Parking passes will also be handed over to the Team Leader upon accreditation together with the initial information package.

Each team will receive one parking pass, irrespective to the number of people on the team, which is valid for the parking lot in the Regatta Course Area where you are allowed to park with a maximum 9-seated minibus.

Before leaving the Accreditation Centre, all Team Leaders will be asked to confirm and sign the Final Travel Info Form of their team with the official departure date and time as well as the National Anthem and National Flag Declaration Form.

All Team Leaders should leave their email address and cellphone number, so they can be reached anytime during the competition in case of an urgent matter and unforeseen circumstances.

National Team Uniform

Every competitor must compete in their team uniform.

A photo of your National Team uniform must be provided in advance of the competition.

Boat Numbers

The Boat Numbers can be collected directly before the race at the designated place for Identity and Polyox (ID/Polyox) Control at the Race Embarkation pontoon in the Athletes' Area. All Boat Numbers must be returned immediately after the race at the Race Disembarkation pontoon.

If there is a personal number missing, you can go to the Information Centre in the Finish Tower on the Ground Floor.

Boat Storage

Boat racks are provided either in the Boathouse or at the tents in the Athletes' Area. You are requested to take your trailers to the designated Trailer Parking Area.

Boat Stickers

The Athlete's Name Sticker must be applied on all boats for the ICF Canoe Sprint races. In order to be presented in a standard manner, the Name Stickers for the canoe and kayak boats must be positioned at the same point on every boat. The Country Code Sticker will be applied on all boats and at the same place for each ICF Canoe Sprint competition. The stickers will be checked at the Boat Control. It is the Participating National Federation responsibility to provide the stickers to their athlete.

Rent A Bike

It is absolutely forbidden to use motor boats during the official training sessions and competition days. However, coaches are permitted to follow the competitors by bikes on the service path along the Regatta Course.

The service on rent of bicycles for coaches will be operated. Rental bikes will be available on site to be booked through the Host Organising Committee for 25 USD a day.

Drinking Bottled Water

Drinking bottled water will be offered to all accredited participants and is available for free during the Access Period to Regatta Course and competition days between August 20th and 25th, 2024.

Medical Services

The Medical Centre will be operating at the Regatta Course with ambulance, first aid and doctor on duty.

The following Medical Services are available for all official participants of the World Championships: doctor on duty, the ambulance, hospital and clinic assistance are near to the Competition Venue.

The Opening Ceremony to be the official opening part of the 2024 ICF Canoe Sprint World Championships Samarkand.

It will showcase the ICF Canoe Sprint major event of the year 2024 as well as the ICF governance and leaderships, athletes, coaches, technical officials and the region of Uzbekistan in a positive way.

The Opening Ceremony consists of two (2) parts, a formal segment and an entertainment section. The Opening Ceremony starts with the Athletes' Parade.

The Host Nation then presents artistic displays of music, singing, dance, and theatre representative of its culture.



The National Anthem of Uzbekistan will be played after the President of the Organising National Federation speech whilst the National Flag of Uzbekistan is raised.
The ICF Anthem will be played after the opening of the 2024 ICF Canoe Sprint World Championships Samarkand whilst the ICF flag is raised.

VIP Services

The VIP's Lounge operating during competition days is located on the Ground Floor in the Finish Tower. There is the VIP's Tent right in front of the VIP's Lounge as well.

Boat Control

THREE TYPES OF BOAT CONTROL

1) There is NO Pre-Competition Boat Control (1st Boat Control).

Before the competition Each Participating Federation has to control all their boats which will Before the first day of the competition each Participating National Federation can control their boats which will be used during the ICF Canoe Sprint World Championships races (Do-It-Yourself Control) to satisfy themselves that their boats conform to the rules.

The athletes are responsible to ensure the boats conform to the technical requirements for the competition as per the ICF Canoe Sprint Competition Rules 2023 Chapter 3.

Any attachments consisting of water absorbing material must be absolutely dry or they will be removed for the weighing.

Additional weight, if any, must be fixed to the hull of the boat.

2) Identity and Polyox Control (ID/Polyox Control).

Before proceeding to the start of a race all crews/boats must pass through Identity and Polyox Control.

Athlete's name and their country code must be placed on each side of the boat under the cockpit.

Boat Stickers can be ordered through the Host Organising Committee for 10 USD a piece.

Athletes can embark only from the designated place before the race where the Technical Officials will check all competitors ID, personal number, boat number, uniform and crew uniformity.

They will also check for any performance enhancing foreign substance on the boat and any forbidden devices.

2.1) Uniform and uniformity

The athletes must wear an appropriate official clothing with easy identification of the nation they represent. Every athlete must compete in the team uniform mentioned in the nominal entries or at accreditation at the latest.

In a crew boat there must be uniformity among all athletes including clothing sleeve length, hats, headbands, and spray deck covers.

In crew boats the names of the competitors must be in order that they race in the boat. The first name at the top must be the competitor at the front of the boat.

3) Post-Race Boat Control (2nd Boat Control).

Post-Race Boat Control will be directly after all the races.

At least three (3) boats will be selected at random from the participants in the races for boat control after the finish.

Do-It-Yourself Boat Control

CHECKLIST FOR DO-IT-YOURSELF BOAT CONTROL

This instruction is created to assist athletes, coaches and team leaders to avoid disqualifications in Boat Control of international events according to the ICF Canoe Sprint Competition Rules 2023. Please contact to Chief Official of Competition Event or ICF Canoe Sprint Committee if you need more information or you have ideas to make this instruction better.

A. IS A SCALE READY?

- #1 Check Does the scale show "0.00" before weighting?
- #2 Calibration If display shows something else press [-0-]-button before weighting. Be careful that nobody touches the scale at the same time.

B. IS A BOAT READY?

- #3 Dry Boat Is your boat totally dry and clean from foreign substances? If not, please clean and dry your boat carefully before weighting.
- #4 Empty Boat Have all loosely fixed things removed from a boat? If not, please remove everything which is not permanently fixed before weighting.
- #5 Extra Weights Have you fixed your extra weights into a boat structure? If not, please fix it because volunteers might drop it easily in Boat Control #2 after your race. Officials are working according #4.
- #6 Lane Number Have you removed your lane number plate? If not, please remove your lane number.
- #7 Correct Parts Do you have exactly correct seat and footrest or floorboard and kneerest block(s) inside a boat?
- #8 Devices Have you removed your wrist watch, GPS, heart rate monitor and other real-time feedback devices from your boat? If not, please remove your equipment from the boat.

C. IS A BOAT CONTROL TENT / AREA READY?

- #9 Wind Is there a perfect wind protection around the scale (a tent with 3 walls)?
- #10 Extra weights Do you have extra weights available to have marginal enough?
- #11 Marginal Do you know the deviation of the scale to estimate a proper marginal for extra weight needed? (For K1/C1: 50-100g, K2/C2: 100g, K4/C4: 100g)

D. WEIGHTING OF BOAT

- #12 Position Please put your boat onto the scale carefully to the position that bow, stern or rudder and do not touch anywhere.
- #13 Extra weights Mark all the fixed extra-weights so that you will immediately see if anyone has changed them.
- #14 Modifications DO NOT CHANGE ANYTHING AFTER WEIGHTING!
- #15 Always check Check your boat on scale before each race; Ask assistance from Boat Control Officials or ask your Team Leader to contact Chief Official if you don't understand this process of Boat Control

Start Area

Athletes must be on the water at the Start Area, not less than three (3) minutes prior to the specified start time of their race. The Start Area is defined as the area of water surface within 100 metres of the Start Line.

Only athletes for the next race start will be allowed to enter the indicated Start Areas of 200-300m, 500-600m, and 1000-1100m. They will be called to the Start Area by Starter three (3) minutes before the start. Once the boats enter the Start Area they are forbidden to turn around and they need to paddle a straight line towards their assigned start boats.

Aligners will be placed at the beginning of the Start Area of the 300m, 600m and 1100m to control the boats' flow.

Anti-Doping Control

Doping as defined in the Olympic Movement Anti-Doping Code is strictly forbidden. Anti-Doping control will be conducted in accordance with the ICF Anti-Doping Control Regulations. The selected competitors are subject to Anti-Doping Control conforming to the relevant regulations.

It is very important that all competitors should have their passport (or some other official paper suitable for identification) ready to present if chosen for Anti-Doping Control for identification, so make sure they do not leave it in the hotels.

Anti-Doping Control will be carried out during the competition by the by Uzbekistan National Anti-Doping Agency. In accordance with the standards of the ICF, the required number of samples will be taken.

Medal Ceremonies

All competitors receiving medals must be wearing their national outfit and proper sport shoes are requested together with the Team Leader of the winning nation to be present at the Meeting Point (behind the Finish Tower) 10 minutes the latest prior the Medal Ceremony officially scheduled.

Medal Ceremony will start at its officially scheduled time sharp.

Athletes not presented at the time of their respective medal ceremonies will not be awarded their medals after the officially allocated times of the ceremonies.

Athletes taking part in the Medal Ceremony without accreditation cards, sunglasses, caps or bandanas and any personal talismans and/or toys.

ATHLETES ARE NOT ALLOWED TO TAKE ANY KIND OF NATIONAL FLAGS OR OTHER NATIONAL, CULTURAL OR RELIGIOUS SYMBOLS WITH THEM ONTO THE PODIUM

In the event when winners/medallists are absent from the Medal Ceremony for a valid reason (for example, hospitalisation), medals and bouquets are handed over to the official representing the relevant National Federation. That official does not take place onto the podium, but stands in front of its and accepts the medal and bouquet.

Winners and medallists of Canoe Sprint events are awarded medals by a representative of the ICF or Host Organising Committee, whereas flowers are handed over by a representative of the winning National Federation and/or another guest of honour.

After each Medal Ceremony an official group photo is taken on the podium, and all winners and medallists should go through the Mixed Zone in the Medal Ceremony Area.

Closing Ceremony

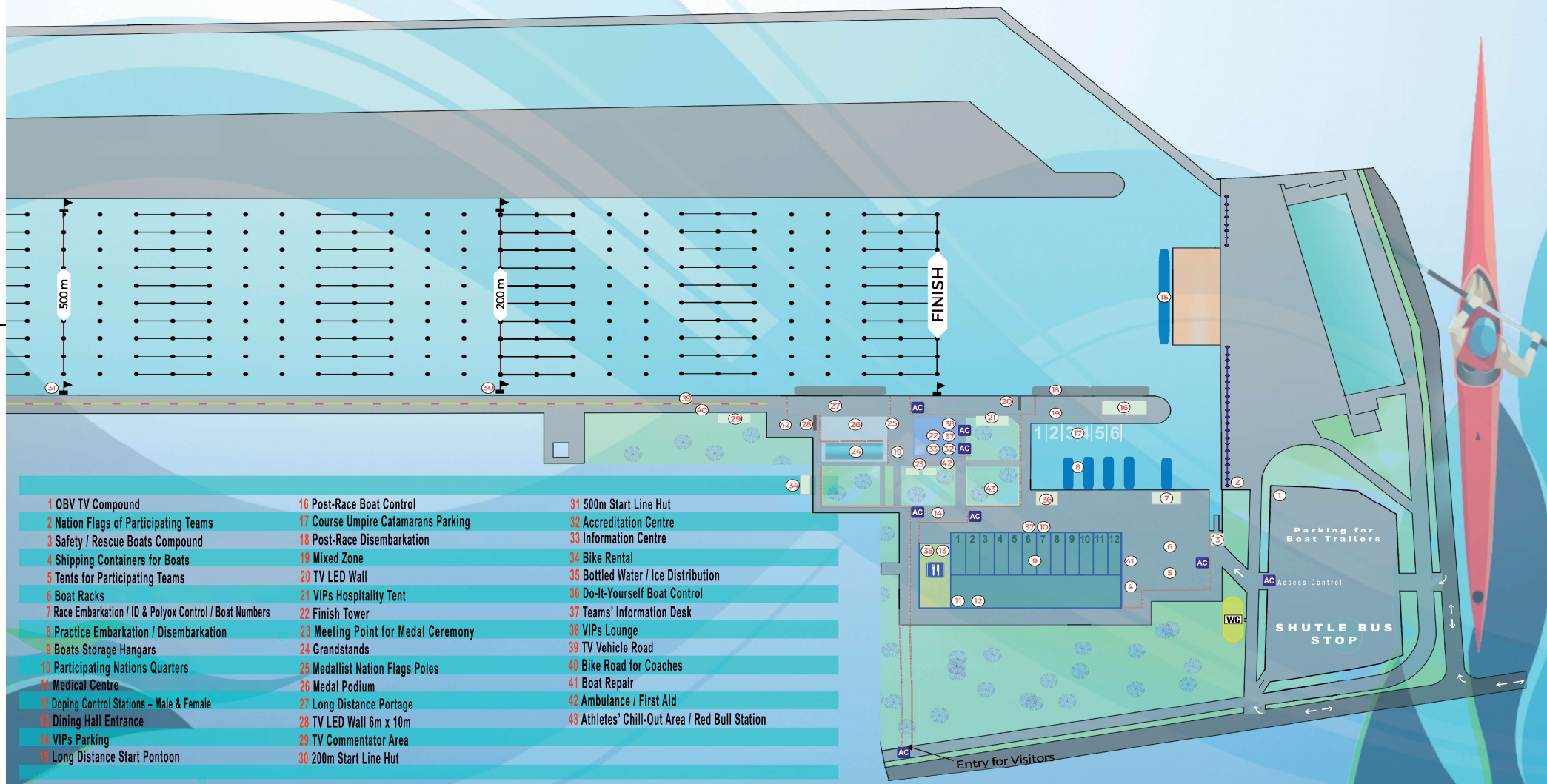
