#### **Course arrangement**




PORTAGE AREA









Short distance 3 laps, each lap 1,2 km, 2 portage. Yellow line shows turn for short laps.

Blue line standard (long course), each lap is 2 km, 10 laps + 1 short lap

Total 21 km, first two laps no portage, so 8 portages. Portage appr. 60 metre long, sandy beach out and sandy beach in. Portage self on beach.

#### TEAM OFFICIAL ACCREDITATION COST INFORMATION

Team Officials (must have a function in in the sport) are responsible for the costs of their accommodation, meals and transportation.

The following options are available to extra team officials once they are approved by IWGA.

AVAILABILITY IS LIMITED. (most rooms are already booked)

ACCOMMODATIONS ALLOCATED ON A FIRST-COME, FIRST-SERVED BASIS.

# **OPTION 1** — Accreditation + Athletes Village Accommodation — \$180.00 per person/day

Single Includes the following:

- Accommodation in a single room at the Athletes' Village.
- Accreditation ID card which allows access to venues, the athletes' village, opening and
  closing ceremonies, etc according to the access levels which are established for the
  cardholder by IWGA and BOC. (Accreditation levels for Extra Team Officials are evaluated in
  the same manner as all other accredited persons.)
- 3 meals per day at the catering centre on the campus of the Athletes' Village

Transportation within the Games transportation network (airport venues, athlete villages)

## OPTION 2— Accreditation + Athletes' Village Accommodation — Double \$120.00 per person/day

Includes the following:

- Accommodation in a double (shared) room at the Athletes' Village.
- Accreditation ID card which allows access to venues, the athletes' village, opening and closing ceremonies, etc according to the access levels which are established for the cardholder by IWGA and BOC. (Accreditation levels for Extra Team Officials are evaluated in the same manner as all other accredited persons.)
- 3 meals per day at the catering centre on the campus of the Athletes' Village
- Transportation within the Games transportation network (airport venues, athlete villages)

#### **OPTION 3** — Accreditation Only \$55.00 per person/day

#### **Includes the following:**

- Accreditation ID card which allows access to venues, the athletes' village, opening and closing ceremonies, etc according to the access levels which are established for the cardholder by IWGA and BOC. (Accreditation levels for Extra Team Officials are evaluated in the same manner as all other accredited persons.)
- 3 meals per day at the catering centre on the campus of the Athletes' Village
- Transportation within the Games transportation network (airport, venues, athlete villages)

Accredited athletes and officials arriving after the start of the Games or departing before the end of the Games will have the possibility to attend the Opening and Closing Ceremonies as well, independent from the period of accreditation.

For accommodations outside of the athletes' village, Birmingham Organisation accommodation partner, National Travel Systems (NTS), will work with delegates to find solutions according to the delegate's budget. (contact Ruud Heijselaar for more information)

Delegates who are not accommodated within the Games transportation loop will be responsible for making their own way to the athletes' village for meal service, and/or to participate in the Games transportation system.

#### **For VISA**

#### How can I get an invitation letter for athletes?

The following information have to be provided to generate visa letters for individual athletes and teams:

- Organization (IF)
- Last Name
- First Name
- Function
- Gender
- Date of Birth
- Place of Birth
- Nationality
- Passport Number
- Passport Issue Date
- Passport Validity Date

#### When and where should I apply for a VISA?

Due to the COVID pandemic and consulate closures all over the world, it is recommended that athletes/officials schedule interviews as early as possible in consulates of their country or neighbouring countries. National Travel Systems may assist you with providing contacts and facilitating interviews on time.

Obtaining a visa will be pertinent for many of the attendees of The World Games 2022. The key is starting the process well in advance of the travel date. Below are some steps and information pertaining to a US Visa to attend the The World Games 2022.

- Register through the The World Games 2022 Registration Portal. Letters of Invitation will be available to those approved registrants. They will be sent to the email on file upon registration.
- Determine if you need a Visa to enter the United States. There are currently 38 countries that participate in the Visa Waiver Program. These countries are listed in the State Department Website

• If your country is not part of the Visa Waiver Program, contact the nearest US Embassy and Consulate regarding obtaining visas. In addition, there are companies and agencies that will assist with obtaining visas for a fee. Directory of Visa Categories (state.gov). Best practices are to start the process as much in advance of the travel date as possible. Some National Governing Bodies have been known to obtain visas for those with a chance of qualification to start the process well in advance.

Travel restrictions relating to Covid 19 can change at short notice and may be different for different countries. All federations are advised to monitor the restrictions carefully to ensure that their team complies with any requirements.

#### **MEDIA RIGHTS FOR ATHLETES**

Competitors, team officials and other team personnel who have qualified and will participate in The World Games may allow their person, name, picture or sports performances to be used for advertising purposes before and during The World Games in accordance with the principles determined by the IWGA Executive Committee.

Athletes and others holding accreditation to The World Games 2022 are encouraged to share their experiences with their friends, family and supporters via social and digital media and to preserve the memories of their attendance at The World Games.

Athletes can take photographs and record audio/video (using non-professional equipment) content of The World Games. Athletes can share this content on their personal social/digital media accounts or website, except for content containing audio/video of the Field of Play.

### Anti-Doping – Regulations

- IWGA's Anti-Doping rules effective 1 January 2021 are in full compliance with the WADA Code and will be strictly applied for TWG 2022 – as well as the WADA directives.
- · IWGA remains the testing authority for the Games.
- A contract of collaboration with ITA has been signed to carry out the controls on the field.
- · USADA as local NADO will be involved.
- · WADA will send observers.
