

2019 ICF Anti-Doping Statistics

The statistics reported for the ICF in-competition and out-of-competition programs cover tests that are initiated by the ICF or its representatives. These statistics do not include in-competition and out-of-competition testing initiated by National Federations or National Anti-Doping Organizations.

2019 In-competition testing statistics

The ICF is responsible for Anti-Doping testing during ICF Competitions which includes Junior and Senior World Championships and World Cups in all disciplines.

The ICF performed **227 in-competition tests** as testing authority.

Out-of-competition testing statistics

99 samples (blood, urine, or passport samples) have been collected from out-of-competition testing in 2019.

The ICF Out-of-Competition Testing Program is coordinated by the Canadian Centre for Ethics in Sport Anti-Doping Service (CCES) since 2012.
