2026 AURONZO INTERNATIONAL CANOE SPRINT AURONZO DI CADORE (BL) - ITALY, 3-4-5 JULY

REGISTRATIONS CLOSE – TUESDAY 23 JUNE 2026

For those who have not yet registered, registration closes on Tuesday 23 June 2026 at 11:59 pm. Please note that the registration process requires submitting the Preliminary Entry form (Attachment 1 of Bulletin 1). Foreign crews must submit the registration list (Nominal Entry), and Italian crews must complete the registration process on the portal www.iscrizionicanoa.com.

The participation fee must be paid by bank transfer (details provided in Bulletin 1) by Tuesday, June 23, 2026. All details and procedures are provided in Bulletin 1.

TEAM COMPOSITION FOR K4/C4 MIXED

For those wishing to register for the K4 and C4 MIXED races, please note that the crew must consist of 2 male athletes and 2 female athletes.

ROAD CONDITIONS IN VENETO (direction from Bologna towards Auronzo)

For those arriving from Belluno with the SS51 Alemagna, we point out that there are deviations and queues in the Longarone area and traffic lights and possible queues in the Auronzo di Cadore area.

LAKE CONDITIONS

The competition area of Lake Santa Caterina is formed by a dam on the Ansiei river. The riverbed between the bridges of Villapiccola (starting area 1000 metres) and Transacqua (finish area) is subject to gravel and debris removal works. This year you will find a basin in very good condition.

ACCESS OF VEHICLES AND PEOPLE TO THE COMPETITION VENUE

- Access to the competition area must preferably be done on foot, parking unauthorised vehicles outside the areas dedicated to the event.
- On the days of 01/07 and 02/07 it will be possible to arrive with the vans and trailers to deposit the canoes and kayaks in the appropriate racks, subject to availability.
- After depositing the canoes on the canoe stands, the trailers must be parked in the dedicated areas (upstream of the river) and can be recovered at the end of the races, or shortly before.
- When the canoe stands are full, the last trailers that arrive can park in the dedicated areas.
- On 03/07 (all day), 04/07 (all day) and 05/07 (until about 3pm), a maximum of up to 2 vehicles (cars / vans) for groups with more than 8 athletes registered for the event can park in the dedicated areas at the race venue. For all the others only 1 vehicle will be permitted. Authorised vehicles will be given a PASS to be displayed on the windscreen or visible before entering the event area, from 06:00 to 20:00.
- For vehicles not equipped with a PASS, if the vehicle is not removed after the announcement of the speaker, the intervention of a tow truck will be requested and all associated costs are to be borne by the owner of the vehicle.
- Vehicles with the "disabled on board" badge, or with the authorisation of the C.O. (disabled athlete participating in the event), will be able to access and park in the competition area without needing the PASS.
- Pedestrian access around the lake and to the venue is free at all times.

RACE SECRETARIAT

The race secretariat will be located at the at the finish tower, found at the end of the descent of via Zardus, on the far side of the bridge that crosses the lake.

The jury, the photo finish and the time-keepers are positioned on the finish line, on the Stella Alpina side.

From 15:00 to 18:00 on Thursday 02/07, the Clubs / Teams will be able to verify their registrations, bringing with them the receipt of the payment transfer of the participation fees and anything else that could be useful for the verifications.

It should be remembered that for administrative and general matters, the Organising Committee, through its representatives should be contacted. For any technical and regulatory matters, the Jury is competent.

The fee to be able to present a technical protest during the competitions, as per ICF regulations, is Euro 75.00.

BOAT CONTROL

The boat scale will be positioned on 01/07-02/07 near the assistance pontoons, located close to the Ambulance, so that athletes can easily pass by the scale and carry out weight control.

The boat scale will be positioned on 03/07, 04/07 and 05/07 in the vicinity of the Jury and Race Secretariat area. It will be possible to check the weight from 07:30 to 08:00 in the morning and at the end of the day of competition, until 19:30.

The scale will be reserved for routine checks at the end of each race.

It will not be possible to check the weight of the boats with the races in progress.

MEDAL CEREMONIES

The ceremonies must be carried out according to the program that will be provided, with the winners who will be awarded by Authorities or representatives present near the podium. The winning crews must present themselves with the same uniform / race shirt. The medal ceremonies will be held near the Finish Tower area.

LUNCH AT THE RACE VENUE

From 24 June 2026, i.e. after the registration deadline, you will receive a communication for booking and advance payment of meals. For those who have reserved their lunches, the service will be available from 11:30 to 14:30 on 03/07, 04/07 and 05/07, with collection and consumption at your own gazebo or, depending on the availability of places, near the tent structure near the distribution area.

To collect the meals ordered, a team representative should present themselves with a copy of the chosen menu in paper format and already paid for, and collect all meals for the team.

HYGIENE SERVICES

Portable hygiene services are available in the competition venue.

MEDICAL ASSISTANCE

During the races, medical assistance will be available. It should be remembered that the transfer costs to hospital facilities and the stay in the event of hospitalisation are the sole responsibility of the injured person. The transfer to the first aid point does not need to be paid for by the injured person.

The medical assistance service is reserved only for athletes registered for the event and their accompanying technicians / team leaders and for all members / employees appointed by the Organising Committee (jury, time-keepers, etc.).

BICYCLE RENTAL SERVICE

There will be a bike rental service available during the races. To book and receive more information, please contact TreCime Service tel. 333.3142212 or visit the website www.trecimeservice.com. As this service is very popular, we suggest you book ahead.

LIMITS FOR DRONES

During the races, only the organisation's drone will be allowed to fly over and film for Live Streaming. The flight of other "drone" devices is strictly prohibited, with immediate reporting to the competent Authorities and a fine.
