

ACCREDITATION

All participants of the competition must be accredited. Access to the course is not possible without an accreditation card.

OPENING HOURS

The Accreditation Centre is located at the Regatta Course, Krancowa 98 street.

Team Leaders are kindly requested to come directly to the Accreditation Centre upon arrival.

If Team arrive later that **20.00PM** should go directly to dedicated hotel, team should come to accreditation next day morning.

Team leaders are required to arrive alone. After paying their dues, team leaders may collect their accreditation cards. A federation will receive accreditations only when all documents are delivered and invoices are paid.

SPORT INFORMATION DESK

The information desk will be located in the athlete's area next to the hangars. During the competition, the staff at the information desk will provide all necessary information.



BOAT NUMBERS & BIB NUMBERS

Boat numbers are free of charge and can be collected before the race at the designated place next to ID control. All rented numbers need to be returned after the race.

BIB numbers will be provided by the OC and will be available at accreditation. In case of a missing number, go directly to Chief Judge.

Every competitor must have a personal BIB number during all competitions. The number should be placed on the competitor's back. The whole number must be visible, and no part of the BIB number can be obscured.

POST-RACE BOAT CONTROL

Post-race Boat Control is located next to the finish line on the finish tower site. Boat controllers will check boats after all heats, semi-finals, and finals.

At least three (3) boats will be selected from the participants in the races for boat control after the finish. Athletes will be called by boat numbers. Selected boats numbers will be also visible on the screen.

WARM-UP AREA

Athletes may access the water for warm-up at the competition venue via two pontoons located near the boat racks.

The warm-up area is situated behind the 1000m start line of the regatta course. It is forbidden to train during competition days parallel to the regatta course.



LOST and FOUND

All reports of lost items at the venue should be delivered directly to the Sport Information Desk. This is also the location where all found items should be delivered. Items will be kept at the venue until the end of the competition.

PARKING

Parking passes will be available at the accreditation office. All cars must be parked only in the designated parking area.

Teams will receive three parking passes for: one trailer and two accredited vehicles (up to 3,5t). Additional parking passes will be purchased for **30 Euro/car/competition**.

MEALS

All participants will have lunch at the regatta course. Catering tent will be located next to the accreditation office.

WATER

Water will be available from dispensers; please provide competitors with water bottles.

UNIFORMS AND UNIFORMITY

If two (2) boats from the same country compete in the same race, they must wear the same uniforms submitted with Nominal entries. In a crew boat there MUST BE uniformity among all athletes including: sleeve length, hats, headbands and spray covers.

Teams shall upload a picture of their uniform before the entry deadline in SDP to the relevant section. A detailed guideline on the procedure will be sent to the team leaders by ICF.

MEDAL AWARDING CEREMONIES

All athletes (wearing their national outfit and shoes, not allowed: cap, sunglasses, flags) of the winning nations are requested to be present at the meeting point next to the Finish Tower 10 minutes prior to the officially scheduled victory ceremony at the latest.

Medal awarding ceremonies will start at their officially scheduled time. In case any athlete arrives late to the meeting point, the ceremony will start by the schedule **without him/her**.

DOPING CONTROL

Athletes will be randomly selected for doping control conforming to the relevant regulations. For the ICF World Cup, every athlete, coach and support personnel must pass the relevant anti-doping online course on the Anti-Doping Education Learning platform (ADEL) corresponding to their role before the first day of the competition in accordance with 2023 ICF Anti-Doping Rules.


