

Asian Canoe Slalom and Sprint Qualifiers for Tokyo Olympic 2020

ACSL 30 April – 2 May 2021 and ACSP 5 – 7 May 2021 Pattaya, Thailand Bulletin #2

Welcome all NFs to the significant events for qualifiers. Under the Covid-19 pandemic, even it is difficult for host competition but we will get through together.

Please note that all required documents for VISA and Covid–19 regulations are referring to Bulletin#1. The important documents for VISA application are Booking confirmation for ALO, the HOC invitation letter, Thai Foreign Affairs Ministry approval, the latest bulletin and Certificate of Entry: COE. If you require any support, do not hesitate to contact HOC.

1. The venue

1.1 The venue for ACSL and ACSP are confirmed at The RCAT Rowing and Canoeing Training Center, Pattaya.

1.2 The venue has to be set and controlled for preventing and secure all NFs from Covid-19 infected. It will be divided and restricted for making safe and clean at all time you are participating the events. RCAT will inform and instruct by the information signs by the main principal as "Social distancing". Please kindly follow the instructions.

1.3 The regulations for preventing Covid-19 inspected and useful events information will be informed to all who involved by <u>www.en.rcat.or.th</u> while you are staying in Alternative Local Quarantine and official accommodation at Ambassador City Jomtien Hotel and the venue.

2. The Nominal Entry

2.1 ACSL: NFs have sent already since 25 March 2021 and must be made by each National Federation using the ICF's online entries system (SDP): <u>https://icf.msl.es/icf/icf.jsp</u>

2.2 ACSP: Due to entries and accreditations requests must be made by each National Federation using the ICF's online entries system (SDP): <u>https://icf.msl.es/icf/icf.jsp</u>.

Anyway, HOC asks for your favor to fill out the "Nominal Entry" by the appendix attached and return to HOC within <u>12 April 2021</u>, then HOC and ACSP TD can arrange the provisional schedule in advance.

3. The present situation of the Covid-19 quarantine period

Thai Covid-19 Disease Control Center announced the new quarantine policy: since 1 April 2021 for foreign visitor acknowledge:

- Without Covid-19 vaccination and Covid-19 Free Certificate "Not Covid-19 Infected" within 72 hours before the journey and 2 RT- PCR test during quarantine period Day 3 - 5 and Day 9 - 10 are negative, need 10 days quarantine.

- With Covid-19 vaccination (more than 14 days – 3 months) and Covid-19 Free Certificate "Not Covid-19 Infected" within 72 hours before the journey and 1 RT- PCR test during quarantine period Day 5 - 6 is negative, need 7 days quarantine.

- With Covid 19 vaccination (more than 14 days – 3 months) but no Covid-19 Free Certificate "Not Covid-19 Infected" within 72 hours before the journey needs 2 RT- PCR test during quarantine period Day 0 - 1 and Day 5 - 6 are negative, need 7 days quarantine.

That made it possible for ICF representative and ACSL and ACSP ITO to arrive Thailand on 23 April 2021 and depart Thailand on when each competition finished.

Please notice that all attendees who involved in ACSL and ACSP need to stay in the official accommodation only and have to stay in "Bubble" after the quarantine period finished as well. "Bubble" is the way to secure everyone for Covid-19 until you depart from Thailand.

If any NF needs the RT- PCR test within 72 hours before the departure, with self-expense. Please inform HOC, e-mail: office@rcat.or.th

4. Training and Competition period

4.1 For NFs, the official training: OT, will be prepared as table below. OT will be started when you get the first RT- PCR test on day 3 of ALQ guarantine period and receive the result "Negative" only.

6. ALQ. - Official accommodation – "Bubble" = Ambassador City Jomtien Hotel

6.1 Please kindly reserve and check the ALQ for ACSL and ACSP at Ambassador City Jomtien Hotel only via <u>rsvn@ambassadorcityjomtien.com</u> Quarantine period is 16 – 30 April 2021. NFs may kindly response for ALQ expense. When quarantine period finished, all certified NFs have to stay more longer in "official accommodation period and "Bubble" staying as well.

6.2 ACSL: official accommodation period will be start from 1 – 2 May 2021 under NF responsibility. Reservation via HOC.

6.3 ÅCSP: official accommodation period will be start from 1–7 May 2021 under NF responsibility. Reservation via HOC.

6.4 "Bubble" will be started when quarantine period finished and involved official accommodation period. All who stay from quarantine period and get the "Not Covid-19 detected" will transfer from ALQ room to official room in the Tower Wing and can meet across NFs inside the designated area in the hotel such as pool, sport bar and dining room.

8. The weather

The weather in Thailand is hot all year round and the temperature during April - May is between 25 - 35 degrees Celsius and may exceed 40 degrees on some days.
