### Updated information 30<sup>th</sup> July 2020

Competition dates fixed: 13-18<sup>th</sup> April 2021

Training days fixed: 10-12<sup>th</sup> April 2021

With the global Covid19 pandemic ongoing the ICF headquarters and ICF Canoe Polo Committee together with the hosts Italy (FICK and Host Organising Committee) are still working towards staging the 2021 ICF Canoe Polo World Championships following the postponement of the dates in 2020.

### Greg Smale, Chair of the ICF Canoe Polo Committee:

'Firstly, I hope this update finds all those involved with this event in good health along with your families. I'm sure we all have stories and some of you/us heartache over the ongoing pandemic. Following close co-operation with Italy and a number of meetings to discuss options I'm pleased to be able to confirm for your diaries the confirmed dates.'

'We have no doubts in the ability of Italy to organise these championships and I'm pleased to inform all the venue itself, including the outdoor swimming pool, is now back open and has been for a few weeks.'

'We continue to liaise closely with the hosts and will update further in due course. We are of course, like many across the world, watching the pandemic data and for global participation/qualification for World Games etc paying particular attention to the flight situation.'

'Countries affected significantly by Covid19 are beginning to re-start Canoe Polo with some understandable restrictions which is after a very hard few months a significant step forward'.
