## 1. EVENT LOCATION

### Pre-competition training

On both Friday 19 June and Saturday 20 June, before the competition begins, clubs will be able to train on the whitewater channel of the River Ésera.

The ICF Ranking event will take place at the same time as the competition; paddlers from countries other than Spain will start after the last Spanish competitor.



Following this competition, the 2nd Ésera Whitewater Canal Sprint Rafting Open will take place, open to all athletes wishing to participate, including competitors from other countries.

## 6. SERVICES AND FACILITIES

Graus Town Council is making the municipal sports facilities in Graus available to all participants.

We ask all clubs and athletes to use these facilities responsibly and with respect for others.

A space has been reserved at the water's edge for parking cars and vans.

Club tents must be set up on the meadow next to the river, leaving a clear path for athletes to pass through.

There is a toilet by the river and changing rooms with showers and toilets in the municipal facilities.

The podium will be set up by the river and, in the event of rain, the awards ceremony will take place inside the Municipal Sports Hall.





A parking area has been set aside for the public and those accompanying participants; the organisers ask that you respect the designated areas.

## 7. DISINFECTION PROTOCOLS

In compliance with disinfection measures against the spread of the zebra mussel, all boats must arrive disinfected in accordance with the disinfection protocol (<http://www.chebro.es/contenido.visualizar.do?idContenido=11945>). All boats and

paddles will be disinfected once the

sporting event has finished.

**It will be mandatory for all boats to pass through the disinfection point once the races have finished.**

Disinfection times have also been arranged prior to the competition:

Friday 19 June from 6pm to 8pm and Saturday 20 June from 9.30am to 10.30am

## 2. EMBARCACIONES SIN MOTOR



### 2.1. Eliminación de restos adheridos

- En el mismo lugar de desembarque, se procederá al vaciado total del agua del interior de la piragua o barca.
- Se inspeccionará cuidadosamente toda la embarcación y los equipos que hayan estado en contacto con el agua, eliminando los ejemplares de mejillón cebra y restos de vegetación acuática visible.

### 2.2. Secado y desinfección

Se pueden eliminar las larvas de mejillón cebra por secado de las embarcaciones, mediante limpieza con hidrolimpiadora o bien aplicando una solución clorada.

#### 2.2.1. Secado de las embarcaciones

- Vaciar y secar la embarcación minuciosamente, de manera que no quede ningún resto de humedad donde pueda refugiarse alguna larva de mejillón cebra y ser transportada a otra masa de agua. Prestar especial atención a las zonas menos accesibles y más difíciles de vaciar y secar.
- En el caso de que el equipo no vaya a ser usado se mantendrá en cuarentena durante 10 días aumentando este tiempo en función de las condiciones climatológicas, de almacenamiento, etc. En caso de no poder mantener los días de cuarentena se procederá al secado manual mediante esponjas o bayetas secantes.



### 2.2.3. Aplicación de productos desinfectantes

- Rocíar la piragua con una solución clorada de 1mg de cloro libre/l (añadir 0,25 ml de lejía en 10 l de agua) asegurándonos de que el producto llega a todos los recovecos de la embarcación.
- Los equipos que hayan estado en contacto con el agua: salvavidas, impermeables, vadeadores, artes de pesca, etc., deberán seguir el protocolo de desinfección de equipos desarrollado en la p. 10.
