- The protocol will be strictly implemented from Monday morning.

ACCREDITATION CENTRE

The accreditation centre will be open:

Sunday 1 November	16.00 – 18.00	Thursday 5 November	8.30 – 18.00
Monday 2 November	8.30 – 18.00	Friday 6 November	8.00 – 18.00
Tuesday 3 November	8.30 – 18.00	Saturday 7 November	8.00 – 18.00
Wednesday 4 November	8.30 – 18.00	Sunday 8 November	8.00 – 12.00

Accreditation will be mandatory to access the venue from the 2nd access of each person.

NATIONAL FEDERATIONS WRITTEN DECLARATION

- Each team leader must provide this form (one per National Federation) at the accreditation centre to obtain the training bibs and the accreditation.
- Some printed forms will be available at the HOC Headquarters (see map #6) from Saturday 31 October to allow you to prepare it.

DAILY PRESENCE AT THE VENUE

- Each accredited person will have to sign at arrival and at departure each day.
- It will be done at the entry check point.
- It is mandatory.









KEY MEASURES TO STRICTLY RESPECT

- National teams, including all technical officers, staff and athletes will be expected to comply with this protocol.
- If an individual, or an entire team, does not respect it, the ICF may deny access to the venue to the concerned person/team.
- All accredited persons MUST wear a face mask all times when indoors or outside except:
 - When eating or drinking
 - o Athletes, when they are on the water or on the conveyor belt

Athletes on the bank must be able to wear the mask at any time.

- Face mask **MUST** be worn over the mouth and nose.
- All persons should refrain from close contact such as handshakes and embraces. At all places, participants are advised to facilitate 1 m social distance.

TRAINING SCHEDULE AND TRAINING BIBS

ENTRY LIST VERIFICATION, NATIONAL ANTHEM & FLAG SIGN OFF

- Whilst collecting training bibs Team Leaders will be asked to check and sign off their entry list, national anthem and flag with the Sport Information Office (entrance of timing & scoring office).
- From the start of Monday Morning until 12:00 on Wednesday 4 November, each Team Leader must check and sign their entries list.
- All changes or withdrawals have to be done on this entry list and signed by the Team Leader.









TEAM TENTS

- Team tents will available (see map #3).
- They will be accessible for teams from Wednesday 3 November.

This delay is due to uncertainty to deliver the competition under the lockdown situation.

- From Monday to Wednesday, you must change on the car park.
- Boat storage will be available and security 24/7 from Monday.
- Water and fruits will be available.
