## **COVID 19 regular testing**

#### **Context:**

Several COVID19 positive cases have already been reported within the Canoe slalom community in Augsburg since the beginning of the official training periods.

### **Actions:**

Measures has been taken for the persons who have tested positive to manage the situation out according to the 2022 ICF COVID Protocol (quarantine and contact cases daily tested).

We ask all the participants, staff, volunteers to act with responsibility at the venue, and:

- To test every three days with an autotest during the official training and competition periods. Also any suspicion or symptom must be checked with an autotest. This regular testing program should start today
- Masks must be worn inside the ICF rooms at the venue (accreditation room, enquiry desk, meeting rooms) and FFP2 masks must be worn in public transport (local regulation)
- No hugs, handshaking and kisses during the training sessions and during the competition (Kiss and Cry area or during medal ceremonies)
- Declared cases must be reported as soon as possible to the ICF (<u>Thomas Rosset</u>) and the HOC (<u>Lisa Micheler-Jones</u>) COVID managers
