- Seminar for new officials on World Cup races
- Friday before a World Cup race a seminar from 08:30-12:30
- Conduct by 2 persons of the CAM (or key ITO's)
- PowerPoint presentation

#### **Day 1 Afternoon**

- Questions about the statutes (not for the ones who passed any other ICF examination)
  - 5 questions
- Questions about the Marathon Rules
  - 15 questions
- Scenario's
  - Practical situations 5 scenario's

#### **Day 2 Morning (only World or Continental Championships)**

- Team leaders meeting
  - All who passed the exam must be present at the TLM
- Appoint mentors for the World Cup and World Championships
- Meeting with the mentors and their trainee's (to explain what they can expect)

#### **Day 3 Racing day 1 (for World Cup, racing day 1)**

- Practical knowledge of the trainee's
  - Morning races           Mentor 1
  - Afternoon races       Mentor 2
- Report by the mentors to the members of the examination committee

#### **Day 4 Racing day 2 (for World Cup, racing day 2)**

- Practical knowledge of the trainee's
  - Morning races           Mentor 2
  - Afternoon race       Mentor 1
- Report by the mentors to the members of the examination committee
