 Founded in 1880, the American Canoe Association (ACA) is a nonprofit organization serving the broader paddling public by providing **EDUCATION** related to all aspects of paddling; STEWARDSHIP support to help protect paddling environments; and sanctioning of programs and events to promote paddlesport COMPETITION, **EXPLORATION** and **RECREATION**.

ACA Instructor Certification Program

- Established 1972
 - 8,500 certified Instructors 250 certified Instructor Trainers
 - Canoe (Touring, FreeStyle, River)
 - Kayak (River, Coastal, Surf, Sit-on-Top, Prone, Surfski)
 - Raft
 - Safety & Rescue
 - Adaptive Paddling
 - Stand Up Paddleboarding (SUP)
 - (Flatwater, Whitewater, Surf, Coastal, Yoga)
- Estimated 809,000 students taught annually

- Mechanics of Adaptive Outfitting for Paddlesports




Adaptive Paddling Workshops

- Instruct the novice paddler in ACA Level 1 skills


