All athletes, coaches, and support personnel must have completed the relevant anti-doping online course on the WADA Anti-Doping Education Learning platform (ADEL) corresponding to their role. The certificates showing completion should be sent by each National Federation to manuela.gawehn@canoeicf.com. Previous certificates are still valid for this season. There is no need to repeat the program unless the person's role changes (e.g. athlete becoming coach).

Accreditations will not be issued until the certificates are marked off.

It is the Technical Chair's discretion to accept or decline a late entry. Late entries to the competition will incur a fee of 50 euros per athlete in addition to the participation fee.

12. Closing of the course

The course is closed 15 min before the first official start each day until 10 minutes after the last athletes pass the finish line on the whole course.

If there is a gap of more than 45 minutes, the course is open until 15 min before the first official start

13. Pre-Start Control

The pre-start control will be on the right river side near the boat entrance. All athletes have to pass the pre start control.

14. Start and Finish location and procedure

A. Start procedure – individual events

- Boat will be held on the right bank and released from 0 after the countdown has finished
- Athletes are responsible to get themselves to the start position on time.
- There will be a clock facing upstream into the warm-up area showing race time and the next athletes to start.
- One boat at the start and the following competitor could stay behind the releasing point.
- The beam line is will be indicated by two poles
- At the start, there will be an acoustic signal (15 seconds before start
 4 shorts, 1 long start).
- Athletes must start within 3 seconds of their start time.
- At all times, the athletes must follow the Starter's instruction, or they may be disqualified for the run.
- The course is closed 15 minutes before the first competitor each day.





B. Start procedure – team events

- All boats will be held, 1 boat from individual start position and 2 boats from rafts, one on left bank and one on right bank.
- It doesn't matter which of the three boats cross the start line at first. All boats must pass the start within **10 seconds from the "0".**





C. Finish

- The beam line is marked with banners "finish".
- Athletes must exit on the river right and pass through equipment control and for Final the kiss and cry zone next to the boat control
- Athletes must not leave the finish zone until dismissed by the equipment control judge once they are no longer needed for the ceremonies, anti-doping or equipment control.
- As soon the athletes leave the boats at the finish they maybe be required for a quick comment regarding their run then for finals the leading athlete must proceed to the Mixed Zone area.
- During this process, each athlete must wear his competition bibs.
- there will be a flower ceremony just after the finals of each category

15. Course approval

The course must be approved by a simple majority of the present.

16. Start Interval

- Sprint Heats 45 seconds
- Sprint Finals and Teams see schedule

17. Results

- HOC will compile the results using https://live.results.cz/.
- Results will be posted on the official notice at the enquiry desk behind the glass house
- Live results will be available on a viewer at the enquiry desk.

18. Location of Inquiry / Protest desk, Protest fee

- The Inquiry desk is located behind the glass house.
- The Protest fee is 75 euros

19. Equipment measuring and post competition control

- Equipment Control is located at the end of the course and is open for self-checking: Wednesday and Thursday during training slots
- Equipment control station can be used also each day of competition 15 minutes before each Wildwater canoeing official competition start times.
- There will be random post equipment control conducted throughout the Heats, all qualified athletes go through equipment control for Finals.
- Safety advice: airbags must be full pump. Shoes are required. !!!
 - Life jackets: 3.7.4.d All the buoyant material must be located in the vest above the waist.

All other aspects following the rules.



20. Doping control

The doping control station is located in the main building behind the reception

- Athletes will be notified for Doping Control at the finish area.
- ID card or passport will be requested.

21. Awards Ceremony, Time and Location, Dress requirement

- For Opening and medal ceremonies, athletes, medallists, team staff and team leaders the must attend the meeting wearing proper National Federation Uniforms.
 For medal ceremonies, the Team leaders of the gold medallists must attend the ceremony.
