

ICF / PAU 2021 COVID-19 PROTOCOL

KEY MEASURES TO STRICTLY RESPECT

- National teams, including all technical officers, staff and athletes will be expected to comply with this protocol.
- If an individual, or an entire team, does not respect it, the ICF may deny access to the venue to the concerned person/team.
- All accredited persons MUST wear a face mask all times when indoors or outside except:
 - When eating or drinking
 - Athletes, when they are on the water or on the conveyor belt
- Athletes on the bank must be able to wear the mask at any time.
- Face mask MUST be worn over the mouth and nose.
- All persons should refrain from close contact such as handshakes and embraces. At all places, participants are advised to facilitate 1 m social distance.









ARRIVAL IN PAU AND ACCREDITATION CENTER

If you arrive before the opening of the competition venue, free training is under French low, you will need for each member of your team the Health Pass.

EXTREME SLALOM BOATS

- The HOC will provide 8 boats and spraydecks.
- Boats will be available near the start platform for each training session.

TEAM TENTS

- Team tents will available.
- They will be accessible for teams from Monday 6 September at 9.00.
- Boat storage will be available and security 24/7 from Monday.
- Fruits will be available.










VENUE MAP
