7 – Clarification about Tie break rules in QH



B.4.2. Rules for qualification heats round:

- If the athletes have the same result in the qualification heats, the tie should be broken by a re-run (tie break run).
- The fastest athlete will be ranked highest. The original race time will be displayed on the results of the phase.
- The starting time of the re-race will be determined by the competition committee.

Clarification in QH :

 A tie break run will be contested only when the tie affects the progression or the start order of the next round.

- Wear bib number


- For head to head sprint, receive boat plate (A or B)
- Be one time to receive the boat allocated <mark>20</mark> minutes before your start time.




11 – HEAD TO HEAD SPRINT / FIELD OF PLAY


COURSE LAYOUT





12 – HEAD TO HEAD SPRINT – rules reminder




- Start procedure :

 - The athletes must not paddle before the start machine is open.



COURSE LAYOUT


