 2024.











