

4. LOCATION AND VENUE INFORMATION

How to reach Klong Bang Phai Whitewater Course, Pattaya-Rayong, Thailand.

The easiest option is to fly to Suvarnabhumi Airport (BKK). The trip from the airport to the venue is approximately 2 hours by car. Don Mueang Airport (DMK) & U-Tapao Airport (UTP) are also some possible options. For a small fee RCAT is pleased to assist teams with buses to reach the venue.



The artificial whitewater course is nestled in the compound of the 48000sq/m at the Rowing and Canoeing Association Training Center. The facilities are designed to serve as a training center for water sports athletes; mainly the RCAT's national teams of canoe – kayak sprint, rowing, and canoe slalom. There are also jogging and cycling tracks to serve the health-concerned neighboring community.





9. OFFICIAL TRAINING PERIOD


The Official Training period per groups will be organized FOR ACCREDITED ATHLETES, on 1st and 2nd March (Free of charge) The official training schedule will be published ACCORDING TO THE NUMERICAL ENTRIES once it will be closed.



10. ENTERING TO THAILAND

- 10.1 All passengers must complete the Thailand Digital Arrival Card.
- 10.2 If the alien stays in the Kingdom longer than 90 days, he/she must notify in writing the nearest Immigration Officer, concerning place of stay, as soon as possible upon expiration of 90 days. And required to do so every 90 days.
- 10.3 Aliens are not allowed to work unless they are granted Work Permit.
- 10.4 Foreigners are required to submit their arrival card information 3 days in advance of their arrival date in Thailand.
